Additional Information:

Housing: We are able to provide housing with host families to all teams for the duration of the event, beginning the evening of June 27th through the morning of July 2nd. Family, friends, coaches, etc. will be responsible for finding their own housing. A list of area hotels can be found <https://visitsheboygan.com/>, and we encourage you to book early as hotels fill up! Any sailors staying in non-provided housing must have an adult chaperone.

Meals: Included in the entry fee will be lunch and dinner on the 28th, 29th, 30th, and 1st. Extra tickets to the Opening and Closing Ceremonies will be available for purchase for extra guests.

Boats and Equipment: Boats will be provided and set up prior to the sailors' arrival. Teams are responsible for providing their own sails and life jackets.

Travel/Transportation: There is no major airport in Sheboygan. We are located about one hour from Milwaukee, WI (General Mitchell International Airport) and about 2.5 hours from Chicago (O'Hare International Airport). There is a shared ride van service that works quite well going to/from the Sheboygan area from Chicago or Milwaukee. www.goriteway.hudsonltd.net/res We will provide transportation for sailors between their host homes and venue, as well as to Harken and SEAS for an industry tour of their facilities.

Cost: We anticipate the entry fee will be \$500 per team.
