NELSON SHOW JUMPING SEPTEMBER SHOW CONDITIONS

- 1. This competition is run under ESNZ rules www.nzequestrian.org.nz
- 2. Riders entered in registered (i.e. non-introductory classes) must be full members of ESNZ.
- 3. Riders in all introductory classes must have an annual ESNZ Introductory membership or pay a casual membership of \$15 per day.
- 4. Hacks entering national series classes and HOYQ need an ESNZ Equine Registration and Jumping Discipline start. A Casual Equine Jumping levy of \$20 for the show can be used to compete up to 1.10 on a hack, no National Series Points of HOYQ will be awarded. Ponies entering national series classes and HOYQ need an ESNZ Equine Registration and Jumping Discipline start. A Casual Equine Jumping levy of \$20 can be used to compete up to 1.0m on a pony, no National Series Points of HOYQ will be awarded. All hacks and ponies pay an ESNZ jumping levy of \$5, and a \$5 ground levy these are compulsory.
 - 5. All entry fees and charges to be paid at time of entry:
- 6. Scratching's are to be notified to the Secretary the day before or by 7.30am prior to the commencement of the day's competition.
 - 7. Refunds less fixed admin costs 25% on proof of the horse's inability to compete. No refunds will be considered if not notified prior or during the show.
 - 8. There may be testing for prohibited substances during the show.
 - 9. Formal turnout for all registered and series class riders. Club uniform and tidy dress encouraged for all introductory class riders.
 - 10. The organisers reserve the right to alter or delete the programme/ prize money / substitute product as they see fit.
 - 11. Qualification refer Annex 8 Article 32.
 - 12. Back numbers must be worn.

- 13. Prize money is to be paid by direct credit.
- 14. GST: All entry fees and prize money is GST inclusive.
- 15. Approved safety helmets must be worn. 16. Committee reserve the right to not accept an entry.

17. All riders must comply with ESNZ Health and Safety regulations. All competitors are competing at their own risk.
