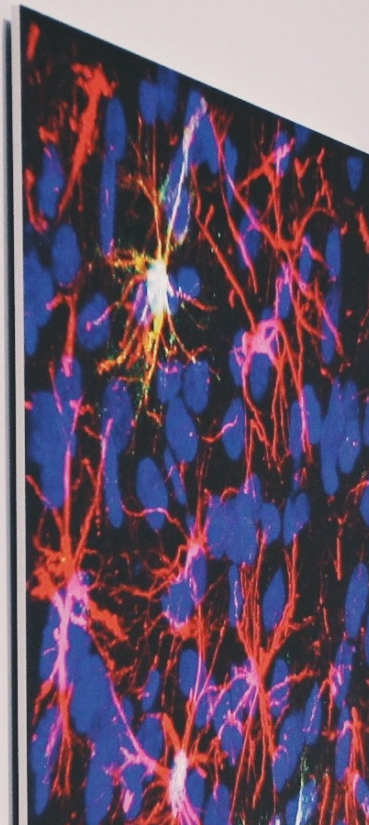

White matter fiber bundles in the human brain are organized during prenatal and neonatal periods following birth. Magnetic resonance imaging, or MRI, is the primary method used for studying the developing human brain in vivo. We can use a special type of MRI called diffusion tensor MRI, which captures diffusion patterns of water molecules in brain tissue, to trace bundles of axon tracts in the brain. Using this

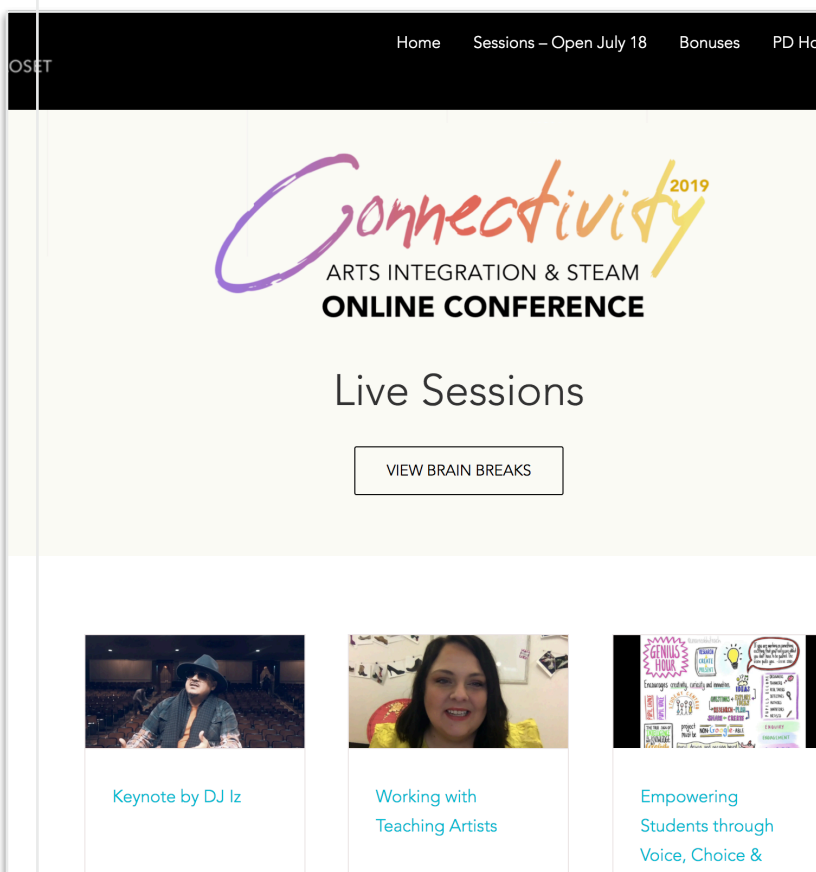
Remember that you already have on-demand site access. You can login there now to view the breakout sessions.
