For the 2019 competition year, all the shows in the 2019 Combined Prize list will count for New England Morgan-Circuit Championship Awards.

Important Information

Eligibility

Performance Classes-Horse owner is a current member of the NEMHA.

Equitation Classes-Riders must be a NEMHA member and compete on a Morgan.

Tournament Division-Rider must be a member of NEMHA.

Horse receiving the award must be a Registered Morgan horse.

Qualification

Points will be **accumulated** from the date of Membership.

You must show at a minimum of **two** shows, and pin in two classes within the same division to qualify for a Circuit Championship.

Ribbons will be awarded **Champion and Reserve** for each division.

General Rules & Definitions

MAIDEN, NOVICE, and LIMIT HORSE classes will count towards the Open Division.

MAIDEN, NOVICE, and LIMIT Rider/Driver classes will count towards the Amateur Division circuit championship unless shown by a Junior Exhibitor, then the points will count towards the Junior Exhibitor Division circuit championship.

Amateur classes will only count towards the Amateur Division Awards, unless no Amateur championship is offered-then points will count towards the Open Division.

Jr. Ex classes will count towards the Jr. Ex. Division Awards, unless no Jr. Ex. championship is offered, then points will count towards the Open Division.

How Are Points Calculated?

Points will be awarded for places 1st-8th in both qualifying and championship classes as follows:

Qualifying Class

1st place	8 points
2nd place	7 points
3rd place	6 points
4th place	5 points
5th place	4 points
6th place	3 points
7 th place	2 points
8 th place	1 point

Championship Class

Champion	13 points
Reserve	12 points
3rd place	11 points
4th place	10 points
5th place	9 points
6th place	8 points
7 th place	7 points
8 th place	6 points

The New England Morgan Horse Show is worth double points.

Junior Exhibitor-not reached their 18th birthday as of 12/1 of the previous year.

Youth Exhibitor-not reached their 21st birthday as of 12/1 of the previous year.

Amateur Exhibitor must hold an Amateur Card with USEF.

Walk/Trot Riders must be 11 or younger as of 12/1 of the previous year.

If a horse is shown in a Jr./Novice Class, the points will count towards the Jr Division Circuit Championship award (if offered) if the horse is 4 years of age and under. All other points will go to the Open Division Circuit Championship Award.

In classes that have two possible divisions in the name (with the exception of Jr./Novice), points will go towards the 1st/primary division.
