Of note, bring a check book as there will not be a cashier at this Sunday meeting.

## Drag Racing

# Bonneville 100

The Lone Star Corvette Club had one member run the Bonneville 100 this year.

The race is a very exciting race and is run on Highway 93A just out of Wendover, NV, home of the famous Bonneville Salt Flats.

Race headquarters was at The Wendover Nugget Hotel and Gabbling Hall. What a beautiful place to stay. The hotel itself has just been completely remodelled, the food was good and cheap, and if you chose to gamble, it was available.

The race was run on July 13-16, 2006, and Tom Whalen was the only LSCC club member to go race. Tom's wife (Bernadine)'s brother Ron Kopacko was Tom's navigator.

There was a general practice session on a 10-mile closed section of the actual race road on Friday, along with Rookie Qualifying, to give everyone a chance to loosen up their machines and check their speedometers against their radar guns.

On Saturday, everyone puts their machines proudly on display in the park for the spectators in a Car Show, and there will be "Car Games," plus, of course, a lot of "bench racing" going on! Saturday evening, you will attend a mandatory Driver's Safety Meeting.

Then, early Sunday morning, the real fun begins about 8:00 AM, when you are given the green flag! After the run, and lots of story-swapping, there is an Awards Banquet at the host hotel, where the victors earn their trophies and bragging rights!

Tom's Corvette performed flawlessly – no warning messages this time, the new oil coolers (engine, transmission and differentials) did their job and also Tom did not get disqualified. So all in all it was a very good race.

Tom & his navigator ran in the Grand Sport Upper class with a target speed of 150mph. There were 9 cars in the class and they finished 5<sup>th</sup>. Just to show everyone how tough these races are, Tom was only 1.899 seconds quick and averaged 150.117mph. That's pretty darn close to get 5<sup>th</sup> place. Tom says he ran very close to his tech speed of 168 MPH, and his corvette felt like there was more to be gotten if he had tried...

It is a long haul to get to Wendover but the effort was worth it – it was a fun race. Already the anticipation is running high for the jaunt to Arnold.
