



Dressage Wairarapa – Kiwi Arena Rake Premier League Event

Rider Information

Arrival – Access to the grounds is via the Fleet Street entrance from midday Friday.

Arena Familiarisation/Warm Up - Arena familiarisation is 3.30pm – 5.30pm on Friday and 7.00am– 7.20am on Saturday. Arena set up is from 1.00pm Friday - your assistance will be most appreciated. If set up is completed earlier, arena familiarisation may commence earlier.

Horses may be led in-hand or ridden at **walk only** around the outside of the arena and be ridden in trot and canter in the all-weather warm up area during these times.

Any person leading a horse in an arena familiarisation must be wearing a correctly fitted, current ESNZ approved tagged helmet. All horses being led must be wearing a bridle with a permitted bit, and with two bridle numbers (or back number for non-graded horses). A Newmarket lead may replace the reins for this purpose.

Riders competing on the all-weather surface may enter the all-weather warm up area 15 minutes prior to their test time. Riders competing on the grass surface (Arena 5 and 6) may enter the oval area 15 minutes prior to their test time. Otherwise, warm up is in the Judds Road paddock.

Riders in Arena 4 will start their test inside the arena. All arenas are 60 x 20m.

Back Numbers – All non-graded riders must wear back numbers when working their horse/pony. Please collect these from the office and ensure you return them before you leave.

Camping – you must have booked and paid camping fees with your entry if you are staying on the grounds Friday or Saturday night. This is a requirement of the A&P.

Dogs – Dogs must be always kept on a lead. Dogs are not permitted in any stable or yarding area, warm up, competition areas or buildings. Any dog causing disruption must be removed from the grounds if requested by the OC.

Draw Times - The OC reserves the right to amend the programme and draw times as required to ensure the smooth running of the event. Draw times will be moved up where possible. Riders are to check EvoEvents and the noticeboard for any changes.

First Aid & Emergencies - In an emergency dial 111. Masterton Hospital is the nearest hospital and is 10 minutes from the grounds in Te Ore Ore Road. A defibrillator is available outside the A&P office near the Fleet Street entrance. The main first aid station will be located near Arena 4 on Saturday and Sunday. Outside of these times first aiders can be contacted via the event office.

Food - A selection of hot and cold food, coffee and other drinks will be available for purchase on the grounds during the day from 7.30am Saturday and Sunday.

Happy Hour – Eastwood Motor Group is hosting happy hour from 5.15pm – 6.30pm Saturday. Happy hour will commence immediately after prize giving and will be held during the Medium Tour and Grand Prix musical freestyle classes 801 and 901.

Jackets – As set out in Article 415 of Rules of ESNZ Dressage, jackets are compulsory at Regional events at all levels. During weather extremes the OC may give permission for athletes to compete without jackets; this could happen with the current forecast. If an athlete chooses not to wear a jacket, the shirt must have short or long sleeves and a stock or tie, or an integrated choker collar or a choker collar. Any stock or tie must be suitably pinned down.

Musicals – Ensure your CD or USB is delivered to the office 2 hours before your class commences. The format is set out in the schedule on EvoEvents. We expect there will be a testing kit at the office from 4.00pm – 5.00pm on Friday if you wish to test your music.

Photographer – Corina Belliss Photography is the official show photographer.

Prize Giving – Times shown are approximate. The OC reserves the right to change times and classes for each prize giving as required on the day. The prize giving schedule will be updated on the Noticeboard. Riders are to be in riding attire.

Saturday 5.00pm – 5.15pm – unmounted prize giving for the Saturday Super 5 and Zilco Musical Freestyle classes that have results available.

Sunday 12.00pm – unmounted prize giving for the Super 5 and Zilco Musical Freestyle that have results available. Mounted (optional unmounted) prize giving for the Level Championships where finalised.

Sunday 1.30pm – unmounted prize giving for the remaining Super 5 and Zilco Musical Freestyle classes. Mounted (optional unmounted) prize giving for the remaining Level Championships, Age Championships and Area Challenge.

Championship rugs for Level Champions have been kindly sponsored by PGG Wrightson. Rugs are to be collected from the office prior to prize giving.
