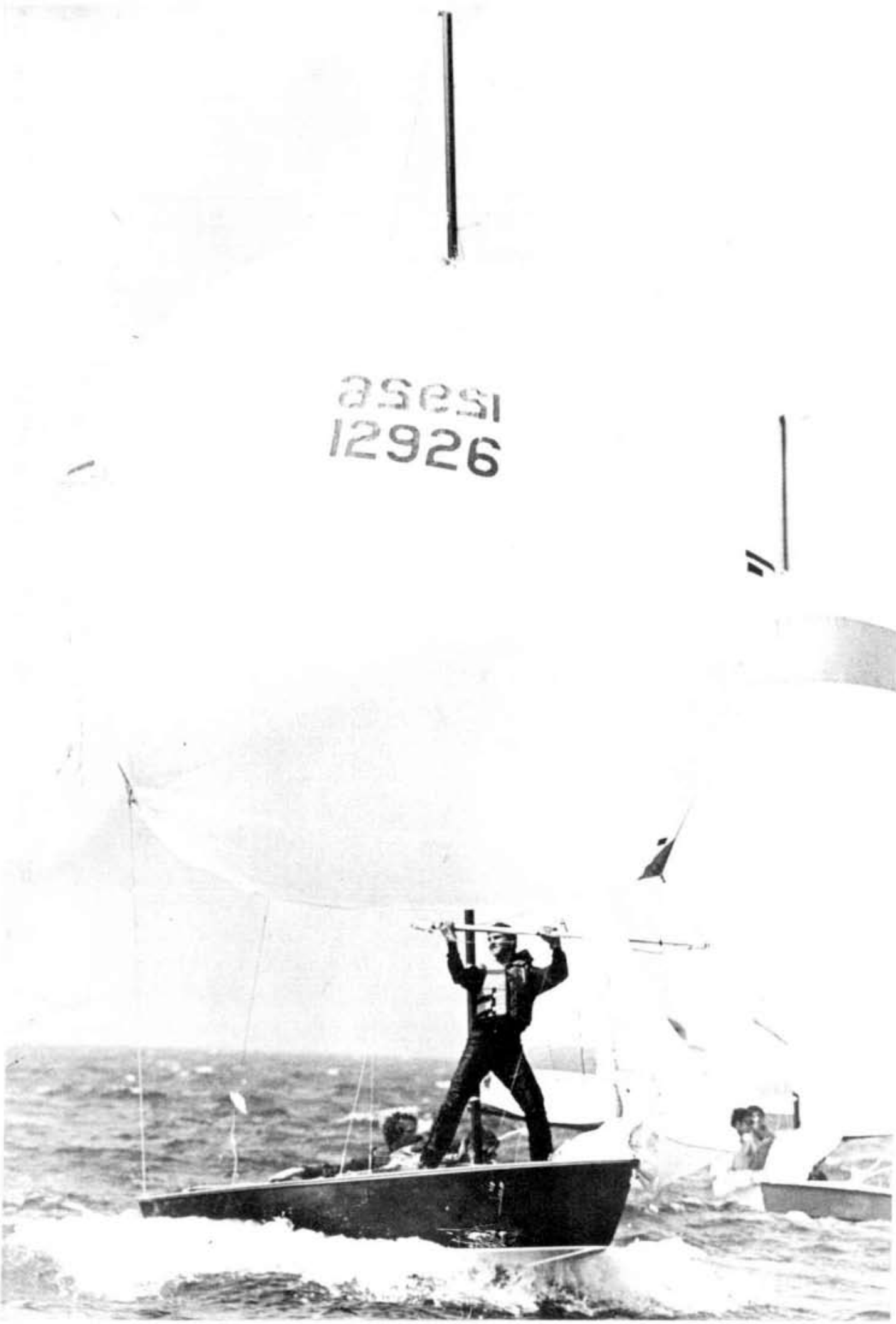

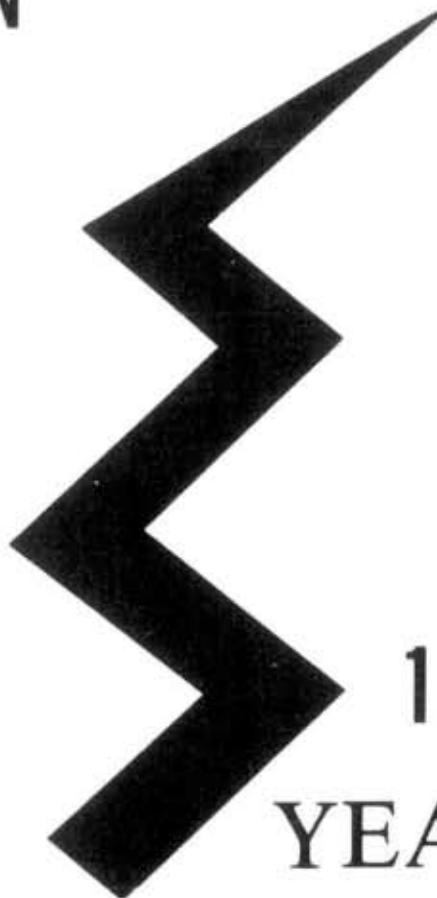


## ***PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE***
