There were approximately 135 members in attendance. Mr. Hester introduced the 2006 Club officers. Sandy Conwell asked for a motion to approve the February minutes as published in the March newsletter; the motion was approved.

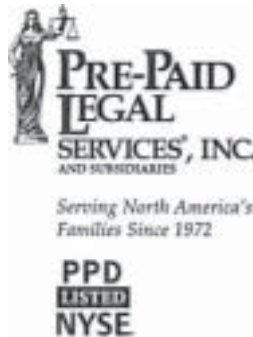

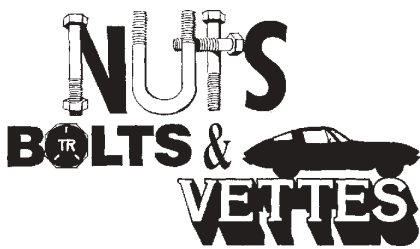
