## HHSA'S ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING

To heck with snow and winter cold, the sailing season is about to unfold. In this regard, HHSA will hold its 1983 organizational meeting Sunday, February 20, 1983. The meeting will (1) begin at 12:00 noon, (2) continue until approximately 4:00 pm, and (3) will be held in the upstairs dining room of Herrington Harbour Restaurant. The purpose of the meeting is to plan the 1983 calendar and all members are encouraged to attend. Principal activities to be discussed and organized include (1) the racing program (including novice events), (2) association cruises (including weekend and extended cruises), (3) social activities (ie, spring christening party, crab feast, and children's day), (4) instructional and educational programs, and (5) other activities and functions of the association.

The meeting will begin with an overview of association objectives for the upcoming season; to be followed by separate meetings of the race committee, cruise committee, social committee, as well as membership and newsletter committees.
