The Brazilian Sailing Federation has granted special assistance to the Brazilian Champions to participate in the Worlds, as a result of our renewed status as a PanAmerican Class.

The remaining 4 teams and additional slots to fill the South American Championship will be defined by two additional qualifiers to be held in May and June.
