After setting up your personal info, you're ready to start getting into the forums. There are only a few default forums all members are automatically associated with. In order to be part of a forum and make it one of your "Optional forums", you need to click on each one of these Green On buttons. What the hell, go ahead and click all of them. The next step after you add them, will be to go back to "Forum General Preferences" and set your defaults for how you want all of them to behave. I would not suggest editing each of them individually, unless you have a lot of time on your hands.

After you select your forums, you will need to go to "Forum Preferences" and tell all of them how to behave; when to alert you someone posted there, how you want to receive the alerts and all that stuff.

After selecting all your Forums, go to “Forum General Preferences” and select how all your Forums will be handled.
