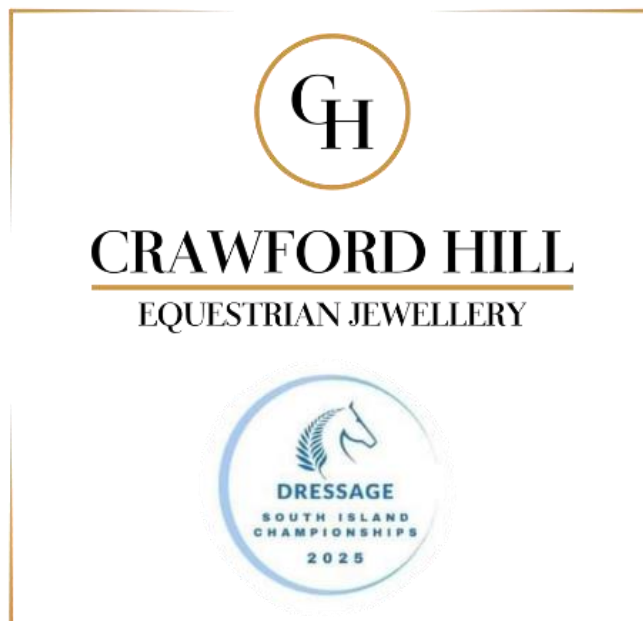

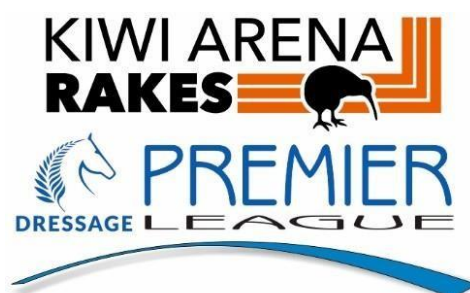

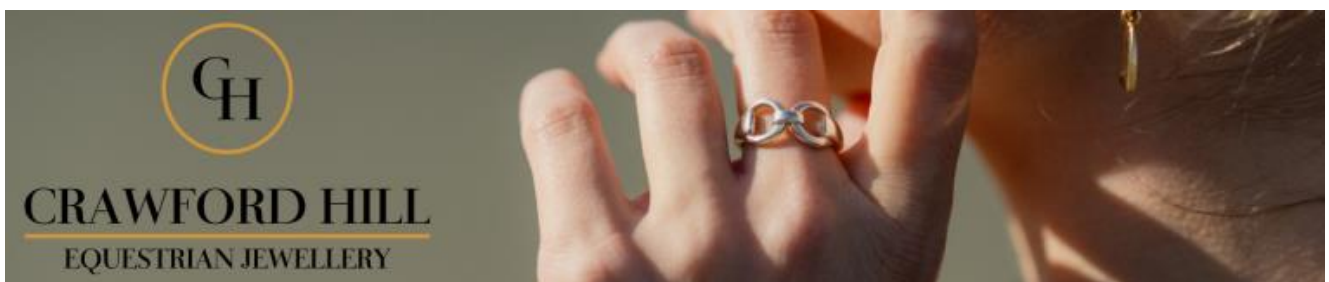

Important Information

Responsibility: It is the rider, or person responsible, obligation to read and understand the conditions for this event as published in this schedule.

1. **ESNZ Registration for Graded Classes:** Entries will not be accepted without membership as follows current to the 9th February 2025.
 - Preliminary: Riders must have an ESNZ Introductory ESNZ Child or Full Competitive membership.
 - Novice and Above: Riders must have an ESNZ Child or Full Competitive membership.
 - Horse and Ponies: Must have ESNZ Horse/pony registration. May compete on an Annual Dressage Discipline Start (purchased on Horse Reg) or use Flexi Start at \$5 per Test (payable with entries).
2. **ESNZ Registration for Non-Graded Classes:** All Riders must be an ESNZ Child, Full or Introductory ESNZ member current to 9th February 2025 or pay a Casual membership fee of \$16.30 per event. Non-graded classes are open to Horses and Ponies who have NOT been registered for Dressage since 1st January 2024.
3. **Non-Graded Classes:** Non-graded classes will be limited to a maximum of forty combinations in total, on a first in (and paid), first served basis. All non-graded horses/ponies must be plaited. If insufficient entries Horse and Pony classes may be combined at the discretion of the Organising Committee.
4. **Rules:** All competitions will be run under the current (2024) ESNZ GR's, VR's and ESNZ Rules for Dressage.
5. **Official Start Time:** The official event start time is 7.30 am Friday 7th February 2025. This is the start time for the period of jurisdiction for all Equestrian Sport New Zealand (ESNZ) General Regulations, and ESNZ Dressage rules. Please note NZ Articles 420-430 prohibited gear is not allowed from the time of arrival at the event.
6. **Official Finish Time:** The official finish time will be 60 minutes after the completion of the last class or 60 minutes after the completion of all presentations for the event, whichever is later.
7. **Protests & Complaints:** Protests and complaints may be considered by the Ground Jury at an event in accordance with Art 137 of the ESNZ General Regulations. As a guideline only, protests must be lodged within 60 minutes of the completion of the competition to which the protest relates, and a complaint within 60 minutes of the completion of the event. A fee of \$50 is payable. The Ground Jury is the sole judge of time in both cases. 8. **Qualifiers:** Premier League Shows are qualifiers for Horse of the Year and Bates National Dressage Championships.
9. **Dressage NZ Leagues/Series:** Horses/ponies must have a Dressage discipline start to gain points in any Super 5 League, Zilco Musical Freestyle Series, Prestige Futures Prize, AMS Saddlery Pony, Young & Youth Rider Performance Leagues, or Top 10 Leagues. Downgraded horses/ponies do gain points in the Top 10 League, EquiMatch, Fine Line and Tackshop.co.nz. See Series Conditions <https://www.nzequestrian.org.nz/disciplines/dressage/competition/dressage-series-classes/>
10. **Tests:** All tests from DNZ Test book version 2023 or FEI Website. Please note new V2025 FEI tests may apply from 1 January 2025. FEI level Musical Freestyle Tests current as at 1st August 2024 will continue to apply. <https://inside.fei.org/fei/your-role/organisers/dressage/tests>
11. **Super 5 Tests:** Must be ridden from memory, no caller is permitted.
12. **FEI Tests:** Must be ridden from memory, no caller is permitted.
13. **Music for all Freestyle Classes:**
 - Music in MP3 format to be emailed to champsmusicals2025@gmail.com by 28/1/2025 for coalition into the correct Level.
 - Music to be supplied on the day on USB in **MP3 format** as a **backup**.
 - Only have the one music track on the USB so there is no confusion as to what track to play.
 - Make sure the USB is well named – ID Tag and full name, horses name, bridle number and what level you are competing. Class number is also helpful. Do not put unnamed USB's into plastic bags with details on paper as these can blow about and get mismatched.
 - Advise at what point around the arena the music is to start from. E.g. start at P.
 - Hand in your music to the caravan well before the class is due to start so they can be placed into class order prior to the class starting (not during the class competition).
 - When it is your time to ride, please present and make yourself known to the Music Caravan for identification as the correct combination to compete and be matched with your music.
 - Music will be returned to the office for collection at lunch times and end of the day.



Event Conditions

1. **Amendments:** The Organising Committee (OC) reserves the right to refuse entries, cancel the event, alter the programme/schedule and/or prize money within the ESNZ and DNZ Rules.
2. **Presentation of Prizes and Prize Money:** See DNZ Rule article 456.
 - a. All riders must attend advertised presentations. The Organising Committee reserves the right to withhold prize monies should a placegetter not attend an advertised prize giving.
 - b. The Organising Committee reserves the right to substitute prize money with goods of equal value or higher.
 - c. Prize money will only be paid out on scores of 57% and above.
 - d. All prize money will be paid by direct credit within 21 days of the event. The OC reserves the right to withhold prize monies should a place getter not attend an advertised prize giving. Please ensure your bank account details are loaded and noted as verified on EvoEvents, this is your responsibility as we will not be contacting you if you have not listed it.
 - e. Prize money will be paid out on a 1:2 ratio for Registered Pony Classes and Para Classes.
3. **Prize Giving:** Format and times will be advised in the Programme.
4. **Draw:** Any changes to the draw due to scratchings will be made after close of play each day starting Thursday night and will appear on EvoEvents overnight. Please check www.evoevents.co.nz daily. It is the rider's responsibility to check any new times posted.
5. **Scratching's:** Must be notified to the Entry Secretary Ken Wilson email sichampsentries@gmail.com or text 021339843. Text only please once competition has commenced.
6. **Stabling Refunds:** Where stabling requests cannot be met, refunds will be made by direct credit after the show. Allocations will be based on a first in first served basis except for yards/stables that are already leased. Please see Horse Accommodation section on page 6.
7. **Equal Placings:** In the case of equality in any qualifying class, the higher collective marks will determine the higher placing. If the competitors are still equal, then the higher co-efficient marks will determine the placings. If there is still an equality of points, the competitors are given the same placing. This is done automatically by the EvoEvents system.
8. **Pony Classes:** Are restricted to riders as per DNZ rule Article 403.
9. **Downgraded Horses/Ponies: Super 5 League and Zilco** – Downgraded horses/ponies may compete in Super 5 League and Zilco qualifiers and Island Championships but can not gain series points. See Series Conditions <https://www.nzequestrian.org.nz/disciplines/dressage/competition/dressage-series-classes/> and Downgrading Rule <https://www.nzequestrian.org.nz/esnz/rules-regulations/dressage-rules/>
10. **Riders with Multiple Horses, Class and Grade Restrictions:** Riders are limited to three horses. Horses and ponies are limited to one grade, except PARA Riders, Young Dressage Horse classes and ponies doing Super 5 tests or National Competitions. If riding more than one horse/pony, horses/ponies are restricted to two starts per day. Para Competitors may compete in a maximum of two tests per day ie Para class and able-bodied class. In the case where a rider is riding 2 horses in Advanced or above this, subject to OC approval, can be counted as one horse should that rider have two other horses entered. The OC will make every effort to ensure that riders have at least 60 minutes between rides. However, if this is not possible owing to the scheduling of classes, the maximum time possible between rides will be allocated.
11. **Helmets:** ESNZ approved and yellow tagged riding helmets must be worn at all times, at all levels, during the competition when mounted.
12. **Stallions:** Stallions must comply with ESNZ Article 133 and must be housed in a stable at all times.
13. **Non-Competing Horses:** All horses and ponies on the grounds after the official start time must be entered at the event unless the Organising Committee gives permission otherwise and then ground fees are to be paid.
14. **Media:** South Island Dressage Champs Organising Committee, Dressage NZ and ESNZ reserve the right to use event photographs, for marketing, publicity, advertising, funding applications as they see fit. Competitors and/or participants will receive no remuneration for this. All images remain the property of the South Island Dressage Champs Organising Committee.
15. **Liability:**
 - a. Competitors and spectators attending this event do so at their own risk.
 - b. Dunstan Horsefeeds NEC Christchurch, ESNZ, Dressage NZ or South Island Dressage Champs Organising Committee nor any representative of these bodies, accepts any liability for any loss, damage, injury or illness to horse/pony/rider, spectators, land, vehicles or any personal property whether caused by their negligence or breach of contract in any way whatsoever.

- c. Dunstan Horsefeeds NEC Christchurch, ESNZ, Dressage NZ or South Island Dressage Champs Organising Committee will not be liable for the safety or security of any goods/equipment or the loss of, or damage to such, brought in/stored at the venue, during the event.

16. Health & Safety:

- a. South Island Dressage Champs Organising Committee and Dressage NZ is committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy event for all participants and for providing the information, training and supervision needed to achieve this.
- b. Competitors and associated staff/visitors to the venue must comply with the ESNZ/Dressage NZ Rules and SI National Equestrian Centre Health & Safety Policies and appropriate Legislation and Health & Safety at Work Act 2015.
- c. Each Competitor and/or exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazard created, accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves at the venue of the Event.
- d. Copies of the event Health & Safety policy can be found at the event office.
- e. Any incident or near miss must be reported to the event office and an incident form completed.
- f. Any hazards identified must be reported to the event office.
- g. Competitors will be responsible for their safety at all times and must observe safe practices and follow event rules and officials' instructions at all times, ensuring that others are not put at risk by their actions.

17. ESNZ Concussion Policy:

- a) This event will be run under the ESNZ Concussion Policy Guidelines.
- b) Dressage NZ policy requires all riders to report to the Medical Officer following a fall.
- c) Medical clearance must be obtained before remounting or leaving the grounds.

18. ESNZ Drug & Alcohol Policy

ESNZ reserve the right to drug or alcohol test any participant at the event under the ESNZ Drug & Alcohol Policy 2020. This link will access the policy and frequently asked questions.

Entry Conditions

1. Entries close for the South Island Dressage Championships on **Thursday 16th January 2025 at 8.00pm**.
2. Payment to be made at time of entry by manual banking, made to South Island Dressage Champs Committee Account ANZ 06-0901-0874266-00 with name and rider ESNZ registration number as reference. If payment is not received within 3 working days of entry the entry will be returned as not valid.
3. Enter online at www.evoevents.co.nz. Fax, emailed or phone entries will not be accepted.
4. Entries & Changes – Can be made through EvoEvents Change Request or contact the Entry Secretary Ken Wilson sichampsentries@gmail.com
5. Any changes to the draw due to scratchings will be made after close of play each day and will appear on EvoEvents overnight. Please check www.evoevents.co.nz daily.
6. If anyone wants to do one or two days of the competition, please email sichampsentries@gmail.com

Entry, Event, Camping and Horse Accommodation Fees

Stable/Yard Fee: Is based on a 24 hour period and cover all the time you are on the grounds. The yards and stables are the property of Dunstan Horsefeeds NEC Christchurch and must be booked prior to the competition day, **they are then allocated and posted on EvoEvents with draw**. We will be checking during the day so please only use your allocated yard unless you advise the office of your requirement to move. Anyone caught using an unpaid stable will be charged plus a \$20.00 admin fee. As leased yards are being phased out from 31/7/2024 only yards in the 400 series, old yards, are now leased/owned for Dressage riders.

Horse Event Levy - Ground Fee \$34 per horse for event

Rider Event Levy - \$25 per rider non-refundable

Medic Event Levy - \$10 per rider non-refundable

Stables \$120 arrive Thursday - leave Sunday afternoon or depart Monday \$160

Covered Yards \$90 for arrive Thursday - leave Sunday afternoon or depart Monday \$120

Uncovered Yards \$36 arrive Thursday - leave Sunday afternoon or depart Monday \$48

If you are staying before or after the competition, please request extra accommodation costs by emailing sichampsentries@gmail.com

Camping Fees:

Non-Powered \$10.00 per night

Arrive Thursday - leave Sunday = \$30 or \$40 if leaving on Monday.

Powered \$25.00 per night - Power sites will be allocated and your site number will be sent to you.

Arrive Thursday - leave Sunday = \$75 or \$100 if leaving on Monday.

Please state arrival and departure date on EvoEvents with your entry.

Withdrawals and Refunds

Applications for refunds must be submitted on the **Withdrawal Form**, second last page of this schedule, then sent to the Entry Secretary Ken Wilson sichampsentries@gmail.com

Final date for refund applications – Friday 14th February 2025.

Conditions of withdrawal from the event before close of entries.

- Competitors that withdraw prior to close of entries are to submit their withdrawal through EvoEvents, followed up with a refund application form completed and emailed to the Event Secretary by entry close date 16th January 2025. Competitors are still liable for online entry fees, EvoEvent fees, medic fee and rider levies which are non-refundable.
- All other fees paid will be refunded. No Vet or Dr's Certificate required.

Conditions of withdrawal from the event after close of entries.

- Stabling and camping fees will be 100% refunded in all cases.
- Online entry fees, EvoEvents fees, medic fee and rider levies will not be refunded.
- If unable to provide a vet or doctors certificate will receive no ground fee or entry fee refund.
- If a doctor or vet certificate is provided ground fee and entry fees will be refunded.
- If vet certificate provided, only the horse to which the certificate applies will receive a refund.
- If doctors certificate provided fees for all horses for that rider will be refunded.
- You must obtain a Vet/Doctors Certificate and complete the Withdrawal Form which is the second last page of this schedule. The withdrawal form needs to be received by the Event Secretary by 14th February 2025.
- Special applications for refunds can be presented to the OC for consideration with withdrawal form.

Championship Eligibility Points & Awards Levels Preliminary - Grand Prix, PARA and Non-Graded Preliminary - Novice

1. Combinations are eligible for one level of Championship only.
2. **Level Championship Awards**
 - Registered Horses L1 – L9 Rug and Trophy to each level "Open" Champion, sash to Reserve Champion. Sashes to Bronze Champion and Reserve L1-L5. Bronze Champions are eligible to win Open Championships.
 - Registered Ponies L1 – L4 Trophy and sash to each level Champion, sash to Reserve Champion. Rug to overall Registered Pony Champion across L1-L4 ie only one rug to be presented for Registered ponies. Calculated as per awards on page 8.
 - PARA – Rug to Champion, sash to Reserve Champion, over all PARA grades combined.
 - Non-Graded – Sashes to L1 and L2 Champions and Reserves. One Hay Bag to L1 combined horse/pony highest championship points and one Hay Bag to L2 combined horse/pony highest championship points.
3. Championship points are allocated 20 for 1st, to 1 for 20th in all classes except see next point 4.
4. ****Weighted Classes** - Points are allocated 30 for 1st through to 1.5 for 20th in all classes denoted by ******.
5. See class schedule for classes used and weighted classes.
6. Points towards the Championship will only be awarded for scores of 57% and above.
7. Champions and Reserves: The combination with the highest aggregate allocated points from specified classes in the Schedule of classes will be the Championship winner. In the event of a tie, the combination with the highest place in the ****** weighted qualifier is the winner. If there is still a tie, the combination with the highest aggregate collective marks in the ****** weighted qualifier will be the winner. If there is a further tie, the combination with the highest average % over all classes will be the winner.

Age Group Championship Eligibility – Graded Classes/Riders

1. **Combinations are eligible for one level of Championship only. Champion sashes only will be awarded.**
2. **Champion Junior Rider:** For riders on a horse from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach 12 until they reach the age of 16. Riders who turn 16 on or after 1st August may continue competing as a Junior until the 31st July in the following calendar year. **Please ensure your correct date of birth is shown in EvoEvents.**
3. **Champion Young Rider:** For Riders on a Horse or Pony from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 16 years until they reach the age of 21. Riders who turn 21 on or after 1st August may compete as a Young Rider until the 31st July in the following calendar year. **Please ensure your correct date of birth is shown in EvoEvents.**
4. **Riders are only eligible for one Award either Junior Rider or Young Rider not both.**
5. **Champion Pony Rider:** For riders on a pony until they reach the age of 17 years. Riders who turn 17 on or after 1 August may compete until 31 July in the following calendar year. **Please ensure your correct date of birth is shown in EvoEvents.**
6. **Champion Pony Rider 12 years and Under:** For riders on a Pony until they reach the age of 13 years. Riders who turn 13 on or after 1 August may compete until 31 July in the following calendar year. **Please ensure your correct date of birth is shown in EvoEvents.**
7. **Riders will only be eligible for one Award either Champion Pony Rider or Champion Pony Rider 12 years and Under not both.**
8. **Champion Masters:** Open to riders on horse or pony. Riders must be aged 50 years or over as at 1st January.

Championship Points Junior Rider Award, Young Riders Award, Pony Rider Awards and Masters Award

Championship points are allocated in the table below. Most points across three tests per grade will count. For Horse Classes - L1 B, C & D tests, L2 - L5 MFS, B and C tests and L6 - L9 all tests. For Pony Classes – A, B and C tests will count.

In the event of a tie, the horse contesting the highest level will be the winner. In the event of a further tie, the combination with the highest place in the qualifier ** is the winner.

Special Awards – To be entered via EvoEvents Where Stated

Hanoverian Society Award: Two awards presented Level Preliminary-Medium and Advanced Medium and above. The award will be presented to the highest-level Hanoverian Champion, if no champion then the reserve. If there is neither the sash will lapse for that grade this year. Horses must be registered with NZ Hanoverian Society. **Please state at time of entry to be eligible. Please ensure NZ Hanoverian registration documents are uploaded onto the horses record on EvoEvents to be eligible. Must enter at time of entry.**



Roanoake Just Tru Trophy: Open to horses with at least 25% cold blood, competing in graded classes from Preliminary through to Advanced. E.g. Irish, Draught, Friesian, St James, Clydesdale, Cleveland Bay and French Draught. Most points across three tests being L1 B, C & D tests, L2 - L5 MFS, B and C tests and L6 all tests. **Must enter at time of entry.**

Rosari Guest Star Memorial Trophy: Highest % musical classes L2 - L5.

Monique Memorial: Highest % musical classes Advanced L6 - L9.

Buckton Tumbledown Trophy: Champion Registered Pony (to have competed in registered pony classes). Three classes per grade will count. The applicable classes are detailed in the class section of the schedule. Points allocated as per table above for Rider Awards. In the event of a tie, the pony contesting the highest level will be the winner, in the event of a further tie the combination with the highest place in the qualifier ** is the winner.

Abbotsburn Challenge Goblet: Turnout – Judges Choice

Bronze and Open Champions & Reserve – for Preliminary to and including Advanced Medium graded Horse levels. All classes to be included. Rug to “Open” Champion and Sashes to Bronze Champion and Open and Bronze Reserves. Bronze Champions are eligible to win Open Championships also.

Pony Breeders Society Award: A rosette will be awarded to the highest placed pony registered with the Pony Breeders Society NZ. Pony must be fully registered with the Pony Breeders Society NZ (Inc) that is to have a permanent registration number and to be foaled in New Zealand. **Please ensure PBSNZ registration number is uploaded onto pony’s record on EvoEvents. Must enter at time of entry.**

Area Teams Competition – Entry form is attached to this schedule (2nd last page) or can be collected from the Events Office on the Grounds. Teams to be nominated to the Event Office by 12 noon Friday 7th February 2025, stating team name, riders names, horse/pony names and grades. Areas can nominate more than one team. Teams to consist of 4 riders all competing at different levels, can be graded and non-graded. One rider, one horse and riders can only go in one team. If an Area is one rider short, they can “borrow” a rider from another area. Two tests per team member will count towards points. These tests will be Fridays test for each grade, graded and non-graded classes and Saturdays “B” test (ie 1B, 2B, 3B etc) for graded and non-graded levels L1-L5 plus Saturdays test for L6-L9 unless timetabling alters the days and riders will then be notified. Rosettes to the winning team.

Young Dressage Horse Classes With Commentary – 4,5,6 and & 7yr Old

- All horses must have the correct breed/pedigree/breeder information on file with ESNZ and the Event Management System – this is to ensure commentary is correct and all information needed is provided.
- Refer to the DNZ Rule Book Annex 7 (A7) page 66.
- ESNZ Horse registration is required but Horses do not require a discipline start.
- Breeding will be announced prior to entry to the arena and a short commentary will be given after each test.

Competition Arena Use & Familiarisation

1. All Competition Arenas are closed at all times except as stated below.
2. These times may be amended please check times in rider notes provided with the draw.
3. Arena familiarisation is not intended to be used as a full schooling session.
4. Riders need to be considerate of other riders wishing to familiarise their horses.
5. Lunging to be in the lunging arena only.
6. Horses may be hand walked or ridden at walking pace around the exterior of the competition arena unless advised otherwise by the Technical Delegate.
7. Any person leading a horse in an arena familiarisation, must be wearing a correctly fitting yellow tagged helmet. All horses being lead must be wearing a bridle with a permitted bit, and with two bridle numbers. A newmarket lead may replace the reins for this purpose.
8. Arena familiarisation time: Friday 7th February in the morning time TBA. ** Please note this may be subject to change and will be updated in the rider notes.

Horse Identification, Venue, Stabling, Yards and Accommodation Conditions

1. Approved Dressage NZ Horse/Pony identification numbers must be worn on both sides at all times warming up, competing and when being ridden or led in Arena Familiarisation.
2. When not competing, it is compulsory that horses/ponies are identified with ID tags also that include, person responsible name and mobile phone contact number.
3. All yards and stables are to be left properly mucked out. If not a fee of \$50 will be charged. It is recommended all riders take a photo of their cleaned out yard clearly showing their yard number on departure as proof.
4. Stallions must comply with ESNZ Article 133 and must be housed in a stable at all times.
5. Please keep wash down bays clean at all times.
- 6. Yards and Power Sites will be allocated and posted on EvoEvents with the draw.**
7. Moving horses to unallocated yards or stables is prohibited without permission of the Stable Manager.
8. Please use the skips provided for horse waste not rubbish, wheelie bins are provided for rubbish only.
9. No smoking or vaping in any buildings or stable areas.
10. Damage to Dunstan Horsefeeds National Equestrian Centre Christchurch facilities is to be reported to the Event Office.
- 11. Please state arrival and departure date on EvoEvents with your entry.**

Yards

1. Temporary yarding must comply with ESNZ rules and location to be approved by the Stable Manager.
2. New yarding has been added to the east of the present new yards and as such all yards have been renumbered. A new yarding plan will be sent out at the same time as the draw.
3. All 500 and 600 yards are not going to be leased once the present agreement runs out.
4. New six hundred series yards do not have power sites so we will be allocating those to people who are camping without power.
5. We will allocate the new yards unless you prefer the old yards in which case you need to advise us on your entry. Some of these are leased or owned so there are limited numbers.
- 6. Power sites will be allocated and posted on EvoEvents with the draw.**

Dogs

1. Dogs must be kept in the truck/car park area at all times.
2. No dogs are allowed in the warm up, competition areas or buildings.
3. Dogs must be on a lead at all times.
4. The owner of the dog will be responsible for the cost of any damage/harm caused by the dog at the competition, and the associated rider will face elimination due to any disregard of these rules.
5. Any person with a dog causing disruption or concern may be asked to leave the grounds at the discretion of the OC.

Camping & Power Sites

1. Trucks and campervans requesting power must have a valid electrical certificate and under no circumstances will allow other vehicles to connect to their vehicle via extension cords.
2. Power can only be connected from the 10 approved power boxes. At no stage can power be connected from toilets or stable block.
3. **Power sites will be allocated and posted on EvoEvents with the draw.**
4. Please be tidy and use green wheelie bins for all rubbish – no animal waste in green bins.
5. Waste and grey water tanks must only be emptied in designated waste water dumps.

Vehicles & Access

1. Speed limit for all vehicles 15 kph.
2. Motorbikes must not be used after 8.30 pm and must be used in accordance with normal road rules.
3. Persons under 16yrs may not use motorbikes.
4. Approved safety helmets must be worn when riding motorbikes at all times.
5. Joy riding on any part of the grounds at any time will not be tolerated.
6. Bicycle helmets must be worn in accordance with NZ road rules.

Professional Services

1. Equine Therapists and Treatment
 - a. Any equine therapists or practitioners who are not veterinarian and intend to provide therapeutic treatment to equines in any capacity at this event in a private or commercial basis must notify the Organising Committee of any treatment prior to the event.
 - b. All practitioners must also comply with the Conditions applicable to this event set out in the Schedule of classes.
 - c. Riders who own their equipment (eg Equissage, Cyclossage or similar) are only permitted to treat their own horses with these systems at the event.
 - d. Any practitioner receiving financial or other gain from providing therapies at the event will be required to pay a trade exhibitor fee at the discretion of the Organising Committee.
2. Other Professionals including freelance grooms
 - a. Any other professional intending on providing services at this event must obtain prior agreement from the Organising Committee – this excludes professionals Dressage Coaches assisting in the warmup of competitors and grooms that are in part or full-time employment of a competitor.

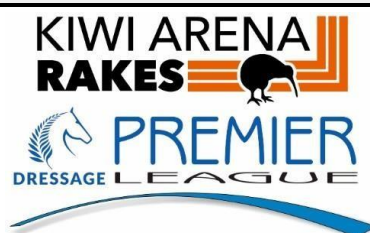

1. This event is run under ESNZ Para-Equestrian Rules, ESNZ General Rules and 2. Regulations and ESNZ Dressage Rules where applicable.
2. All riders must be current full financial members of ESNZ at time of entry, and current until at least 9th February 2025.
3. All horses must have ESNZ registration at time of entry and current until at least 9th February 2025.
4. All PE riders must have a current FEI or ESNZ ID card, a copy of which must be carried at all times while riding.
5. ESNZ, Dressage NZ & ESNZ Para-Equestrian rules apply from time of arrival where applicable.
6. All tests are the current versions that are on the ESNZ or FEI Website.
7. All Riders are to always display the Official Orange Para Badge on each side of their saddle cloth while schooling, hacking or competing as well as the horse's ESNZ registration number on both sides of the bridle or saddle cloth.
8. A horse may not be shared by different riders between PE and able-bodied classes.
9. A horse may be shared by riders of different grades in PE classes as per Para-Equestrian Rules Article 166.
10. While every effort will be made to accommodate riders wishing to compete in both PE and AB classes and to accommodate PE riders with more than one horse, the smooth running of the event is paramount, and should there be excessive entries or timetabling issues, then riders may be asked to nominate which horse/discipline they want to compete in. No more than two tests per day per horse/rider combination can be entered.
