How can you not love this car show event when you have the Rocky Mountains as your playground??!! It is truly the ultimate Corvette experience—not only do you drive through harrowing twists and turns but you also have the added benefit of high altitude. Add speed to the equation (Curtis had us up to 125+ on one straight-away), and the Rockies really rock! 16 cars participated in VOTR with 14 cars caravanning; and it was a great, well driven caravan even with 14 cars. Thanks to Sandy Galletta who provided us with bound booklets containing informative trivia on each of the cities we traveled through as well as copies of our attendee list, route directions, mileage, and maps—thank goodness she didn't give us a test after arrival!

Looking Glass Corvette Association hosted a fun-filled celebration for their 35th anniversary. As usual their members were friendly, hospitable, always available, and very informative. We had a nice surprise in the vendor area. On display was the metal frame with motor of the new ZR1 as well as a complete 2009 ZR1—what a driving machine, both in looks and under the hood! There were a couple of changes to the format this year. There was not a Friday road rally but rather we were provided six day trips to choose from and follow on our own. Also Friday afternoon there was an English Tea and Fashion Show for the ladies but I don't think any of us returned from our road trips in time to attend. 9 cars ventured up Mt. Evans at 14,264 ft. elevation, the highest paved road in the U.S., definitely not for the faint of heart but what an exhilarating ride! A few other LSCC attendees drove to Central City to try their luck at the casinos or took

other day trips, but we also saved time to do some serious shopping as well.

Beaver Run Resort did a great job accommodating all the participants and provided ample car washing space. The food and service was good and the ambience superb. They did have some problems with parking, non-Corvettes parking in the garage areas reserved for Corvettes and also too many Corvettes. I think LGCA and Beaver Run may be suffering from over-popularity: when you're too successful with your event and location, how do you control your success?! (The event sold out within 36 days of open registration which began March 1.) We did have one mishap which shook us up a little, however. The parking garage door came down on Phil Key's forehead while he was walking through—thankfully it wasn't deep and the wound was "glued" together and Phil didn't miss a thing. Corvette drivers are a tough breed!

Saturday night during the dessert buffet we were also treated with talks by John Heinricy, Engineering Director of the Performance Division of GM and Dave Hill, retired Chief Engineer of Corvette who told me he still receives our LSCC Newsletter. During a pregnant pause when Mr. Heinricy was asked a question from the audience regarding the performance difference between the F55 handling package on the C6 and the new ZR1, Darrell Jackson spontaneously blurted out \$60,000 (he didn't think he had said it so loudly) and brought the house down with laughter. Mr. Heinricy never did answer the question after that!

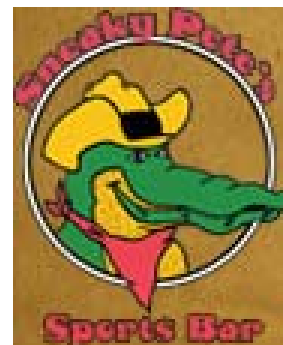
COME ON OUT AND BE PART OF THE SOCIAL EVENT OF THE YEAR.

Historic Motorama II:

On September 10, our very own Curtis and Sharon Troster will depart from the National Corvette Museum as members of Historic Motorama II. Their 1991 ZR1 will be part of a caravan consisting of one Corvette of each year from 1953 through 2009. The three day journey from Bowling Green will arrive in Detroit, Michigan in time to help kick off General Motors' 100th Anniversary Celebration. Curt's and Sharon's car was chosen from several hundred submitted.

Original Build Sheets:

The Museum has obtained a limited number of original Corvette build sheets from the Corvette Assembly Plant and this collectible piece of memorabilia can be another way to document your Corvette.

NCM has random build sheets on Corvettes produced from 2002-2007 that are "not" reproduction copies. Many are marked, tattooed and worn from the journey through the build process. Build sheets are available at \$40 for NCM members and \$50 for non-members. Hexagon Bricks:

2008 Corvette Revue Shreveport, LA September 5 - 6

Corvettes and casinos - a pretty good combinations, but there's more. The fun starts with a road tour to Jefferson on Friday with an optional riverboat tour, followed by a hospitality night. The car show Saturday is at a great venue, Festival Plaza in downtown Shreveport.

North Texas Corvette Roundup Wichita Falls, Texas September 19 - 20

Us "oldtimers" remember when the roundup was at the falls and it was great. This year it is back at the Holiday Inn at the falls. What makes it so great? The race consisted of six events this year,

1. New this year was a ½ mile drag races – no brackets, hust head to head with anyone you wanted to race.

3. a Racers Parade through town with kids in your car.
4. a Car Show.
5. a "burnout contest" for those that wanted to destroy their tires .. a Mustang Corba won that contest (he got a \$12 trophy for \$200 worth of tire rubber)
6. the Open Road Race.

The LSCC members once again represented the club well with the following results:

There was a team trophy and LSCC won 3rd place.

The Racers Parade was a lot of fun with radio, newspaper and TV coverage. Each of the racers was asked to let a local child ride in the parade with them and a lot of the kids wore the race helmets & were

strapped into the cars just like racers, what a neat sight and fun for all.

The car show had many beautiful & unique vehicles in it and the town as a whole loved looking at the race cars.

The burnout contest stunk of burning rubber & no LSCC members took part.

The Open Road Rally course was rough, windy, up & down, and just as tough a race course as any of us had seen. It had 78 hazzards (turns, dips, whoop de dos, etc.) in the 55 mile run. Both driver & navigator were kept very busy, but we all did well.

The awards picnic (held in the city park, with over 600 attendees), was wonderful, full of kids and family's and the best corn on the cob you could ever want to taste and we won lots of the trophy's as well.

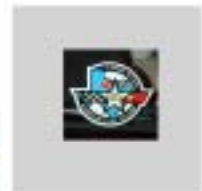

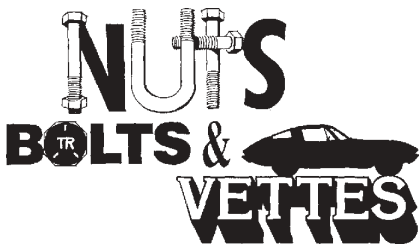
