## When the time comes, have a plan:



Inform students and parents of **new procedures** in the studio.



Schedule lessons so there are **breaks between students**.



**Screen students** before entry. Deny entry to individuals with symptoms.



Ask students to **only bring items that are needed** for the lesson with them.



Students and teachers should **wash/sanitize their hands** often.

## Other considerations:

Consider using **video conferencing** instead of face-to-face meetings for high-risk scenarios.

Require **electronic payments** to avoid handling cash or cheques.

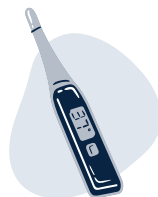
Both teacher and student should **wear face masks**.
