



VOLUNTEER CONFIDENTIALITY AGREEMENT

I _____ understand that Waterfront Village ("Village") has a legal and ethical responsibility to maintain the privacy and confidentiality of all member information. Any contact that I have with a member and any information shared with me by a member will remain private and confidential in the manner set forth in the policies and procedures of the Village:

- 1) I will not disclose any member information or discuss any such information with anyone except the Village Executive Director or other persons as determined by the Village Executive Director.
- 2) I will not make any unauthorized transmissions, copies, disclosures, inquiries, modifications or purging of member of Village information, nor will I use any Village subscriber lists for any usage without express written consent from Waterfront Village.
- 3) I will not access or knowingly view any proprietary information about Waterfront Village. If I have a question about whether to access proprietary information, I will ask the Village Executive Director before doing so.
