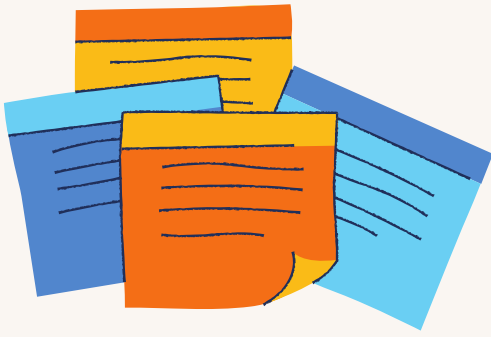




Creative Note-taking Strategies for Students



Use Hyperdocs
