General Event Conditions & Information

- **Dogs-** must be on a leash (no longer than 5m) at all times & to be under control of suitable person. Failure to comply will result in fine for owner (multiple fines may result in dog being removed from the grounds). All proceeds to FF NEC. **Minimum fine per offence \$100.**
- **Non-competition Horses** - please check with Event Secretary that there is available space for these - then please book with Entries & pay the Facility Fee & accommodation.
- **Camping/Yarding for Event:** Facility Use Fee - \$25 per horse; Camping \$15 per truck; Power \$20 per connection (Limited); Stable \$30 Covered Yard \$26 (Limited); Paddock \$16 per horse; Open Yard \$12; Day Yard \$5. If you are arriving prior to the event - you may need to pay extra facility, camping & yarding fees. Please notify Event Secretary.
- **Enter on EvoEvents - www.evoevents.co.nz**
- **Bank Account: ASB Wild Riders 12-3093-0344542-00**
- **Refunds** - ALL classes 80% of entry fees if scratching received prior to 49 hours before start of competition. Refunds will be paid electronically into your bank account week following event. Other refunds at OC discretion. All Refund requests must be in writing - including your bank details & correct name on account.

- All Horses attending must be allocated & use a yard - including horses competing that are not staying. NO HORSES ARE TO BE TIED TO TRUCKS/FLOATS. This is a request from FF NEC, please respect this. Consequences for non-compliance.
- All horses must have back numbers (XC) on whilst being ridden. You will need a XC bib for these paper #'s - we will print these & have available for collection from 7.30am.
- The organising committee reserve the right to restrict entries as necessary & alter classes as required.
- Draw & yarding will be emailed to you - please supply relevant email address with entries or available on Evo Events Friday.
- **Liability:** Neither the Organiser of any event to which these rules apply nor the NF nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, vehicles, their contents & accessories or any other personal property whatsoever whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract, or in any other way whatsoever.
- *Make yourself aware of the hazards & precautions identified at main entrance of FF NEC on your arrival.*
- **Reminder: Correctly Tagged Body Protectors must be worn on Cross Country & Safety Helmets at all times.**

How the day will run:

1. SJ - Approximately 16 fences in the SJ ring ranging in heights from 65cm to 1.05m. Joker = 25 points (only jump once) after you have jumped 8 obstacles. You can jump each fence either way & each fence can be jumped twice (ie. Once each way) - you will earn points equivalent to the number of the fence. No points earned for refusal (it does count as an attempt at obstacle) no points for fences where rails are knocked down.
2. XC - 3 Heights of jumps will be flagged. Blue #'s up to 80cm; Red #'s up to 95cm & Green #'s up to 1.05m. Blue = 10points; Red = 15points; Green = 20points. You can mix them up around the XC. If there is a combination (abc) you will need to jump the same colour through the combination.
3. All falls of rider must be checked by Medic before continuing for the day & before driving home.
4. Nothing is timed.....so no need to be in a hurry or out of control. You can circle between the fences (not combinations) & you can miss fences you don't want to jump. You DO need to walk the course, so you know where you are going..... Fences need to be jumped in numerical order 😊 - this is so it doesn't look like a "round-up" on the XC pitch - more like a well executed dance routine 😊 😊 😊
