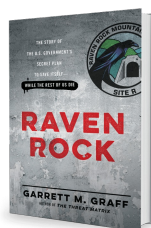

Senior Housing Coming to Southwest



CityPartners has worked diligently to conceptualize and design a 12-story, mixed-use building at 555 E Street, SW, that will include two dedicated floors with 58 units of senior housing for those 62 and older along with 136 market rate rental units on one portion of the site, and a 253-room European style hotel on the second portion. With 10,750 square feet of neighborhood-serving retail, 555 E Street SW aims to become a transformative building that will be an asset for the neighborhood just south of the National Mall.
