The Woodhill Sands Story

Woodhill Sands is a story of collaboration across the equestrian community, to ensure a lasting place for equestrian sports competition and training in the Auckland Region. Woodhill Sands Equestrian Centre is a community led development purchased by the sport through The Woodhill Sands Trust, in October 2017 to secure ongoing access to this wonderful venue.

The equestrian community undertook extensive fundraising, collecting funds for the required deposit, allowing the Trust to complete the purchase. This occurred in October 2017 with a 20-year mortgage from ASB Bank with support from Auckland Council as guarantor.

Woodhill Sands is now owned by the sport and all the riders that come from far and wide to train and compete at the facility

Woodhill Sands Trust and other groups from across the riding community hold events throughout the year catering for all levels across all the different areas of our sport.

Woodhill Sands is the only venue with a 100% natural, all-weather surface (sand based). This provides a wonderful solution for a riding surfaces to enable year round competition and training activity. Indeed, participation extends for a full 12 months across multiple disciplines most weekends. Elsewhere, winter competition on this scale is very limited due to unsuitable ground conditions. As a result, Woodhill Sands is a key venue for horse riders to train and compete all year round.

The Team at Woodhill Sands are excited about the future and look forward to sharing it with riders, supporters and spectators for many years to come.

ENTRIES

Entries will only be accepted with full, clear payment & must be made on line at www.evoevents.co.nz

REGISTRATION RIDERS - IMPORTANT

To compete in Introductory Classes – Riders must be either a full ESNZ member, an Introductory member or pay a Casual Membership fee of \$16.30 per show. NB. No casual equine registration or flexi start fee is needed to do Intro classes. Horses 90cm and under & Ponies 80cm and under.

Riders must be full members to compete in all other classes.

REGISTRATION HORSES JUMPING SHOWS ONLY

To compete in Open Classes - Horses not registered with ESNZ must pay a Casual Equine fee of \$5.15, plus a Flexi Start fee of \$25 to compete in Open Classes up to 1.10m for Horses, and 1m for Ponies. If your horse is registered for another discipline but not for SJ/SH the Flexi Start fee applies. You cannot enter a series class or be eligible for HOYQ points in Show Hunter. Classes above this height or series classes require full registration.

All horses must pay a \$7 jumping levy per show.

PAYMENT— IMPORTANT INFORMATION!!!

No rider will be able to compete at the show without entries being paid for prior to riding.

Payment can be made via Poli (internet banking) or Stripe (credit card).

If you have any technical issues and payment isn't made you will need to pay directly to our bank account 12-3019-0013702-00 with **the date of the show you are entering as reference and the surname of person entered**. Please email us to let us know you have done this, so we can download your entry. Failure to do so will result in entries not being processed.

SCRATCHING/ REFUNDS

Entries withdrawn before close of entry are entitled to a FULL refund of all fees (except their online & admin) fee.

After close of entries riders must present a doctor or vet certificate to be receive a refund of 75% of entry, ground, yard and accommodation fees this must be received within 5 days of the event.

On Line entry fee & Administration fee is non refundable irrespective on when scratching. Refunds will be paid out within 2 weeks of event.

LATE ENTRIES/CLASS CHANGES

Late entries are accepted. Riders will jump first in draw order classes. Riders will have a 50% late entry fee charged per round. Class Changes will incur a \$5 class change fee if not done via Evo Events.

PRIZE MONEY

Will be paid out at the conclusion of show to the bank account number which is verified on your Evo Events account - (less any balance that might be owing the show if applicable) Please make sure your bank account information is up to date in Evo. For Series Classes - prizes (in cash or kind) will be paid to 6th place, regardless of the number of penalties in the first round.

OFFICE

Opens at 8am. Class changes/entries maybe made on line at anytime.

VENUE RULES - Help us keep you safe!

No passenger cars parked in float/truck park! Park on grass by toilets or on grass outside gates.

No tying horses to fences! No leading from horse back (ponying).

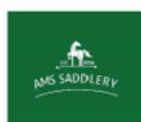
