Texas Lions Camp for special children 16 years old or younger.

Each year LSCC will donate to certain charities with a portion of the proceeds from our LSCC Classic Event. This year you have elected to sponsor "The Texas Lions Camp for Children with Disabilities". This camp is for children with special medical conditions and will allow children with disabilities to attend this wonderful summer camp outside of Kerrville Texas. The camp has been in continual operation since 1949.

The primary purpose of the Camp is to provide, without charge, a camp for physically disabled, hearing/vision impaired, diabetic, and children who have cancer from the State of Texas, regardless of race, religion, or national origin. For most of our attendees, it is the first time for them to ever attend a summer camp. The first time for them to ever take part in outdoor sports activities. The first time to really play with a whole group of kids their own age & with their own "restrictions".

The total expense for the children is paid by the Texas Lions Clubs, none of the attendees are charged for their "once in a lifetime" experience. We even pay for their transportation to and from camp if necessary. This year we have scheduled ten (10) camp secessions, last year we had 1523 campers successfully attend our camps. The Texas Lions Camp is recognized as a nonprofit corporation, under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Service Code.

The show is Saturday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Early registration will be held from 3:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on Friday. The host hotel is the Holiday Inn Express, 580/237-7722. Corvette Weekend Hot Springs, Arkansas April 17 - 19

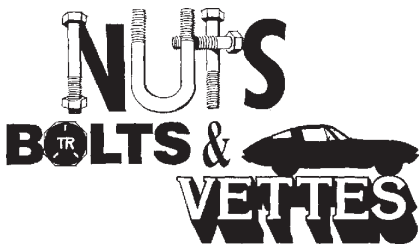
