COVID-19 REQUIREMENTS WHILE COMPETEING AT CARTOWN 2022 NORTH ISLAND CHAMPIONSHIP

We are currently working on operating under the "RED" requirements as described on [Public and private gatherings at Red | Unite against COVID-19 \(covid19.govt.nz\)](#). Should there be a change in levels, we will email details of how we will be operating.

Vaccination passes are mandatory for anyone entering this event or coming onto the show grounds during the event.

Children under the age of 12 years and 3 months do not need to provide a My Vaccine Pass to enter places with a vaccination requirement.

Under the "RED" requirements we will be operating with the 100 person bubbles as described at [Covid Protection Framework Toolkit | ESNZ \(nzequestrian.org.nz\)](#). Any change to this will be updated via email and on our facebook page. All riders will need to declare their support people when they enter. Any persons not registered with Evoevents will be denied entry to the grounds.

Masks are no longer required at outdoor areas but if you are inside or unable to maintain social distancing, please wear a mask.

You must be physically well to attend our event. If you are unwell, awaiting test results, or displaying any Covid-19 symptoms you must stay home and must not attend the show.

Physical distancing of 2m must be undertaken at all times.

Every person entering the grounds MUST scan the QR code at the entrance.

Good personal hygiene practices should continue – wash and dry your hands before and after activities, cough into your elbow and don't touch your face.

Failure to comply with these regulations may result in elimination and removal from the grounds.

ENTRY CONDITIONS

Online entries close with Evo Events on the 25th of March 2022 OR ONCE EVENT IS AT CAPACITY.

All entries will be expected to pay at the time of entry and will not be confirmed until full payment has been received.

No postal or email entries will be accepted unless special arrangements are made with the show secretary (wendy.cdevents@gmail.com).

Late entries may be accepted if there is capacity with 50% late entry fee till 5pm night before the class. At the discretion of the organising committee

GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. All classes run under ESNZ rules.
2. Committee reserves the right to alter the programme.
3. Ring 1 to be run in strict draw order and takes precedence over other rings. Ring 2 will run in draw order but there will be some flexibility if you are competing in ring 1 (within reason). Ring 3 will run in black board order.
4. Please ensure registrations and memberships are up to date. Failure to do so may result in loss of points, placing's, prize money after the show and may result in rider being fined under ESNZ Jumping conditions.
5. Horses/ponies can compete under casual levy system for non-series classes and no higher than 1.10m for horses and 1.00m for ponies but riders must be fully registered. Introductory members can only compete in INTRODUCTORY level classes (named INTRO).
6. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry. Committee reserves the right to evict and eliminate anyone who is acting in an unacceptable manner. Security may be patrolling the grounds.
7. Motorbikes are not to be ridden between the hours of 7pm and 6.30am. Motorbike riders must wear a helmet, not drivers under the influence of alcohol or substances and must not carry passengers.
8. NO dogs allowed. Anyone found in breach of this rule will be asked to leave.



9. Competitors enter at own risk and the organisers take no responsibility for any injury to horses, riders or spectators or any damage to competitors or spectators property.

10. In completing your entry, you acknowledge you have read and understood the Covid-19 Requirements and will abide by them in full. Failure to comply will incur elimination without refund of your entries.

11. Class 4, 5, 6 are to be run as A1 classes with \$200 to be split between all the double clears and \$100 to the style prize winner in each class. The intention of these 3 classes is give the younger horses an opportunity in ring 1 without the pressure of competing against the older horses

FEES AND LEVIES

- Ground Levy \$20 per horse/pony.
- Covid/Admin fee, \$20 per rider (Non-refundable). This is to cover additional costs relating the government regulations and compliance whilst operating an event.
- Stables/Covered Yards \$40 for show; Open yards \$20 for show. Preference will be given to those competing at higher levels, sponsors and volunteers.
- ESNZ Jumping levy \$5 per horse/pony (compulsory) ESNZ Casual Jumping Levy \$20 for horses and ponies not registered with ESNZ Jumping / Show Hunter for the show - Horses may compete at 1.10m and below and Ponies 1m and below. ESNZ Casual Membership \$15 per day for riders not registered with ESNZ only able to compete in Introductory classes.
- Refunds less 25% if notified to the event secretary by 7:00 pm three days prior to the show. Refunds after that less 50% at the committee's discretion.
- Class changes - 10% retained and no late fee charged. LATE ENTRIES, SCRATCHINGS AND CHANGES IN ALL CLASSES NEED TO BE WITH THE SECRETARY BY 5:00PM THE NIGHT BEFORE (at the discretion of the organising committee) – late entries to ride first in draw classes. Class changes should be completed online where possible.
- Riders MUST check with the office before they leave the show to ensure they do not owe money. Otherwise, a \$25 admin fee may be charged for follow-up of any outstanding fees after the show. Note - this show will use the ESNZ Jumping Policy on Debt Collection to follow-up any unpaid accounts. Read more on the ESNZ website or see the policy at the show.
- Prize money will be paid out by direct credit within 14 days after the show so be sure to include your bank details with the online entry. Riders are responsible for checking their placing's and prize money online within two days of the show's competition. No changes in prize money will be made after then.
- In case of cancellation of the event the Covid/Admin fee and a percentage of entry fees will be retained to cover out of pocket expenses only. The organising committee will do their best to return entry fees to riders.
- If competitors are unable to attend the event due to Covid Level Restrictions, the organising committee will do their best to return entry fees to riders. The Covid/Admin fee will be retained and a small percentage of entries if necessary to cover out of pocket expenses only.

STABLING CRITERIA

Stabling will be prioritised for those that enter early, horses jumping 1.30 and over, the organising committee and sponsors of the show at the discretion of the organising committee.

NEW ZEALAND THOROUGHBRED RACING PRIZE

New Zealand Thoroughbred Racing (NZTR) have provided prizes for the following, best placed Thoroughbred on Saturday (\$200 and rug), best placed Thoroughbred on Sunday (\$200 and rug) and best placed Thoroughbred in 1.15m championship (Rug)

Please register your thoroughbred when you enter for the show.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO RIDERS ABOUT MEDIA

By entering or attending this competition, you accept that you may appear within differing media streams that are on location covering the event. Your behaviour at the event and within the competition arena is at your discretion and is your responsibility.

We really need local competitors to step up and help, so you will be asked to provide a volunteer at this show with a contact phone number, and a preference for set up, putting away, or at show duties, please be aware that your entry could be refused if not compliant.

HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY

Central Districts Show Jumping Group are committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy event for all staff, and to providing the information, training and supervision needed to achieve this. We will take all practicable steps by:

- Providing a safe event, safe equipment, and proper materials.
- Identifying and monitoring hazards and using the hazard management hierarchy of eliminate, isolate, or minimise.
- Insisting upon establishment of safe methods and best practices.
- Complying with all H&S legislation, regulations, and codes of practice. We will take responsibility for health and safety procedures, however, ALL PEOPLE ON THIS SITE need to be aware of their responsibilities and comply with the event's health and safety policy. EVERY PERSON involved in our show is encouraged to play a vital and responsible role in maintaining a safe and healthy event through:
 - Being involved in the event health and safety system.
 - Following correct procedures.
 - Ensuring safe and proper use of equipment.
 - Wearing protective clothing and equipment as and when required.
 - Reporting any pain or discomfort as soon as possible.
 - Ensuring ALL accidents and incidents are reported to a Health & Safety Officer at the Office.
 - Helping new employees, trainees, and visitors to understand the safety procedures and why they exist.
 - Informing the office immediately of any health and safety concerns.
 - Keeping the event facilities tidy to minimise the risk of any trips and falls.

COMPETITORS are responsible for themselves at ALL times and must observe the safe practices and the rules/instructions relating to their competition. In case of a fall of an athlete and/or horse at any time in the competition arena, in the practice arena, or elsewhere within the grounds of the event, the athlete must be checked by the event's medical service and the check recorded on your event medical check card before you are permitted to take part in the round in progress or in the next round or competition at the event (Article 224). The card must remain in your pocket and be presented to the gate steward or ground committee before continuing to compete. The horse must be cleared by the Veterinarian or President of the Ground Jury and one other official if the Veterinarian is not available, before the equine is permitted to take part in the next round or competition at the event (Article 224). Central Districts Show Jumping Group complies with the ESNZ concussion policy. Riders who have a suspected concussion will be removed from the event. Riders who are concussed are often unaware of their symptoms and may want to continue riding. The Ground Jury at the event takes responsibility for the rider's wellbeing, assesses the rider and makes an informed choice about whether the rider should continue to ride or not – if any doubt the rider must be removed from the event as per the Blue Card process (outlined below). ESNZ's Blue Card process has been developed to keep riders safe and to support officials in their duty of care.

Blue Card process:

- Officials can exclude a rider from participating in a competition or entire event by issuing a Blue Card because the rider has received a serious injury, including concussion or suspected concussion.
- If a rider issued with a Blue Card at an event refuses to withdraw from the event, disciplinary action may be taken through the disciplinary process set out in the ESNZ general regulations.
- The Blue Card notice is logged on a rider's profile on ESNZ's database.
- A Blue Card means that a rider is stood down from all riding activities until clearance from a registered GP or registered medical specialist can be obtained.
- If a rider who has been issued with a Blue Card competes without first providing medical clearance, this may result in disciplinary action taken through the ESNZ disciplinary process set out in the ESNZ general regulations.
