The Club hosts two fund-raising rides each year, the Ride Around Torch in mid-July and the Leelanau Harvest Tour in mid-September, and with the funds raised we award grants to non-profit organizations that support our mission. Funds are limited, of course, and the application will provide us the information we need to determine awards. If you need help in the application process, please contact us.

Minor Grant: For Requests of up to \$1000. The Minor Grant applications are reviewed semi-annually. We accept applications from January 1st through June 30th and July 1st through December 31st. Organizations will be notified in July and January of the grant determination. Funding is available soon thereafter, or as requested in the application.

Major Grant: For Requests of over \$1000. The Major Grant applications are reviewed annually. We accept applications from January 1st through September 1st. Organizations will be notified in October of the grant determination. Funding is available soon thereafter, or as requested in the application.
