WATERFRONT VILLAGE MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION AND AGREEMENT

THE VILLAGE: Waterfront Village (Village) is a neighborhood nonprofit corporation registered in the District of Columbia that aims to give residents of the Southwest Waterfront and Navy Yard neighborhoods resources that have the potential to make life easier and more enjoyable while they remain in their homes as they age. Village membership is open to all.

TERM: Membership is a 12-month term.

SERVICES/PROGRAMS: The Village provides services to its Full Members through a combination of paid staff and volunteers, at its sole discretion. For any services that are not provided through paid staff and the corps of vetted volunteers, such as major home repairs and home health-care needs, the Village will assist Member in finding a neighbor-referred vendor. Social/educational programs and activities are open to all Members. Full Member understands and accepts that Transportation Services may be provided by a combination of volunteers, shared ride services such as Lyft or Uber, and taxis using a variety of vehicle types, as well shuttles, or motor coaches, at the sole discretion of the Village. Member accepts that if he/she opts for a different form of travel other than that provided by the Village, a fee may be due the Village should it be able to arrange alternative transport for Member. Member further accepts that Village requires seven days advance notice of Transportation Services, and, that while Waterfront Village will make a reasonable effort to fulfill transportation requests with less than seven days notice, such transport may not be included with Member's complimentary benefits if a volunteer driver is not available. Member accepts that a cancellation within 24 hours of a scheduled ride forfeits that ride. The Village has met its obligation if the only vehicle type available is not accessible to the Member, and Member agrees to pay additional fees the Village might incur for a specific vehicle type.

MEMBERSHIP OPTIONS:

Annual Full Membership (\$625 per household):

Access to social activities, Member Services Concierge service, Friendly Companions, Homes Services, and Transportation Services. Offered to residents in the Southwest Waterfront and Navy Yard areas of the District of Columbia who have at least one household member aged 62 or more. Processing time approximately two weeks.

Annual Supporting Membership (\$300 per household):

Access to social activities, the Member Services call center service, and neighbor-referred vendors. All but \$100 of your dues are considered a donation for your tax purposes. Offered to all. Upgrade to Full Membership is immediate if needed with a \$100 discount on your first year if Full Membership.

Companion Membership (\$50 per person):

Access to social activities when accompanying a Supporting or Full Member. Enrollment is through a current Supporting or Full Member. Dues are waived if companion is needed for Member to participate in Village events.

PRIVACY: The Village will take all reasonable steps to protect the personal information of its Members. However, where concerns regarding a Member's health or safety arise, the Village reserves the right to contact the individual(s) listed as non-member contacts or other appropriate people, as determined by the Village. In addition, to connect a Member with a third-party vendor at the Member's request, the Village may disclose contact and other relevant information.

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WATERFRONT VILLAGE MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION AND AGREEMENT, CONTINUED

WAIVER OF LIABILITY: As a Member of the Village, Member understand that the Village is not affiliated with the third-party vendors it may refer, and releases the Village from all responsibility or liability stemming from the conduct of third party providers. Member further indemnifies and agrees to hold the Village harmless for any loss, expense or liability arising out of the activities of its employees or volunteers, including but not limited to any action Member, his/her heirs and assigns, or Member's insurance company might bring for negligence, personal injury or invasion of privacy.

- **As a Member of Waterfront Village, Member understands that the Village is not a provider of emergency services, home- or health-care services, a private case management service, nor a health-care administrator.**
- **Member specifically acknowledges that this Agreement is not meant to create any special relationship giving rise to or implying a Duty to Aid or Protect between him/herself and Waterfront Village.**
- **Member accepts that neither Village staff nor Volunteers are suitably trained to assist with Activities of Daily Living (ADL): Eating, bathing, getting dressed, toileting, transferring, and continence, and shall not be requested to do so.**

TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT: The Village reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to terminate this agreement, at any time, if the Village determines that it is in the best interest of the Village, its volunteers, other Members or the undersigned Member(s). If the Village terminates this agreement, it will return a portion of the annual fee paid on a prorated basis from the month of termination. The undersigned Member(s) may terminate this agreement at any time by providing written notice to the Village. If the Member(s) terminate(s) this agreement, no portion of the annual fee shall be refunded unless by prior agreement.
