Sandy Conwell asked for a motion to approve the August minutes as published in the September newsletter; the motion was approved.

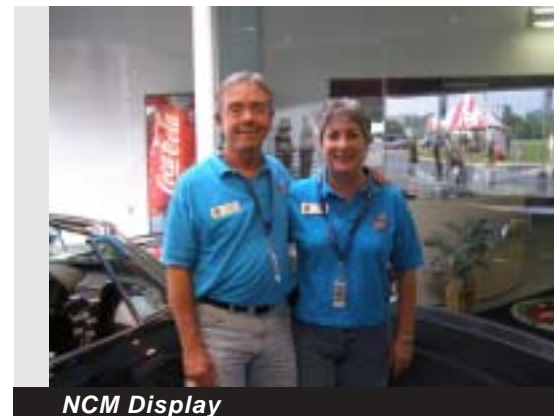
Mr. Hester welcomed new members/guests. Terry Garrett asked for a motion to approve new members who joined in August as published in the September newsletter; the motion was approved.

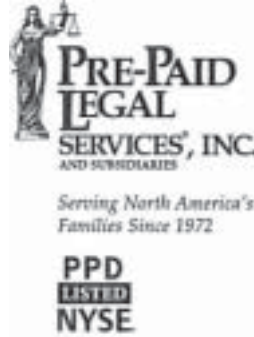

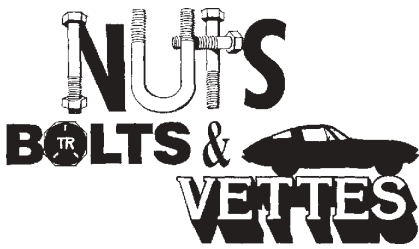
