Calabogie Motorsports Park – a Rain or Shine Event!

The BMW Motorcycle Club of Ottawa is offering a one-day **Advanced Rider Training (ART)** for novice and intermediate riders, **Monday May 27, 2019**, at the Calabogie Motorsports Park (CMP).

ART is for you if you want:

- to improve your skill and confidence in cornering;
- to improve your bike handling skills by learning through theory and on track practice with experienced coaches.

Objective: Accessible education and training for Club members to improve riding skills in a controlled environment. The program includes classroom and supervised track sessions.

Groups: Riders will be grouped according to skill level. All class time and assessments will be led by instructors with safe riding training and track experience. If you are a cautious or less-experienced rider, please let us know and we will make sure you are riding in a compatible group.

Riding Apparel: All riders must wear MOT approved full-face helmets, one or two-piece motorcycle (armoured) riding suits, gloves and boots.

Inspections: All motorcycles must pass a technical inspection and sound check.

Registration and Cost: Please register online at <https://www.bmwcottawa.ca/art-full-registration/>. Cost is \$290 for members of BMW Motorcycle Club of Ottawa, members of MOA/RA or BMW Clubs Canada and its official member clubs. Fee for non-member is \$330. Registration is limited to 50 participants. Payment must be received by 1 April 2018 or your registration will be discarded. You may do an **Interac** transfer to **bmwOTT.Bank@gmail.com** or pay by cheque (payable to BMW Motorcycle Club of Ottawa) and mailed to BMW Motorcycle Club of Ottawa, P.O. Box 8503 Main Terminal, Ottawa ON K1G 3H9. This is a Rain or Shine event. No cancellations will be accepted after May 1st. Substitutions may be possible if replacement riders are available.

ATTENTION. A valid motorcycle driver's license is required. Also, the liability insurance coverage included in the ART School fee is for the benefit of Calabogie Motorsports Park and the BMW Motorcycle Club of Ottawa.
