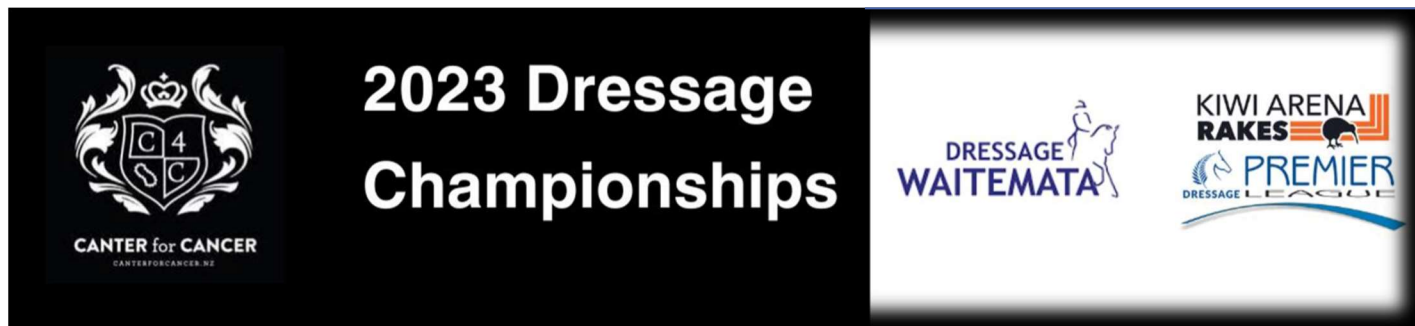

Important Information

1. **ESNZ Registration for all Graded Classes:** Entries will not be accepted without ESNZ rider and horse registrations current to 11 December 2023
2. **Annual Dressage Start:** Is required to enter all DNZ Super 5 Leagues, Zilco Musical Freestyle Series, National Championships, Horse of the Year and international events. All other classes may be entered using a discipline Flexi start.
3. All combinations are eligible for one section only, Bronze, Silver or Gold, and this is the section they are classified, as at the evening prior to the start of the show. (including pony competitors).

Prelim to Elementary : Bronze, Silver & Gold - separate categories for championship

Medium to Advanced Medium: Bronze category separate for Champion; Silver & Gold combined

This also applies to pony riders who are only eligible for one pony championship and may not also contest a horse championship.

4. Super 5 & Zilco MFS classes are combined for all categories with results separated for champion points & rosettes. Prize money paid on combined class results only.



RULES:

Dressage Waitemata Premier League competitions will be run under the current (2020) ESNZ GR's, VR's & ESNZ Rules for Dressage.

1. **Official start time:** The official event start time is 12.00 pm Friday 8th December 2023.

This is the start time for the period of jurisdiction for all Equestrian Sport New Zealand (ESNZ) General Regulations Veterinary Regulations and ESNZ Dressage/Para rules.

Please note Dressage NZ/Para equestrian rules to not allow the use of prohibited gear from the time of arrival at the event.

2. **Official finish time:** The official finish time will be 60 minutes after the completion of the last class or 60 minutes after the completion of all presentations for the event whichever is later.
3. **Qualifiers:** Premier League Shows are qualifiers for Horse of the Year and Nationals.
4. **Dressage NZ Leagues/Series:** Horses/Ponies must have an annual start for Dressage to gain points in any Super 5 League, Zilco Musical Freestyle Series, Prestige Futures Prize, Pony and Young Rider Performance Leagues, or Top 10 League. Riders must register online at Evo Events prior to 1st November 2023 for inclusion in any Top 10 League, Prestige Dressage Futures Prize, Pony and Young Rider Performance Leagues.
5. **Tests:** All tests from DNZ Test book Version 2023 Reprint 1 or FEI Website.
6. **Super 5 Tests:** Must be ridden from memory, no caller is permitted.
7. **Dogs – Dogs are not permitted** at Woodhill Sands, no exceptions. Non-compliance will result in elimination.

Event Conditions

1. **Amendments:** The organising committee reserves the right to refuse entries, cancel the event, alter the programme/schedule and/or prize money within the ESNZ and DNZ Rules.
2. **Presentation of Special Awards Prizes and Prize Money:** See DNZ Rule article 485.
 - a. All riders must attend advertised presentations. The organising committee reserves the right to withhold prize monies should a placegetter not attend an advertised prize giving.
 - b. The organising committee reserves the right to substitute prize money with goods of equal value.
 - c. Prize money will be paid by electronic transfer within 21 days of the completion of the event.
 - d. Product prizes must be collected from event, no product will be posted.
 - e. Prize Givings: Unmounted for Champions & Reserves for all levels & special awards.

All classes, including Super 5 League and Zilco Musical Freestyles, collect rosettes from the office.

3. **Draw:** If required, a revised draw and/or start times for the following day's competition will be available by 6.30 pm each evening on evo events and riders emailed/ text. It is the rider's responsibility to check any new times posted.
4. All outstanding amounts from any previous Dressage Waitemata event must be paid before entries will be confirmed.
5. **Scratchings** Must be notified by email to the Event Secretary or via Evo Events.
6. **Stabling :** Will be allocated by level with higher level requests being accommodated first as at close of entries
7. **Stallions** must comply with ESNZ Article 133 and must be housed in a stallion yard at all times
8. **Stabling Refunds:** Where stabling requests cannot be met, refunds will be made via internet banking after the show

9. **Equal Placings:** In the case of equality in any qualifying class, the higher collective marks will determine the higher placing. If the competitors are still equal, then the higher co-efficient marks will determine the placings. If there is still an equality of points, the competitors are given the same placing.
10. **Riders with more than 2 horses:** Entries are limited to 4 horses, with a maximum of 6 tests per day per rider. The OC will make every effort to ensure that riders have at least 60 minutes between rides. However, if this is not possible owing to the scheduling of classes, maximum time possible between rides will be allocated.
11. **Protest & Complaints:** Protests and complaints may be considered by the Ground Jury at the event in accordance with Art 137 of the ESNZ General Regulations. As a guideline only, protests must be lodged within 60 minutes of the completion of the competition to which the protest relates, and a complaint within 60 minutes of the completion of the event. 12. **Hats:** ESNZ approved and tagged riding helmets must be worn at all times when mounted.
13. **Non Competing Horses:** All horses and ponies on the grounds after the official start time must be entered in a class at the event.
14. **Media:** Dressage Waitemata, Dressage NZ and ESNZ reserve the right to use event photographs, for marketing, publicity, advertising, funding applications as they see fit. Competitors and/or participants will receive no remuneration for this. All images remain the property of Dressage Waitemata
15. **Musical Freestyles:** Riders are asked to please email their music to Leon at high.pferdelity@gmail.com before Friday 1st December 2023. Please provide your **name, your horses registered name AND registered number, class number and level.**
16. Riders may not ride more than 3 tests per day per horse.

17.Liability:

- a) Competitors and spectators attending this event do so at their own risk.
- b) Woodhill Sands, ESNZ, Dressage NZ or Dressage Waitemata nor any representative of these bodies, accepts any liability for any loss, damage, injury or illness to horse/pony/rider, spectators, land, vehicles or any personal property whether caused by their negligence or breach of contract in any way whatsoever.
- c) Woodhill Sands, Dressage NZ or Dressage Waitemata will not be liable for the security of goods/equipment or the loss of, damage to such, stored at the venue, during the event.

18.Health & Safety:

- a) Dressage NZ and Dressage Waitemata are committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy event for all participants, and to providing the information, training and supervision needed to achieve this.
- b) Competitors must comply with appropriate Legislation and Health & Safety at Work Act 2015.
- c) Each Competitor and/or exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazard created, accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves at the venue of the Event.
- d) All competitors and associated staff/visitors to the venue must abide by the ESNZ/Dressage NZ Rules, the Dressage Waitemata and Woodhill Sands Health & Safety Policy's
- e) Copies of the event Health & Safety policy can be found at the event office.
- f) Any incident or near miss must be reported to event office and an incident form completed.

- g) Any hazards identified must be reported to event office.
- h) Competitors will be responsible for their safety at all times and must observe safe practices and always following event rules and officials' instructions, ensuring that others are not put at risk by their actions.

19. ESNZ Concussion Policy

- a) This event will be run under the ESNZ Concussion Policy Guidelines.
- b) Dressage NZ policy requires all riders to report to Medical Officer or Steward following a fall.
- c) Medical clearance must be obtained before remounting or competing.

20. ESNZ Drug & Alcohol Policy

Entry Conditions

1. Entries Close midnight Sunday 19 November 2023.
2. Payment should be made with entry via Poli.
3. Entry will not be accepted unless payment is made. Entry will be held as pending in Evo Events until payment is made.
4. Enter online at www.evoevents.co.nz. Fax, emailed or phone entries will not be accepted.
5. Late Entries & Changes - Please contact event secretary Angela Nobilo for enquiries, waitematadressage@gmail.com
Late entries may be accepted if entries allow or placed on waiting list.
6. No class changes or scratchings will be accepted via Facebook or text.
7. Late penalty fee of \$40 per horse will apply and proof of payment before entry accepted.
8. Payments made after close of entry may incur a late fee

Withdrawals and Refunds

Applications for refund must be submitted by email stating rider name, ESNZ registrations and horses name/s to Event Secretary; waitemataadressage@gmail.com

Final date for refund applications – Sunday 17 December 2023

Conditions of withdrawal from the event before close of entries.

- Competitors that withdraw prior to close of entries are still liable for the online entry fees and admin fee.
- All other fees paid will be refunded.

Conditions of withdrawal from the event after close of entries.

- Stabling, camping & ground fees will be 100% refunded in all cases.
- Online entry fee, admin and medic fee & any late entry fees will not be refunded.
- Competitors unable to provide a vet or doctor's certificate will receive no entry fees refund.
- If a doctor or vet certificate is provided entry fees will be refunded less 25% per horse
- If a vet certificate is provided, only the horse to which the certificate applies will receive a refund.
- If a doctors certificate is provided, fees for all horses for that rider will be refunded.
- Special applications for refunds without a vet or doctors certificate can be presented for consideration by the OC.

Championship Eligibility Points Levels Preliminary to Grand Prix

1. Combinations are eligible for one level of Championship only, excluding young/junior rider & masters.
2. Championship points are allocated 10 for 1st, to 1 for 6th (10, 8, 6, 4, 2, 1)
3. Champions and Reserves: The horse with the highest aggregate allocated points from specified classes will be the Championship winner. In the event of a tie, the combination with the highest place in the Super 5, or pony classes 103, 203, 303 is the winner. If there is still a tie, the combination with the highest aggregate collective marks in the Super 5, or pony classes 103, 203, 303 will be the winner. If there is a further tie, the combination with the highest average % in all qualifiers will be the winner.



Special Awards

1. Champion Junior/Young Rider: Please state at time of entry to be eligible.

For riders on a horse from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach 12 until they reach the age of 21. Riders who turn 21 on or after 1st August may continue competing as a Junior / Young Rider until the 31st July in the following calendar year. Championship classes only count for points

Prelim to Medium : Champion & Reserve awarded a Champion Sash.

Advanced Medium to Big Tour : Champion & Reserve awarded a Champion Sash.

2. Masters Championships: Please state at time of entry to be eligible

Open to riders on horse or pony. Championship classes only count for points Riders must be aged 50 years or over as at 1st August 2023.

Prelim to Medium: Champion & Reserve awarded a Sash.

Advanced Medium to Big Tour : Champion & Reserve awarded a Sash.

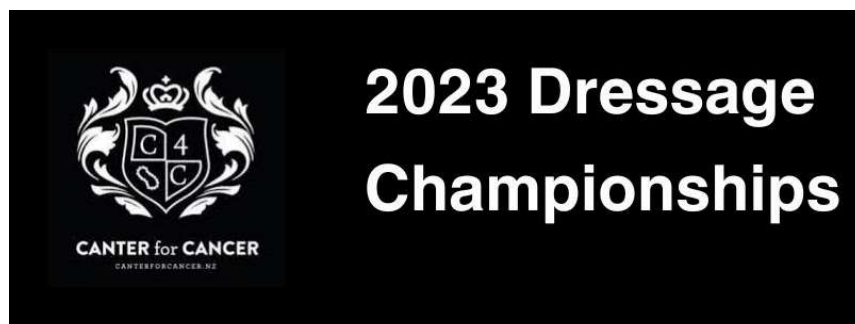
3. Hanoverian Society Award: Please state at time of entry to be eligible.

Two awards presented Level Preliminary to Elementary, and Medium and above. The award will be presented to the highest-level Hanoverian champion, if no Champion then the Reserve. If there is neither, the Sash will lapse for that grade this year. Horses must be registered with NZ Hanoverian Society and papers supplied on entry.



4. Best Dressage Waitemata Member

For horse and rider combination gaining the most points in Preliminary and Novice Bronze classes. Combinations must be financial members of Dressage Waitemata prior to the event. Sash to winner.

Competition Arena Use & Familiarisation

1. All Competition Arenas are closed at all times except as stated below.
2. These times may be amended - please check times in RIDER NOTES provided with the DRAW.
3. Arena familiarization is not intended to be used as a full schooling session.
4. Riders need to be considerate of other riders wishing to familiarize their horses.
5. Lunging is only permitted on grass in designated area. Please see the office to direct if unsure.
Horses may be hand walked or ridden at walking pace around the exterior of the competition arena unless advised otherwise by the Technical Delegate or Steward
6. **Familiarisation Times** Friday 5.00pm – 6pm, Saturday 7.00am –7.30am

Sponsors & Volunteers

We ask that all competitors spend some time to thank our sponsors and volunteers that support Dressage in NZ, either in writing (Sponsors contact details will be listed in the Event programme) or in person during the show. Volunteer thanks can be directed to the Event Office or Event Manager.

Horse Identification, Venue, Stabling, Accommodation Conditions

1. Approved Dressage NZ Horse/Pony identification numbers must be worn at all times when competing.
2. When not competing, it is compulsory that horses/ponies are identified with ID tags that include persons responsible, name and mobile phone number.
3. All yards and stables are to be left properly mucked out and no manure or hay is left behind in parking areas
If not a fee of \$50 will be charged.
4. Temporary yarding must comply with ESNZ rules.
5. Yard barriers are recommended for ponies to ensure they stay in their yards.
6. Stallions must comply with ESNZ Article 133 and must be housed in a stallion yard at all times.
7. Please keep wash down bays clean at all times and avoid washing manure into drains. Other than bore water, no liquids, materials, or chemical additives shall be used in any part of the horse wash facility including detergents, shampoos, and cleaning agents.
8. Moving horses to unallocated yards or stables is prohibited without permission of the Stewards.
9. Please use the allocated areas for horse waste, not rubbish.
10. Please take your rubbish home.
11. No smoking in any buildings or stable areas.
12. Damage to Woodhill Sands facilities to be reported to the Event Office.
13. Camping can be inside paddock with covered yards, and all overnight yarding will be in this area. You are also able to camp in day parking area if desired.
14. Day competitors must park in the main carpark.
15. Waste and grey water tanks must not be emptied on the ground.
16. All persons staying overnight are required to comply with noise controls, namely:
 - Lights out after 10pm
 - No loud music or gatherings after 10pm
 - No use of generators after 10pm unless for emergency purposes

Vehicles & Access

1. Access to venue is via first drive on right in James Mackie Drive.
2. Speed limit for all vehicles 10 kph.
3. No motor bikes are allowed at Woodhill Sands.
4. No arrival before 12pm Friday 9th December . If requiring to stay Sunday night please contact Event Secretary waitematadressage@gmail.com



Professional Services

1. Equine Therapists and Treatment
 - a. Any equine therapists or practitioners who are not veterinarians and intend to provide therapeutic treatment to equines in any capacity at this event in a private or commercial basis must notify the Organising Committee of any treatment prior to the event.
 - b. All practitioners must also comply with the Conditions applicable to this event set out in the Schedule of classes.
 - c. Riders who own their equipment (eg Equissage, Cyclossage or similar) are only permitted to treat their own horses with these systems at the event.
 - d. Any practitioner receiving financial or other gain from providing therapies at the event will be required to pay a trade exhibitor fee at the discretion of the Organising Committee.
2. Other Professionals including freelance grooms
 - a. Any other professional intending on providing services at this event must obtain prior agreement from the Organising Committee – this excludes professional Dressage Coaches assisting in the warmup of competitors and grooms that are in part or full time employment of a competitor.

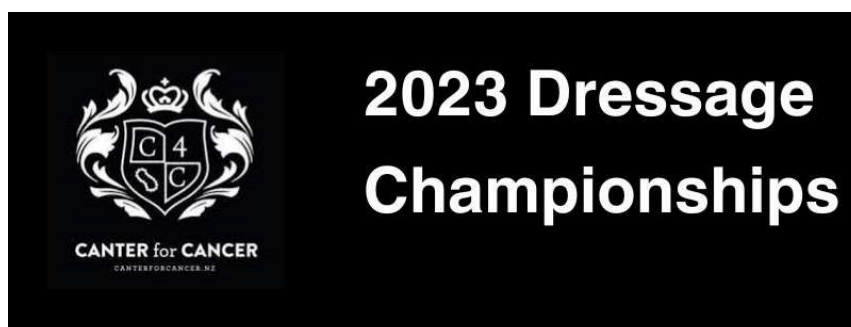

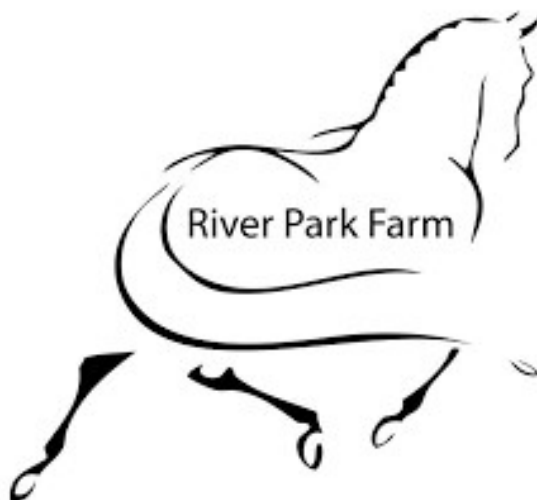

Terms and conditions of entry as previously stated in this schedule are to be adhered to.

- Teams will consist of 4 combinations and to be made up of at least 2 different levels
- Teams must be approved by head PC coach and submitted to Event Secretary by Head Coach by 20 November 2023. See page 20 for team entry form.
- Teams should be made up from one Pony Club but where numbers do not allow this, members can be combined from other clubs.
- Percentages will be added from all 4 members tests - graded or non graded.
- Tests included are 11, 12, 13, 14, 102, 103, 105, 106, 108, 109, 21, 21,23, 24, 202, 203, 205, 206, 208, 209, 31, 32, 33,34, 302, 303, 305, 306, 308
- Combinations may only compete in graded or non-graded but not both.
- Percentages will only count from one level. If riding in more than one level riders must stipulate which tests will count for team points.
- Percentages from the 2 tests from each combination will be added and the highest aggregate total will be the winning team. If a score is equal the higher collective marks will determine the higher placing. If the competitors are still equal, then the higher co-efficient marks will determine the placings. If there is still an equality of points, the competitors are given the same placing.
- Dressage Waitemata Pony Club Teams Trophy will be awarded to the winning Team
- Rosette/ Sash for combinations in teams to 4th place.
- Pony Club Name and rider membership number must be included with team entry form.

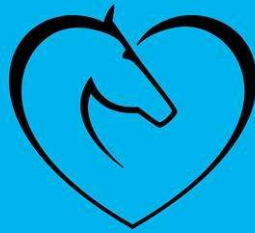
