For the benefit of new members and a reminder to "old" members, the following states the purpose of and criteria for the Lone Star Award. If you want to nominate a member for outstanding service to the Club, please submit your request with a short explanation to any Club officer who will formally present your nominee at an Officers Meeting for consideration.

The Lone Star Award was created March, 1997. The LSCC Lone Star Award is presented to a membership who has consistently contributed to the LSCC for a sustained length of time and reflects a positive image of the LSCC. Any member may present a membership to the Officers for special recognition. A unanimous vote from the Officers is required. In order to be eligible, the membership has to have been an LSCC member for a minimum of 18 continuous months. No current officer or non-voting members are eligible for the award. The membership that receives the award is someone that the majority of the club members will recognize as having made a major contribution to the Club. Nomination forms are available from the Club secretary.

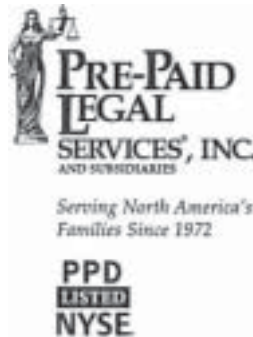

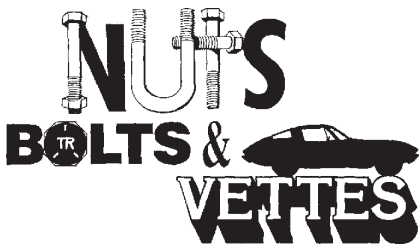
