Important Entry Information

- RIDERS TO PROVIDE THEIR OWN BACK NUMBER HOLDERS AND PRINT THEIR BACK NUMBERS
- Over 25 classes will be placed overall within the height they select. They will compete as one group for dressage phase and all complete the same dressage test regardless of jump heights
- Test callers will be allowed for all classes except 95cm.
- Gear checks will be compulsory for all classes
- The draw will be emailed out and can be found via Evo Events. You will be given dressage times; elimination may occur if you are not at your arena on time. The SJ will be run prior to the XC for all phases, you will be expected to jump your SJ within 30 minutes of your dressage test being completed, where applicable. Those on multiple horses will be accommodated, please be prompt.
- Helmets must display a yellow tag, if required bring to marquee for inspection and tagging before dressage phase.
- Back protectors must be worn for XC and red tagged. Long sleeve top recommended for XC and SJ phases
- All scratching's to be received via email by Thursday 21 November. A refund of 80% will be at the discretion of the organising committee.
- All Entries MUST supply a Jump Judge
- Adult Riders who are on own will be given allocated time slot that gives them time to compete in their class as well as help.
- NZPC Rules apply at all times with ESNZ Rules used as guidelines in competition, all riders ride at own risk.
- Committee reserves the right to alter the program as deemed necessary.
- Draw will be emailed out and posted on appropriate websites or FB pages.
- 2 SJ rings at different heights will run at the same time – time, ring and order to be set when draw done.
- Please remove all rubbish, tape, hay and manure from around trucks and floats
- No taped pens allowed around floats, trucks or in parking area.
- Camping by arrangement only. Please contact Emma Campbell 022 0703572 - \$10 per Equine.
- Abuse of any Horse/Pony or Person's will not be tolerated this will result in elimination of rider or the rider associated with the abuser, you will be asked to leave the grounds immediately
- Whakapara Pony Club and the landowners disclaims all liability in the event of an accident, loss or damage to competitors, mounts, spectators or property.

- NO DOGS ALLOWED – at landowner's request – will result in elimination.
- Please bring own water and take all rubbish with you.
- No Go-Pro's please – riders are not permitted to wear go-pros (or any similar device) while riding at any stage during the event.
