2018 YOUTH SAIL TEAM PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

Welcome to the CRYC Youth Sail Team! We are excited that you have decided to join the team and we look forward to a successful sailing season. The CRYC Youth Sail Team supports the mission of CRYC to promote the sport of sailing by encouraging teamwork, leadership and commitment and sportsmanship. CRYC Youth Sail Team members represent CRYC at local and regional regattas and often develop friendships with sailors at other yacht clubs. CRYC sailors are expected to exhibit appropriate behavior at all times that will reflect positively on the team, CRYC and themselves and assist other sailors whenever possible.

The ability of the CRYC Youth Sail Team to attend and participate in regattas is largely dependent on parent/guardian support and volunteerism. Responsible adults are needed to transport sailors and boats to and from regattas, to support the MAYRA Junior Regatta held at CRYC and to provide such other assistance as the team may need throughout the season. If a sailor can not attend a scheduled practice or planned regatta due to illness, vacation or other commitment, he or she must advise the coach as soon as possible so that transportation and equipment needs can be anticipated.

Sailing is weather and wind dependent. Practices and regattas may be cancelled or delayed if weather conditions are unfavorable or unsafe. Coaches and team representatives will endeavor to keep parents and sailors advised of changing conditions and scheduled events as the need arises.

All sailors are expected to assist with boat loading and packing prior to regatta(s) and assist with boat unloading after regatta(s). When sailors are using boats owned by CRYC or other yacht clubs, they are expected to use the equipment with the utmost care and respect and immediately advise a coach or team representative if part(s) are broken or missing. Although host clubs and coaches will attempt to limit all risk to youth sailors, sailing remains an inherently dangerous activity. Sailors and parents must assume all risks of participation.

In addition to the team participation fee, members of the CRYC Youth Sail Team are expected to be current calendar year members (either junior or family) of CRYC and youth sailors using club-owned boats must be CRYC community sailing members as well. Sailors will be required to purchase a "pinney cover" to be worn over their PFD at regattas so that they can be easily identified as a member of the CRYC Youth Sail Team. Additional team wearables for youth and adults will be available for purchase. Sailors self-register for each regatta in which they are participating and are will be responsible for paying all registration fees at the time of registration. For 2018, the team participation fee is \$600.00 per individual sailor. Families registering multiple sailors enjoy a 20% discount (\$480.00) for the second or more sailors from the same household. Separate registration is required.

I/We agree to release and hold harmless members, employees, instructors, coaches and representatives of the Cooper River Yacht Club and agree to indemnify and hold each of them harmless for any claims, costs, suits, actions, judgments and expenses arising from our child's participation in activities related to the CRYC Youth Sail Team. I/We understand that participation in the proposed 2018 regatta schedule is not guaranteed and that the sailor's ability to participate may be limited or affected based upon weather conditions and other factors.

I/We give our consent and authorize the agents, servants and/or representative of CRYC to consent on our behalf and on behalf of our child to emergency medical care and treatment in the event we are unable to be notified by reasonable attempts of the need for such emergency medical care and treatment.
