

DELRdi Submission Instructions

Dissertation, Thesis, or Project

Satisfying partial fulfillment of a degree

SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS: If you have a dissertation, thesis or project, completed in partial fulfillment of a degree, that is not already listed in the descriptive index OR if you have such a document listed in the index and you would now like to make the full text available to readers please follow these instructions.

1. Submit the full text as a PDF or word document to delrdi@ndeo.org. Whether you want a citation listing or a citation with full text listing, full text must be provided for review preparation. If PDF or word document is not available, contact delrdi@ndeo.org regarding submitting hard copies. The document must include author's name, document title, name of granting institution, year of completion, degree earned, and physical location of the document including UMI/ProQuest Publication numbers if applicable. Also the document contents must include all pages, full bibliography, and all appendices. For full text inclusion, not simply citation, documents must be submitted electronically as PDF or word document. They must be of **final publication quality** (no whiteouts, crossovers, or editorial markings). All scanned documents should be checked to ensure all pages are correctly aligned before submission.
2. Be sure to include a valid email address for contacting you if needed.
3. To submit document or author's abstract for full text inclusion, the Permission to Reproduce form signed by the copyright holder should accompany the submission. NDEO must have this to reproduce the document for online reading. Usually the author holds copyright of a thesis or dissertation. This is also true for those published by UMI/ProQuest. To submit the Permission to Reproduce Form, email a scanned copy to delrdi@ndeo.org.

Published Articles, Reports, Conference Proceedings, and Other Published and Unpublished Documents

SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS: Send an electronic copy of the full text of the document to be considered for DELRdi inclusion to delrdi@ndeo.org. For questions regarding submitting hard copies also contact delrdi@ndeo.org. General document citations in the DELRdi do not provide full text access and therefore do not require signed permission from the copyright holder. However, if full text inclusion of a published work is desired, it is the author's responsibility to submit the copyright holder's signed Permission to Reproduce form.

ALL SUBMISSIONS MUST INCLUDE: Your name, your email address, author's name, and all bibliographic information: name of publication, date of publication, volume and issue number, ISSN number, publisher's name, and location online or physical address where reader can access full text.
