2009 Rotating Charity Nominees

Saint Cloud's Rescue

St. Cloud's Rescue, a 501c3 non-profit since 2003, is dedicated to saving the lives of Saint Bernard's that have been abandoned, surrendered, injured and/or abused. They currently house between 38-40 St. Bernard's. They provide all necessary medical care including, spaying or neutering, all life saving immunizations and any other treatment prescribed by the veterinarian during each dog's preliminary medical visit. This includes heartworm treatment to those that come to us heartworm positive. This required treatment is very expensive in order to save the dog's life; they have treated nine dogs for this disease at the cost of \$600 each just this year alone. They receive calls from all DFW city shelters and many individuals, that for a multitude of reasons can no longer care for their saint, asking for our assistance and taking ownership of these loving dogs.

On an annual basis, \$38,000 - \$40,000 is spent caring for these dogs.

Medicine -	\$12,000
Veterinary Services -	\$12,000
Food -	\$ 9,000
Cleaning supplies -	\$ 3,000
Dog Supplies -	\$ 3,000

Training is also an important part of our facility in order to make the living environment stable for the dogs. They rehabilitate dogs both physically and emotionally. This facility is unique from other rescue organizations in that they provide an open home environment vs. a kennel or caged environment. This introduction to a home environment prepares the dog for its forever home that they seek to find for each saint.

Three families with physically challenged children have recently adopted

dogs. The saints help the children to walk in their own home and to live a more normal life. Saints enjoy children, work to assist their owners and are wonderful life long companions.

As a non-profit organization, they are only able to exist and to save these valuable lives by your charitable donations. Contributions of any amount, large or small, will help this program continue. All donations are tax deductible and every dollar received goes to the well-being of these amazing gentle giants.

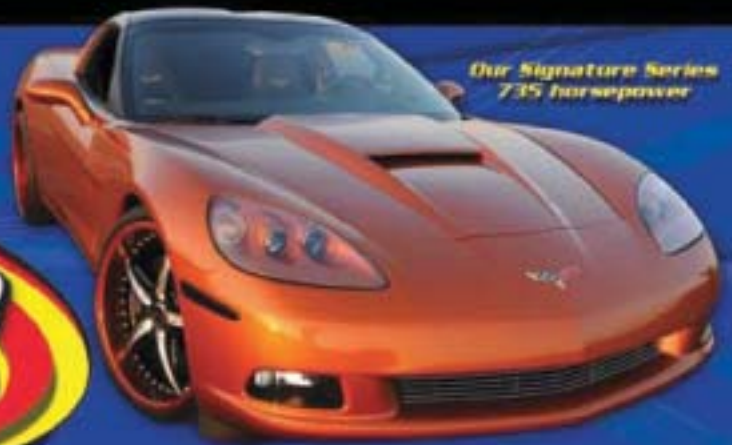

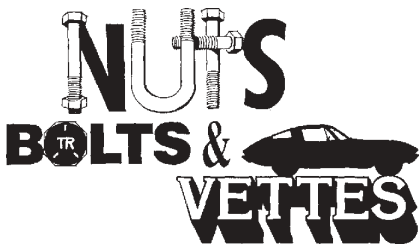
