Responsibility: It is the rider, or person responsible, obligation to read and understand the conditions for this event as published in this schedule.

Important Information

- ESNZ Registration for Graded Classes:** Entries will not be accepted without membership as follows to 19th January 2025.
 - Preliminary: Riders must have an ESNZ Introductory, Child or Full Competitive membership.
 - Novice and Above: Riders must have an ESNZ Child or Full Competitive membership.
 - Horse and Ponies: Must have ESNZ Horse/pony registration. May compete on an Annual Dressage Start (purchased on Horse Reg) or use Flexi Start at \$5.00 per test (payable with entries).
- ESNZ Registration for Non-Graded Classes:** All Riders must be a Child, Full or Introductory ESNZ member current to the 19th January 2025 or pay a Casual membership fee of \$16.30 per event. Horses and Ponies may be registered or non-registered.
- Bronze, Silver and Gold Classes:** Riders will be entered into Bronze, Silver or Gold classes for graded Preliminary, Novice, Elementary and Medium levels as per eligibility the night before the show starts being Friday 17th January 2025.

Rules: Dressage Wairarapa Premier League competitions will be run under the current (2024) ESNZ GR's, VR's & ESNZ Rules for Dressage.
- Official start time:** The official event start time is 12.00 pm Friday 17th January 2025. This is the start time for the period of jurisdiction for all Equestrian Sport New Zealand (ESNZ) General Regulations and ESNZ Dressage rules. Please note Dressage NZ Articles 420-430 prohibited gear is not allowed from the time of arrival at the event.
- Official finish time:** The official finish time will be 60 minutes after the completion of the last class or 60 minutes after the completion of all presentations for the event whichever is later.
- Protests & Complaints:** Protests and complaints may be considered by the Ground Jury at an event in accordance with Art 137 of the ESNZ General Regulations. As a guideline only, protests must be lodged within 60 minutes of the completion of the competition to which the protest relates, and a complaint within 60 minutes of the completion of the event. - Qualifiers:** Premier League Shows are qualifiers for Horse of the Year and Bates National Dressage Championships.
- Dressage NZ Leagues/Series:** Horses/Ponies must have an annual start for Dressage to gain points in any Super 5 League, Zilco Musical Freestyle Series, Prestige Futures Prize, AMS Saddlery Pony, Young & Youth Rider Performance League, or Top 10 Leagues. Riders must register online at Evo Events prior to 1st December 2024

for inclusion in any Top 10 League, Prestige Dressage Futures Prize, AMS Saddlery Pony, Young and Youth Rider Rider Performance League.

10. **Tests:** All tests from DNZ Test book version 2023 or FEI Website,

11. **Super 5 Tests:** Must be ridden from memory, no caller is permitted.

12. **FEI Tests:** Must be ridden from memory, no caller is permitted.



Event Conditions

1. **Amendments:** The organising committee reserves the right to refuse entries, cancel the event, alter the programme and/or schedule within the ESNZ and DNZ Rules.
2. **Presentation of Special Awards Prizes:** See DNZ Rule article 456.
 - a. The Prize Giving schedule will be included in the Rider Notes prior to the event.
 - b. All riders must attend advertised presentations.
 - c. Prize Givings will be unmounted for Super 5 League and Zilco Musical Freestyles. Rider Notes will confirm if mounted or unmounted for Level Champions. All other classes collect from reception.
3. **Draw:** If required, a revised draw and/or start times for the following day's competition will be available by 6.30pm each evening on the results board. It is the rider's responsibility to check any new times posted.
4. **All outstanding amounts** from any previous Dressage NZ Event must be paid before entries will be confirmed.
5. **Scratchings:** Must be notified by text/email to the Event Secretary and submitted on Evo Events.
6. **Stabling Refunds:** Where stabling requests cannot be met, refunds will be made via internet banking after the show.
7. **Equal Placings:** In the case of equality in any qualifying class, the higher collective marks will determine the higher placing. If the competitors are still equal, then the higher co-efficient marks will determine the placings. If there is still an equality of points, the competitors are given the same placing.
8. **Riders with more than 2 horses:** Riders are limited to 4 horses, with a maximum of 6 tests per day per rider. The OC will make every effort to ensure that riders have at least 60 minutes between rides. However, if this is not possible owing to the scheduling of classes, maximum time possible between rides will be allocated.
9. **Hats:** ESNZ approved riding helmets yellow tagged, must be worn at all times when mounted.
10. **Non-Competing Horses:** All horses and ponies on the grounds after the official start time must be entered at the event unless the organising committee grants permission otherwise.
11. **Media:** Dressage Wairarapa, Dressage NZ and ESNZ reserve the right to use event photographs for marketing, publicity, advertising, funding applications as they see fit. Competitors and/or participants will receive no remuneration for this. All images remain the property of Dressage Wairarapa.
12. **Musical Freestyles:** The primary media for playing back MFS music is CD with a WAV or audio track on it. Make sure the disc and the cover are clearly labelled (write your label around the outside of the disc, not across the centre). If you are using a disc that was for a previous class, make sure the label has been changed. Damaged or dirty discs may not play. USB sticks are only a backup as duration and speed cannot be guaranteed. The only format on a USB stick is MP3. No other file type can be played.
13. **Stallions** must comply with ESNZ Article 133 and must be housed in a stable at all times.
14. **Liability:**
 - a) Competitors and spectators attending this event do so at their own risk.
 - b) Masterton A&P, ESNZ, Dressage NZ or Dressage Wairarapa nor any representative of these bodies, accepts any liability for any loss, damage, injury or illness to horse/pony/rider, spectators, land, vehicles or any personal property whether caused by their negligence or breach of contract in any way whatsoever.
 - c) Masterton A&P, Dressage NZ or Dressage Wairarapa will not be liable for the security of goods/equipment or the loss of, damage to such, stored at the venue, during the event.

15. Health & Safety:

- a) Dressage NZ and Dressage Wairarapa are committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy event for all participants, and to providing the information, training and supervision needed to achieve this.
- b) Competitors must comply with appropriate Legislation and Health & Safety at Work Act 2015.
- c) Each Competitor and/or exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazard created, accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves at the venue of the Event
- d) All competitors and associated staff/visitors to the venue must abide by the ESNZ/Dressage NZ Rules, the Dressage Wairarapa and Masterton A&P Showgrounds Health & Safety Policy's
- e) Copies of the event Health & Safety policy can be found at the event office.
- f) Any incident or near miss must be reported to event office and an incident form completed.
- g) Any hazards identified must be reported to event office.
- h) Competitors will be responsible for their safety at all times and must observe safe practices and following event rules and officials' instructions at all times, ensuring that others are not put a risk by their actions.

16. ESNZ Concussion Policy:

- a) This event will be run under the ESNZ Concussion Policy Guidelines.
- b) Dressage NZ policy requires all riders to report to Medical Officer or Steward following a fall.
- c) Medical clearance must be obtained before remounting or leaving.

17. ESNZ Drug & Alcohol Policy:

ESNZ reserve the right to drug or alcohol test any participant at the event under the ESNZ Drug & Alcohol Policy 2020. This link will access the policy and frequently asked questions.

Entry Conditions

1. Entries close Thursday 19th December 2024 or earlier if classes reach maximum entries.
2. Entry will not be accepted until payment is made. Combinations will only be entered in the competition draw once full payment of entry and other fees has been received.

5. No postal, fax, emailed or phone entries will be accepted.

7. No class changes or scratchings will be accepted via Facebook or text.
8. Late penalty fee of \$10.00 per class will apply where a late entry is accepted.

For health and safety reasons, the Masterton A&P require all horses and ponies to be in yards when not being worked. No horses and ponies are to be tied to trucks or floats.

Withdrawals and Refunds

Final date for refund applications – Friday 24th January 2025.

Conditions of withdrawal from the event before close of entries:

- Online entry fee and show levy will not be refunded.
- All other fees paid will be refunded.

Conditions of withdrawal from the event after close of entries:

- Stabling, ground and camping fees will be 100% refunded in all cases.
- Online entry fee, show levy and late entry fees will not be refunded in all cases.
- Competitors unable to provide a vet or doctors certificate will not be refunded class entry fees.
- If a doctor or vet certificate is provided, class entry fees will be refunded less 20% per horse.
- If a vet certificate is provided, only the horse to which the certificate applies will receive a refund.
- If a doctor certificate is provided, fees for all horses for that rider will be refunded
- Special applications for refunds can be presented to the OC for consideration.

If the event is cancelled due to Covid-19:

- Full refund of all charges excluding Show Levy and Online Fee.

Championship Eligibility Points Levels Preliminary – Grand Prix

1. Combinations are eligible for one level of Championship only as set out in the Schedule of Classes.
2. Championship points are allocated 20 for 1st, to 1 for 20th.
3. Bronze, Silver and Gold Championships are awarded for Preliminary, Novice, Elementary and Medium levels.
4. Champions and Reserves: The horse with the highest aggregate allocated points from specified classes will be the Championship winner. In the event of a tie, the combination with the highest place in the final championship qualifier is the winner. If there is still a tie, the combination with the highest aggregate collective marks in the final championship qualifier will be the winner. If there is a further tie, the combination with the highest average % from all championship qualifiers will be the winner.



Age Group Championship Eligibility

1. Combinations are eligible for one level of Championship only.
2. Ensure your date of birth is correct in Evo Events as awards are based on this information.
3. **Champion Junior Rider (Donnerubin Trophy):** For riders on a Horse from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach 12 until they reach the age of 16. Riders who turn 16 on or after 1st August may continue competing as a Junior until the 31st July in the following calendar year. **Please state at time of entry to be eligible.**
4. **Champion Young Rider:** For Riders on a Horse or Pony from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 16 years until they reach the age of 21. Riders who turn 21 on or after 1st August may compete as a Young Rider until the 31st July in the following calendar year. **Please state at time of entry to be eligible.**
5. **Champion Masters:** Open to riders on a Horse or Pony. Riders must be aged 50 years or over as at 1st August 2024. **Please state on entry to be eligible.**
6. Champion and Reserve Champion sashes will be awarded.

Special Awards

1. **Hanoverian Society Award:** Two awards presented Level Preliminary-Medium and Advanced Medium and above. The award will be presented to the highest-level Hanoverian champion, if no champion then the reserve. If there is neither the Sash will lapse for that grade this year. Horses must be registered with NZ Hanoverian Society. **Please Nominate in Evo Events at time of entry to be eligible.**

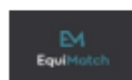
2. **Dressage Wairarapa Denis Reichenbach Area Challenge:** The percentage scores from all combinations competing in Saturday graded classes 106, 202, 302, 402, 501, 601, 701, 801, and 901 will be tallied and divided by the number of area combinations to reach an average team score. The winning area will be presented with the Denis Reichenbach Perpetual Trophy and each team member receives an Area Challenge sash. There must be a minimum of five riders from each area to be eligible. Any change of area must be notified to the Event Office by 9am Saturday 18th January 2025.

Competition Arena Use & Familiarisation

1. All Competition Arenas are closed at all times except as stated below.
2. These times may be amended please check times in rider notes provided with the draw.
3. Arena familiarisation is not intended to be used as a full schooling session.
4. Riders need to be considerate of other riders wishing to familiarise their horses.
5. Lunging is only permitted in the Judds Rd paddock. No lunging is permitted on the all-weather surfaces.
6. Horses may be hand walked or ridden at walking pace around the exterior of the competition arena unless advised otherwise by the Technical Delegate.
7. Any person leading a horse in an arena familiarisation must be wearing a correctly fitting yellow tagged helmet. All horses being lead must be wearing a bridle with a permitted bit, and with two bridle numbers. A newmarket lead may replace the reins for this purpose.
8. Familiarisation time is Friday 4.00pm – 6.00pm. Times will be confirmed in Rider Notes and may change due to grooming and watering requirements.



Sponsors & Volunteers

We ask that all competitors spend some time to thank our sponsors and volunteers that support Dressage in NZ, either in writing (sponsors contact details will be listed in the Rider Notes) or in person during the show. Volunteer thanks can be directed to the event office or event manager. Without the generous support we receive from these individuals and businesses, the cost to competitors would be considerably increased.



Horse Identification, Venue, Stabling, Accommodation Conditions

1. Approved Dressage NZ Horse/Pony identification numbers must be worn on both sides at all times when warming up, competing and when being ridden or lead in Arena Familiarisation.
2. Back numbers must be worn by non-graded riders. These can be collected from the office.
3. When not competing, it is compulsory that horses/ponies are identified with ID tags that include person responsible's name and mobile phone number.
4. All yards and stables are to be left properly mucked out. If not a fee of \$50.00 will be charged.
5. Temporary yarding must comply with ESNZ rules.
6. Stallions must comply with ESNZ Article 133 and must be housed in a stable at all times.
7. Please keep wash down bays clean at all times.
8. Moving horses to unallocated yards or stables is prohibited without permission of the Event Secretary.
9. No smoking or vaping in any buildings or stable areas.
10. Damage to Masterton A&P facilities must be reported to the Event Office as soon as practicable.

Dogs

1. Dogs must be kept in the truck park and on a lead at all times.
2. No dogs are allowed in any stable or yarding areas, warm up, competition areas or buildings.
3. The owner of the dog will be responsible for the cost of any damage/harm caused by the dog at the competition.

Vehicles & Camping

1. Access to the venue is via Fleet Street.
2. The speed limit for all vehicles is 15kph.
3. Parking and camping areas may be defined. Some areas will be restricted to onsite camping/parking only.
4. Trucks and Campervans requesting power must book this directly with the Masterton A&P and have a valid electrical certificate. Under no circumstances will they allow other vehicles to connect to their vehicle via extension cords.
5. Motorbikes must not be used after 8.00 pm and must be used in accordance with normal road rules.
6. Persons under 16yrs may not use motorbikes.
7. Approved safety helmets must be worn when riding motorbikes at all times in accordance with NZ road rules.
8. Joy riding on any part of the grounds will not be tolerated.
9. Bicycle helmets must be worn in accordance with NZ road rules. Children riding bicycles and scooters must be supervised at all times and keep clear of horse traffic areas.

Professional Services

1. Equine Therapists and Treatment
 - a. Any equine therapists or practitioners who are not veterinarian and intend to provide therapeutic treatment to equines in any capacity at this event in a private or commercial basis must notify the Organising Committee of any treatment prior to the event.
 - b. All practitioners must also comply with the Conditions applicable to this event set out in the Schedule of classes.
 - c. Riders who own their equipment (eg Equissage, Cyclossage or similar) are only permitted to treat their own horses with these systems at the event.
 - d. Any practitioner receiving financial or other gain from providing therapies at the event will be required to pay a trade exhibitor fee at the discretion of the Organising Committee.
2. Other Professionals including freelance grooms
 - a. Any other professional intending on providing services at this event must obtain prior agreement

from the Organising Committee – this excludes professionals Dressage Coaches assisting in the warmup of competitors and grooms that are in part or full time employment of a competitor.

Para Equestrian (PE)

Refer to General Conditions for the event plus for Para Classes please note:

1. This event is run under ESNZ Para-Equestrian Rules, ESNZ General Rules and 2. Regulations and ESNZ Dressage Rules where applicable
3. ESNZ Registration for Graded Classes: Entries will not be accepted without membership as follows to 19th January 2025.
 - Riders must have an ESNZ Child or Full Competitive membership.
 - Horse and Ponies: Must have ESNZ Horse/pony registration. May compete on an Annual Dressage Start (purchased on Horse Reg) or use Flexi Start at \$5.00 per Test (payable with entries).
2. All PE riders must have a current FEI or ESNZ ID card, a copy of which must be carried at all times while riding.
3. ESNZ, Dressage NZ & ESNZ Para-Equestrian rules apply from time of arrival where applicable
4. All tests are the current versions that are on the ESNZ or FEI Website.
5. All Riders are to always display the Official Orange Para Badge on each side of their saddle cloth while schooling, hacking or competing as well as the horse's ESNZ registration number on both sides of the bridle or saddle cloth.
6. A horse may not be shared by different riders between PE and able-bodied classes.
7. A horse may be shared by riders of different grades in PE classes as per Para-Equestrian Rules Article 166.
8. While every effort will be made to accommodate riders wishing to compete in both PE and AB classes and to accommodate PE riders with more than one horse, the smooth running of the event is paramount, and should there be excessive entries or timetabling issues, then riders may be asked to nominate which horse/discipline they want to compete in. No more than two tests per day per horse/rider combination can be entered.
