in the November newsletter; the motion was approved. Greg reminded members to submit any changes in their information to Terry by no later than the December meeting for publication in the January directory.

Greg asked Lisa Paton to come forward and present a check to Heroes for Children, the rotating charity chosen for 2006. Sharon Lawson, a director of the charity, accepted and thanked the Club for its consideration and generous donation. Greg stated that presentations for our 2007 rotating charity will be taken from members at the January meeting.

Tim Dowding presented the October financial statement. Beginning balance was \$38,723.11 with deposits of \$5,551.71 and expenses of \$14,641.77, leaving a balance of \$29,633.05 as of October 31, 2006. Tim asked for a motion to approve the October financial statement as presented; the motion was approved.

Sandy Conwell discussed the changes to the Club bylaws and financial policy as published in the November newsletter. There was one discrepancy regarding an associate member's eligibility to vote, the correct fact being an associate member does have the right to vote as currently stated in the bylaws. Sandy asked for a motion to approve the changes including the latter as published in the November newsletter; the motion was approved.

Steve Jones announced the names of members who had been nominated at the October meeting for officer positions for 2007. He asked for any additional nominations for each position. Candidates will publish a short "bio" in the December newsletter and ballots will be included. Ballots can be mailed in the enclosed envelope or brought to the December meeting for final tabulation and election.

Lou Opihare, representing the new Club shirt committee, displayed the four choices of shirts finalized by the committee. Each shirt comes in men's and women's sizes as well as polo style and long sleeve and is made of breathable material. Ballots will be included in the December newsletter. It was determined by the Committee and Officers that the top two shirts voted by members will be accepted as official Club shirts. Greg Hester then adjourned the business meeting.

Open Road Racing

Well everyone, the 2006 Open Road Race season is over & it's time to count participation points for the 2006 LSCC Awards to be announced at the LSCC Christmas Party.

Here are the rules we raced under this year: (If you want to change the rules for the 2007 season, please let us know and we will put it to a vote).

LSCC Open Road Race Team of the Year:

Six (6) points for each 1st place finish.
 Four (4) points for each 2nd place finish.
 Three (3) points for each 3rd place finish.
 Two (2) points for each 4th place finish.
 One (1) point for each 5th place finish.
 Two (2) points for each Road Race you compete in within a calendar year.
 One (1) point for any other "official" not joke awards you might get at a race - like Cars Show

Any ties will be decided to the team with the lowest difference between their actual MPH and the target MPH for their class.

LSCC Open Road Race Navigator of the Year:

A trophy will be awarded to the navigator with the lowest difference between their actual MPH and the target MPH for their class. Results must be posted and verifiable by the governing organization & reflect the sponsoring group's certified MPH. This is a navigator award - solo drivers do not compete.

LSCC Open Road Race Rookie Team of the Year

A trophy will be awarded to the team in which the driver and navigator are competing in their first sanctioned Open Road Race in 2006.

A trophy will be awarded to the team with the lowest average difference between their actual MPH and the target MPH for their class.

Point Scoring Requirement:

Results must be posted by the governing organization & reflect the sponsoring group's certified MPH.

In order to earn race points, you must be a member of LSCC @ the time of the race

A Driver can only qualify for driver points (if you're a driving, you're a driver).

A Navigator can only qualify for Navigators points.

Teams that decide to Co-drive & co-navigate will split the driver & navigator points for the events that they decide to co-drive in.

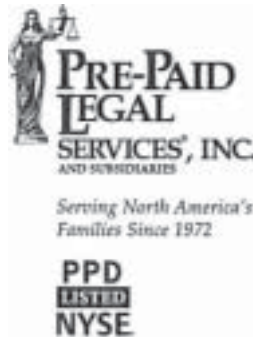

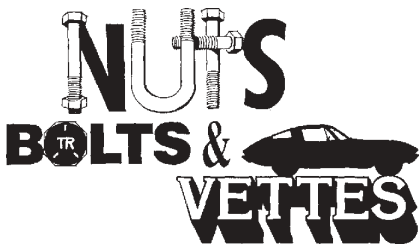
