RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR HORSE SECTION

Please read carefully

1. Judging Commences:

2. The committee reserves the right to alter, delete or combine classes at their discretion depending on entries.
3. Where there are four or less entries, prize money will be paid for 1st and 2nd places only. Where there are two or less entries, prize money will be paid for 1st place only.
4. The committee will refund 80% of entry fee on presentation of a vet or medical certificate.
5. Charges for stables and yards are \$10.00 per night. Those leaving boxes untidy will not be eligible for allocation next year. Please take a photo of yard once mucked out – with stable number in photo. Txt to 027 228 3451 or email to the Show Secretary. Limited stabling and yards available, so get entries in early! Camping is free to competitors, toilets on site.
6. Ridden horses and ponies must be three years and over.
7. Age of rider is at 1st August 2025.
8. The use of tranquilisers, stimulants or any drug, which affects the performance of horse or ponies, is forbidden. Clean sport testing may be carried out at any time under the RAS Clean Sport rules.
9. Any protest must be accompanied by \$50.00 and put in writing to the Secretary. The fee will be forfeited in the event the protest is lost. The protest must be lodged within an hour of the event in dispute. The protest committee is the Horse secretary, and the Chef Steward or Marshall for the appropriate section.
10. Riders in Best Rider in the Hack Section must be seventeen years old and over.
11. Riders may swap rings for their eligible rider class but classes will not stop to wait for them.
12. Whips must not exceed 76 cm in the ring classes.
13. Lead rein ponies are not exceeding 128 cm. Rider 4 years up to and including 7 years of age. These children are those yet unable to ride without assistance from a leader or attendant and should be judged accordingly. Snaffle bridle with lead rein attached to the noseband. No whips, spurs or cantering. Riders in this section are not eligible to compete in any other section, unless in a Lead Rein class. Ponies to be judged on suitability and safety 60%. Conformation 40%
14. First ridden ponies. Rider under 10 years old. No cantering is allowed as a class. However, the judge may ask for a canter in the individual workouts. A cane or whip not exceeding 68 cm in length with a flap 2 cm by 4 cm long may be carried. Riders are eligible to compete in the First Ridden Section for a maximum of 24 months from the date of the first show in this section. Ponies to be judged on suitability and safety 60%. Conformation and paces 40%.
15. We have some lead rein classes that are non-RAS and are open to any child who lacks confidence off the lead rein. These classes have Non-RAS beside them in the schedule. They are open to all child competitors.
16. Boundaries for DISTRICT classes are Omotomutu Creek (Kaiata) to the south, Rahu Saddle to the east, Inangahua Junction turnoff to the northwest, and Iron Bridge boundary both sides of the river to the northwest.
17. Miniature horse section is run under NZMHA Rules. Exhibits are required to carry current RAS height certificates.

18. a) A NOVICE is a horse or pony that has had no more than five wins at any A&P Show at the time of the show.
b) A NOVICE Hunter is a horse or pony that has had no more than five wins in hunter jumping at the time of show.
c) HORSE AND PONY HEIGHT PERFORMANCE CARDS must be carried. Failure to do so could result in elimination. DAY CERTIFICATES will NOT be issued at our show this year. Please ensure you have a current height certificate before show day. Versatility classes do not require height certificates or performance cards.
19. Only novice horses/ponies can enter novice classes.
20. ALL horse/ponies can enter open classes.
21. Entrants in all novice classes MUST be shown in a snaffle bridle.
22. In all rings only 1st prize winners in classes stated will parade for Championships. Once the Champion has been selected, the 2nd placed horse/pony to the Champion MUST be allowed to parade for judging of Reserve Champion.
23. Novice Championship winners not eligible for Supreme Awards.
24. All show jumping is non-grading. Ponies may be ridden by adults but must enter the hack section. You may enter up to 3 show jumping classes.
25. Training show jumping classes do not count for champion points.
26. All riders must wear protective headgear, which includes a retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Due to new regulations, helmets are required to be red tagged to show their compliance with current standards. Please ensure your helmet meets these standards and is tagged to prevent elimination. Please note: as from 1 August 2023 new standards come in to force where a 'yellow' tag must be shown - <https://www.ras.org.nz/equestrian/health-and-safety/>

28. Entries must be received with full payment to be accepted.
29. The Association will not be held responsible for loss, damage or mis - delivery of stock or equipment exhibited in the show.

Limited stabling / yarding at \$10 is available so get entries in early please

There is a \$12 compulsory admin fee per entry (If you are entering more than one horse then you only need to pay this fee once) This entitles you to a horse vehicle gate pass and free camping for both Friday and Saturday nights. This covers our ground hire and means you do not need a gate pass.
