Judy welcomed 5 guests. Amanda Opihare asked for a motion to approve new members as published in the Dec. newsletter. The motion was seconded and approved. She announced we now have 543 memberships with 947 members.

Kelly Davis reported that the club has \$5010 in checking, \$11,107 in raffle account plus our \$10,735 high yield CD. She asked for a motion to approve the treasurer's report. It was seconded and all approved.

Ken Hill asked for a motion to approve the Nov. minutes as published in the Dec. Newsletter. The motion was seconded and approved. He then thanked Judy for her support as President this past year and said goodbye as this was his last official duty as Recording Secretary.

Judy presented a check for \$2500 to Mr. Hester from Cedar Valley College for their Automotive scholarship fund.

Judy reminded the membership that we will be taking nominations for the rotating charity for next year and to bring them for the January meeting. They will then be published in the Feb. Newsletter and voted on at the Feb. meeting.

Judy presented Linda Walker with the Lone Star Award for 2008.

Judy recognized Winona Spinks as the Club's official Public Relations person.

Judy displayed two plaques the Club has received. One is from the Children's Speedway Charity for our contribution of \$16,700 this year. The other is from the National Corvette Museum for all our support over the years. They will be on display at Young Chevrolet.

Judy asked for those who have birthdays for Dec. to raise their hands. We sang Happy Birthday and offered cake to all.

NCM

News

Board Meeting

We were in Bowling Green in early December for the NCM board meeting. The report from the Museum was a mixed bag, but mostly good.

As could be expected in the current economic situation, attendance is down 15%. Donations are down slightly, but membership is up by 4,000 to 32,406. Thanks to all of you who joined or renewed in 2008. While overall receipts are down, the Museum staff has done an excellent job controlling costs and keeping the operation in the "black".

Speaking of in the black, the expansion project is on schedule and under budget by about \$20,000.00 The store and Museum delivery/experience operations will be moving into their new digs in February. Total completion is still expected in July.

GM Woes Affecting NCM

General Motors' financial woes are being felt at the NCM. Museum deliveries of new Corvettes have dropped significantly in recent months. Then on December 12 it was announced that the plant will be closed from Christmas week until the first of March, stopping all Museum deliveries for over two months.

In mid-December another blow was dealt when GM announced it was selling 200 cars from its Heritage Collection at Barrett-Jackson to raise operating funds. Thirty of the cars are Corvettes. Two of these, the LeMans Pace Car and the Purple Smash ZR-1 were in the Museum. While the loss is regrettable, it could be worse. GM's policy concerning its unique cars is to not donate, but loan long term. As a consequence NCM has a sizeable number of cars owned by GM. It is hoped these 200 cars will be all that are sold.

- 2 2nd Place/Class Award/(ISCA “Outstanding”)
- 3 3rd / 4th, etc. (ISCA “Winner”)

Mileage (Actual miles round-trip for event only - sorry no “family visits” included)

Corvettes only - driven or trailer-ed anywhere to an organized event* (no other member owned vehicle)

All miles for event are included even if event is only 1 mile from your home

Miles are awarded to the car, not the participant
If car is replaced during season, points roll to replacement Vette

*Event Examples:

- LSCC Meetings
- Road Races (to, from & race miles)
- Drag Races (ditto above)
- Khanas (ditto above)
- Car Shows, Parades, Cruises / Caravans
- Club Events (including Classic)

Participation

Points/hours are awarded to the Person

Hours

Volunteering at events such as, Dallas Autorama; Fort Worth Rod & Custom Show; Dallas Auto (New Car) Show; State Fair; Eureka Springs Poker Run assistant, etc.

Points are given in lieu of hours for the following:

25 Points for each day you participate on a committee during Classic weekend
25 Bonus points (additional) if you volunteer all 3 days
100 Bonus points (additional) for being a committee coordinator. Includes all Pre-Classic duties

LSCC Meetings

10 Points for meeting attendance

Sponsor New LSCC Members

10 Points per new member

LSCC Group Trips (i.e. Eureka Springs; VOTR; Wichita Falls, BBORR, Drags, etc.)

50 Points for trip organizer
25 Points for group leader
10 Points for participating

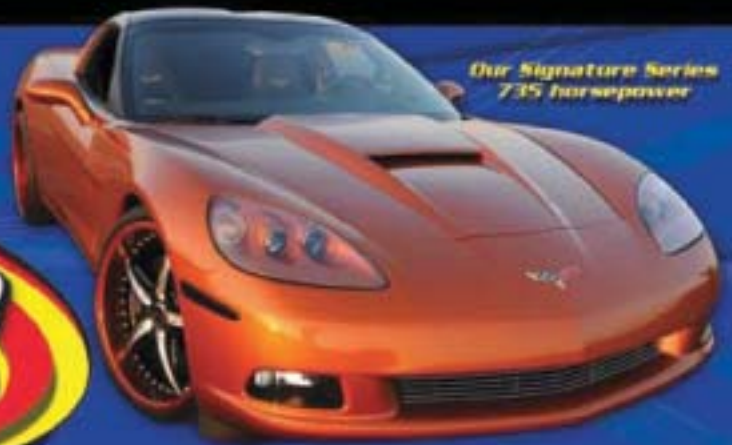

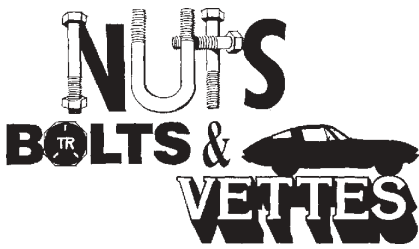
