## **Rules & Regulations**

**ENTRIES CLOSE** June 8, 2018. A copy of Registration papers and lease agreement (if any) must accompany all entry blanks. The show committee and/or Management reserve the right to decline any entry and to return fees before the opening of the show and to prohibit or remove any person from the show without being held liable for compensation.

All Morgan horses exhibiting must be registered with the American Morgan Horse Association, Inc., The Canadian Morgan Horse Association or the British Morgan Horse Society or if under one year of age be eligible for registration.

**AMHA MEDAL CLASSES** Refer to USEF AMHA Medal class specifications outlined in Rules Mo164 and Mo167 -Mo172.

**TOURNAMENT DIVISION** open to all breeds: Morgan horses in this division may cross enter other classes at the show with a different rider. See Tournament Division for complete rules.

**HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:** All horses must have a copy of a negative Coggins test for EIA dated within 6 months of the show date. Foals may use the Coggins of dam. All horses must have a certificate to prove Eastern and Western Equine Encephalitis vaccination has been administered this year. Out of state horses require health certificate to enter state. All horses must have a certificate to prove Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations have been administered within the last six months.

**POST ENTRIES:** *Post entries will be accepted according to the hours posted in the Horse Show Office & must be made at least one session prior to the class.* Management reserves the right to decline a post entry in the case that such an entry would make it necessary for the class to be split. In such cases the exhibitor may elect to be placed on a waiting list to be entered in case of a scratch of a previously entered horse.

**SCRATCHES:** There will be a \$25 fee for each time an entry fails to notify the Show Secretary of a scratch prior to the start of a class.

**ENTRY BLANK:** *The Management and Staff take no responsibility for exhibitor errors.*

Owners: please use an additional entry blank and sign again, if you have more horses or equitation riders than a single entry blank allows.

**ENTRY FEES:** Unless otherwise noted, Regular classes \$30, Championship classes \$40, Championship Jackpot classes \$50, Breeder's classes \$100, and Dressage classes \$30.

**Non rated NEHC & NHH&TA classes are designated with ♦ and \* respectively in the prize list.**

**PAYMENT:** All initial fees must be made with entries. The show office will not accept partial payments from more than one person per horse from individuals sharing expenses. A signed blank check will be accepted. Visa, Mastercard and American Express are the only credit cards accepted.

**There will be a \$50 handling charge for all returned checks and declined credit cards.**

**There will be a \$50 fee charged for all accounts not settled at the show.** Any account not paid in full within 2 weeks of the end of the show will be reported to USEF & other affiliated organizations for appropriate action. See Rules common to all shows for more information.

**REFUNDS** will be made only upon receipt of a veterinarian's or doctor's certificate. No refunds on stall and camper fees after the closing date.

**EVERY CLASS** offered herein, which is covered by the rules and specifications of the NEHC will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

**CROSS ENTRIES** are **allowed** between Classic Pleasure, English Pleasure and Pleasure Driving Divisions. Cross entries are between **allowed** In Hand and Specialty In Hand sections. Horses entered in Tournament Division may be entered into any other class at the show with a different rider/driver.

**HEADERS AND TAILERS** must be at least 16 years of age.

**SHOW RING ATTIRE:** Exhibitors and attendants are required to observe proper show ring attire and decorum. No shorts, jeans or open toed shoes. Any person not properly attired shall be excused from the show ring. **Helmets approved for horseback riding (not bicycle helmets) are encouraged for all exhibitors and are mandatory for Lead Line classes & Tournament Classes.**

**MANAGEMENT RESERVES** the right to cancel or combine or split any class. Class changes will be posted in the Secretary's office.

**HOLDS** accepted at the discretion of the Show Manager only.

**WARM UP AREA:** No long lining of horses on the grounds. Lunging is allowed in the warm up area only when classes are not in session.

**PRIZE MONEY** will be awarded in the ring. Once the cash has been awarded the responsibility of the horse show will cease. Prize money for Breeder's Division will be mailed following the show per program rules.

**Qualifying: 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners in Morgan classes qualify for the Morgan Grand National & World Championships.**

**PRIZES:** Eight ribbons & an award will be given in all classes. Dressage division prizes per program rules. Jackpot Classes receive Champion level Ribbons, prize money and a percentage of the entry fees to the winner.

**AWARDS:** Due to loss and damage, challenge Trophies will be used only for presentation photo purposes in center ring. Winner will receive a plaque for their possession. Challenge Trophies will be awarded to the recipient only upon retirement of trophy.

**STABLING:** Box stalls with doors. Horse Stalls/Tack Stalls \$135 **STABLING MANAGER:** John Lampropoulos 603-770-1884. No Stalls will be reserved without payment in full. **Any stabling changes from original information on entry blank must be made the Show Secretary to ensure proper billing.** Any person requesting additional stalls for another person after receipt of original signed entry blank assumes responsibility for added stalls. All stalls reserved must be paid for even, if not used. If necessary tack stalls may be limited.

**ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURES:** Grounds will be open to exhibitors from Tuesday, July 4<sup>th</sup> at 8AM to Sunday at 12 noon.. Early arrivals or late departures must contact John Lampropoulos at 603-770-1884. **Additional daily fees of \$20 per stall apply.**

**HAY AND SHAVINGS** will be available on the grounds & must be paid directly to vendor. Availability hours will be posted. Contact John Lampropoulos, 603-770-1884 to pre-order. All preorders by July 1.

**FOOD SERVICE AND TACK SHOP** available on grounds.

**DOGS:** leash and clean up after all dogs. It is required that all animals on the grounds be vaccinated against Rabies. There is a \$50 fine for loose dogs, payable to Deerfield Fairgrounds.

**CAMPER/TENT PARKING** with or without electricity & water are available for \$185. Early

Arrivals: \$30 per day \$100 fine for dumping grey water anywhere on the grounds. Pumping is available.

**SHOW RING** (190' x 100') **FOOTING** is stone dust and sand. Warm-up arena (150' x 80') with stone dust and sand footing is available. Dressage arena (20m x 60m) footing is grass footing.

**OFFICE and HOSPITALITY:** Information regarding stall locations, grounds facilities, etc. will be available at the Horse Show office.

Messages may be left there & will be promptly relayed. Show office phone is 603-770-1884.

Coffee and doughnuts will be served each morning.

**MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT:**

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation.

Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

**In Hand Division**

Entries are to be judged individually, standing then at a walk & trot on the line & must be serviceably sound. Horses should stand with front legs perpendicular to the ground. Rear legs may be placed slightly back. The horse is also judged at some time during the class not stretched. Emphasis is placed on type and conformation with consideration given to horse's ability to move correctly on the lead. Unnatural tail carriage should be penalized. Not more than two handlers shall be allowed in the ring to show each horse in In Hand classes. No item may be used inside or outside the ring while showing the horse

except one whip per handler.

There is only one standard for type and conformation for the Morgan horse. Entry Fee: \$30.00

### **\$3500 Breeder's Division ♦\***

These classes are open to all Registered Morgans (or eligible for registration). There are no nomination fees or other restrictions. All registered Morgan Yearlings and Weanlings eligible for registration are invited. Exhibitors are encouraged to wear proper evening attire. **Complete rules are available at the show or mailed upon request.**

**Weanlings and Yearlings** will be paid to 10 places as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> \$1500, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$750, 3<sup>rd</sup> \$400, 4<sup>th</sup> \$250 and Fifth through and including tenth place \$100 each.

Prize money for Breeder's Division will be mailed following the show within 30 days. After any prize money is awarded, the responsibility of the Maine Morgan Breeder's Cup will cease.

**Trainers "\$1500 Triple Crown Award"** will be given to any trainer (or amateur handler signing as trainer) who wins the Weanling class three times or the Yearling class three times in a row.

Entries close at show closing date, however post entries **are** allowed. Entries made after close of the office Thursday morning are not guaranteed to be listed in the Breeder's Class program. Order of go will be posted in the Secretary's Office Friday afternoon. Any entry made after the order of go is posted will be the first entry to show.

## Morgan Amateur Owned, Trained & Shown Division ♦\*

Exhibitors, attendants, and headers must meet the specifications for Amateur status, GR1306. Horses are not to have been professionally trained during the current competition year (riding and driving instruction excluded). In addition, horses are not to be presented, prepared, groomed or schooled with the aid of a professional before or during the competition. Horses may be stabled with a professional during the competition and hauled by a professional. Professional help for situations relevant to safety is permitted.

Owner must sign as owner, trainer and rider/driver on the entry blank, will be strictly enforced. For definition of amateur owner, refer to MO104.9. All AOTS saddle classes qualify exhibitors for the respective Amateur Championship.
