

# Attire for the Junior Sailor

**\*\*All equipment must be labelled with sailor's last name!**



**FOOTWEAR** - Required! Toes get injured easily if not protected. No sandals. No bare feet! "Water shoes" are a good option. Cost is about \$15.



**LIFE JACKET** - Required at ALL times when on water! A "sailing type" life jacket is required. "Water ski" type life jackets are discouraged as they are too bulky and get caught easily on boom or lines. Must fit snugly with working zipper. Cost is @\$80.



**SUNGLASSES/HAT**- Much needed but easy to lose. Don't wear your favorite one! Label with name. Croakies are a must to keep losing glasses.



**WATCH** - Not necessary for first year sailors. Required for racing sailors to time start sequences. Must have a count down timer on it. Cost is about \$35.



**SAFETY WHISTLE** - Required to be tied onto lifejacket at ALL times in case of emergency. Safety whistle is to be used ONLY in case of emergency. Cost is @ \$5.



**SAILING GLOVES** - Personal preference. Not needed for beginners. May be needed for sailors racing or spending long hours on the water. Cost is about \$25.



**WATER BOTTLE** - Keep in boat and refill in Junior Clubhouse before leaving to sail. Purchase a bottle from SBYC w/ SBYC logo on it! Be sure to label with name.
