ESNZ Eventing Test L1

\$400 (plus EE fee) per team of 4

- **No rider and horse combination is allowed to compete if the combination has placed in the top 6 at an 80cm ODE, 2DE or HT or competed at a higher level since 1 September 2024.**
- **Entries on Evo Events – Team manager to do entry.**
- **Entry fee includes Medic Fee per team and Ground Fee.**

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Team members must be financial members of a Pony Club, 25 years & under.
2. Each rider must have done required rallies on the selected mount as per NZPCA rally rules (NZPCA General Regulations Cl 15.4). If this requirement is breached the whole team will be disqualified.
3. No horse and rider combination may compete if the combination has been placed in the top 6 at an 80cm ODE, 2DE or HT, or competed at a higher level since 1 September 2024. Checks will be made and breach of this rule will result in disqualification of the whole team. The event is designed for less experienced combinations to give it a go riding in a team so if a rider who has placed in the top 6 at 80cm or ridden at a higher level rides a different horse they must not have been selected in the place of a less experienced rider who would otherwise have been given the opportunity to compete in the team.
4. Teams consist of up to 4 riders. The 3 best scores in a team are counted for overall prizes and all 4 will be counted in dressage.
5. Draft riders can be put forward to make up teams.
6. Teams may consist of members from different Branches.
7. Branches/Clubs may enter more than one team.
8. The dress code is pony club uniform, subject to the following:
 - For the dressage phase all riders must wear pony club uniform, no jackets but gloves are required.
 - Teams may have a theme/matching outfits/fancy dress, etc, for show jumping and cross country phases providing usual gear safety requirements are met and back numbers are clearly visible, or alternatively must wear pony club uniform.
9. There will be one dressage test for all riders, being ESNZ Eventing Test L1.
10. All 4 riders in a team will enter the dressage arenas at the same time.
11. There will be one show jumping arena. All riders jumping 65cm will start first, followed by all riders jumping 80cm. The same course will be used for each height. Height must be nominated with your entry.
12. Each rider may only show jump one height. Penalty for jumping two courses will be elimination.
13. The event is run at 65cm to 80cm levels with options at all cross country jumps to choose either height. No penalties will be awarded to those taking the smaller options.
14. Approved helmets must be worn at all times when mounted. All helmets must have a YELLOW NZPCA approved tag.
15. Long sleeves must be worn for ALL jumping phases.
16. Approved back protectors must be worn for XC.
17. Team gear checks will be held for all 3 phases, managers must be present.
18. Each AMPC team must provide 1 helper per rider for the day. All other teams must supply 2 helpers per team for pole picking up, dressage arena pack up, cross-country jump judges, etc. Names and phone numbers must be supplied with your entry so that jobs may be allocated before the day. Preferred role can be indicated but is not guaranteed. Back numbers will not be issued without names and phone numbers of nominated helpers.

19. Entry fee is \$400 per team (Inc Medic Fee & Ground Fee).

20. No refunds given for scratchings without a veterinarian or doctor certificate. For each scratching to be refunded, \$10 admin fee will be charged and 80% refund (less Admin & EE fees) will be given.

21. Changes to be requested through Evo Events and all changes made will be charged a \$10 admin fee. No changes will be made after close of entries.

22. Entries close on Monday 17 March 2025 or earlier if entries are full.

23. All Entries to be done on Evo Events by Team Manager.

PRIZES

- Trophy awarded to the overall winning team
- Trophy awarded to top AMPC team
- Trophy for the best performing Auckland under 13 rider
 - Trophy for team commitment
 - Rosettes for all placegetters
 - Ribbons for all participants
 - Sashes for winning teams

If time allows team members are asked to be present for prize giving presentations at the end of the day, mounted and in pony club uniform or team jumping outfits. If this changes notice will be provided on the day.

All trophies will be presented and available for photos and then must be returned to AMPC

Māngere Pony Club canteen will be open – cash only. Coffee van will also be on site.
