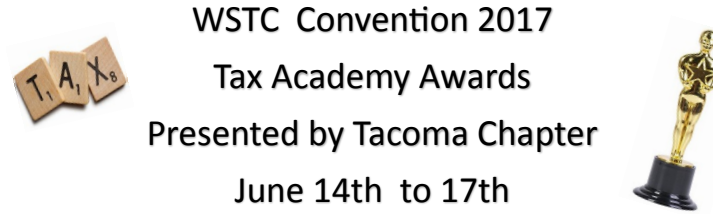

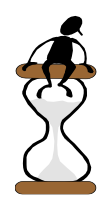
Main Speaker

Paul LaMonaca, CPA, M.S. Taxation

Paul is a tax professional in Falls Church, Virginia a few miles outside of Washington, D.C. and has been in partnership with Don Williamson since 1989. He is a former accounting and tax professor at **The American University in Washington, D.C.** He holds a **B.S. Degree in Accounting** from LaSalle College in Philadelphia and a **Masters Degree in Taxation** from American University in Washington, D.C.

Paul is a frequent lecturer of various federal income tax topics including corporations, individuals, fiduciaries and real estate. He was named as the **Tax Instructor of the Year** by the National Society of Tax Professionals (NSTP) 3 different times and the recipient of NSTP's 2008 Howard Longley Memorial Award for leadership, dedication, vision and service to the tax profession. He was the recipient of the 2014 President's Award for dedication and service to tax professionals and the 2015 recipient of the Rod Ervin Award for Outstanding Contribution in promoting and enhancing the image of tax professionals. He is a speaker at many State Society Tax Consultant Seminars and Conventions. From 2006 to 2012 he served as the moderator of the Annual Northern Virginia Chapter of the Virginia Society of Enrolled Agents Tri-State Seminar. Paul teaches for several State Chapters of Enrolled Agents and other various tax and accounting Societies and Associations throughout the United States.

Paul has been a member of the **Board of Directors** of the National Society of Tax Professionals since September 1996 and has been NSTP's **Director of Education** since 2006. He has been a presenter at the annual IRS National Tax Forums since 2009 and his 2016 presentations were ranked number 1 and number 2 by the almost 11,000 tax professionals who attended in Chicago, New Orleans, Washington, D.C. Orlando and San Diego.
