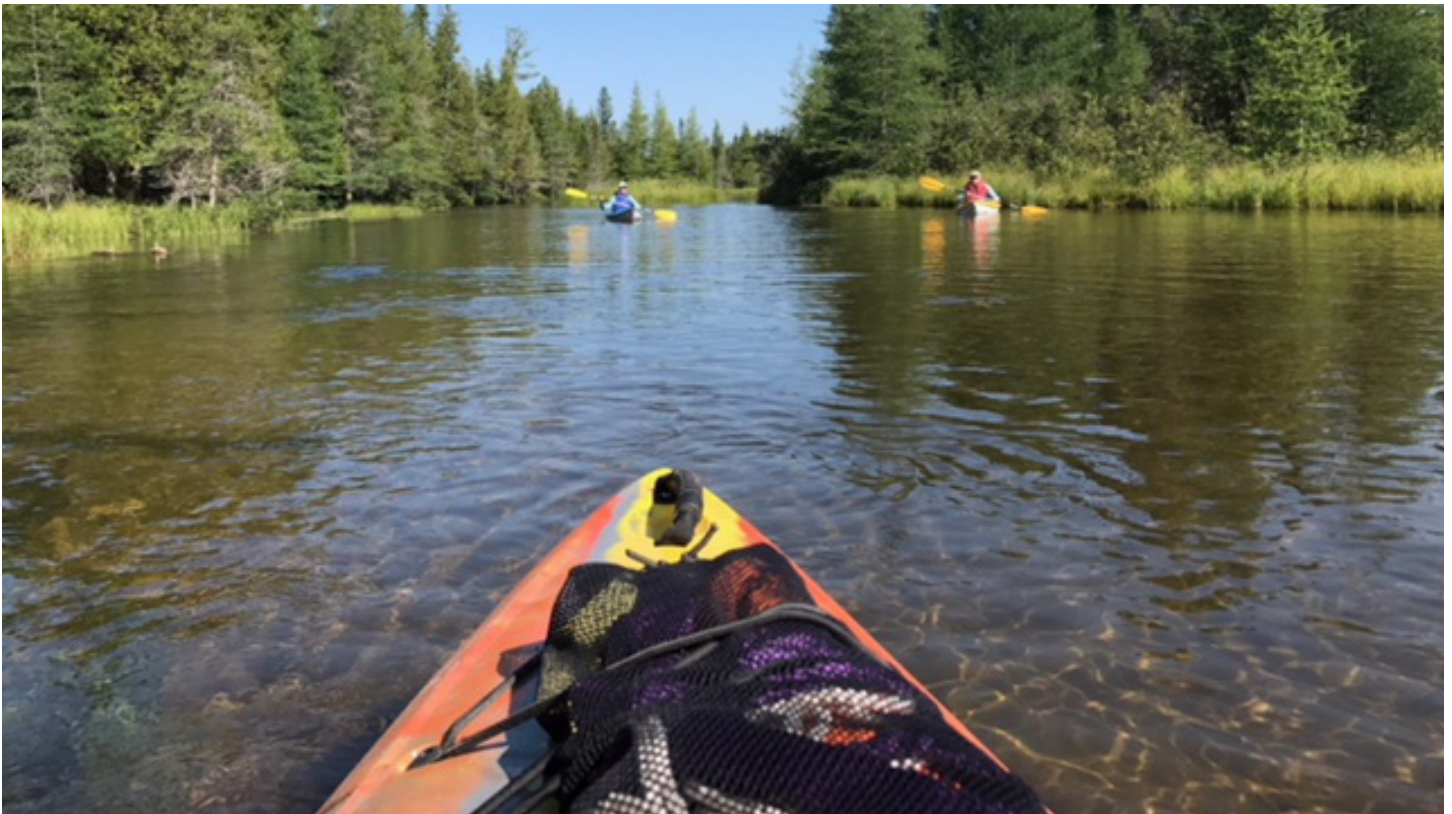

### **SOME OF THE AREA RIVERS:**

**The Pine River** flows through a valley in the Manistee National Forest. Spring water, wildlife and beautiful forests make paddling the Pine an incredible experience. With rapids in some sections and calm waters in other,

**The Big Manistee River** is included in the National Wild and Scenic River system because of its long stretches of undeveloped, forested banks and its clear, clean water.

**The Platte River** flows through Sleeping Bear Dunes National Lakeshore in Northern Michigan and ends at Lake Michigan.

**The Au Sable** is one of Michigan's most well-known sports rivers for its clear water and good trout fishing.

**The Jordan River** flows through the pristine wilderness of the Jordan Valley. The clear, cold river is one of the best trout fishing streams in the state of Michigan.

**The Rifle River** in the northeastern Lower Peninsula has an average depth of only eighteen to twenty-four inches. The shallow water makes it a popular choice for beginners and families canoeing with children.

**The Crystal River** is also located in Sleeping Bear Dunes National Lakeshore.

**The Thornapple River** in West Michigan features calm waters and good fishing.

**The Sturgeon River** the fastest flowing river in the Lower Peninsula. There are also several obstacles in the water, such as rocks and narrow passages, that must be navigated quickly through the swift current. Advanced paddlers seeking a thrill love the exciting Sturgeon.
