See Solar, Cook Solar will educate, empower and enable opportunities for women and girls by providing solar lanterns and cookers to:

- * Enable study or work after dark;
- * Save time spent gathering fuel and associated risk of violence;
- * Provide opportunities for enterprise;
- * Reduce risk of burns and respiratory disease.

In the first year, the Appeal will help girls' education charity Camfed distribute solar lanterns to girls in Zambia and support a Soroptimist programme to provide solar cookers to women in Fiji.
