Entries

All entries are to be through EVO EVENTS (previously equestrian entries) website (www.evoevents.co.nz), with the use of Polipay – no exceptions. If you are unfamiliar with either of these processes, please do not leave it until the last minute. Problems encountered with the Evo Events website should be directed to Evo Events, using the website chat function or phone 021 684 858 and not to the Wanganui A&P Show committee. Entries will not be accepted or processed until payment has been received.

- Entries close WEDNESDAY 10TH DECEMBER.

Ground levy of \$10 per horse will apply. This will be capped at \$30 for anyone who brings 3 or more horses.

Rider levy of \$15 per rider – this includes the rider first aid levy.

Entries for Recreational Rings

Recreational rings have blanket fee of \$40 – This allows you to do inhand & ridden sections as a combination.

If you are wanting to only do one section of the recreational discipline (e.g. inhand or ridden) please select the \$40 Recreational fee & the \$15 discount.

Entering multiple sections

If competitors cross enter/ enter different sections they do so at their own risk. Classes will not be held up for a competitor nor will you receive a refund if you miss your class

Prize Money

All prize money will be paid out to the bank account number on your Evo events account within three weeks of the show. All prizes and prize money are GST inclusive.

Refunds and Scratching's

The Association will refund 80% of entry fees on scratching's or withdrawals on or before Wednesday 10th December. Scratching subsequent to this date will be considered on a case-by-case basis. Refunds will be processed after the show - no refunding of \$10 or less. There is no refund of cancelled entries for yards as we will have already booked, transported and paid for them.

Horse of the Year Qualifying Show

The Wanganui A & P Show is a qualifying show for Horse of the Year 2026.

Access and Camping

Camping is available on the grounds for **Friday night, Saturday night**.

Please Park in the correct areas; signage will be up from 10am on Friday.

Please select the \$0 camping fee on Evo events when entering and please state which nights you will be staying.

We will be offering unpowered camping sites only.

****NEW** COMPETITORS STAYING ON FRIDAY NIGHT** – Due to Health & Safety concerns we have had to bring in a new policy for Friday night campers. Camping for Friday night will not be in the centre oval of the racecourse, it will be on the grass area over by the stables and yards. Entrance for Friday night campers is via PURNELL STREET in the float parking gate. You will come through the gate and head left onto the grass area and camp/park there. There is no camping on the gravel carpark area as this is reserved for racehorse trainers' vehicles. You are welcome to leave your vehicle here for the duration of the show or you can drive around to the Anson Street gate on Saturday morning and remain there for the rest of the show. Camping on Saturday evening can be in either location.

There is no going in the tie up or wash bay area, getting any horses or ponies out of yards or boxes on Saturday morning until all the racehorses have left the racecourse. We will have committee managing the area whilst racehorses are coming and going.

Parking

The clearways allow for competitor/spectator/emergency and staff access. All designated clearways marked by cones or signs are to be kept free of parked vehicles during the running of the show. All hay and manure and rubbish must be raked up and dumped in correct places.

Legal Liability

Our Association's Public Liability Policy does not cover Competitors or Exhibitors.

Protests

Protests must be lodged in writing with the secretary no later than 30 minutes after the conclusion of the event concerned. A deposit of \$50 must accompany each protest. This will be refunded if the protest is upheld.

Head Wear Yellow Tagged helmets are to be worn at all times when mounted. Please note that from August 2023 new standards imposed – a yellow tag is to be worn- <https://www.ras.org.nz/equestrian/health-and-safety/>

Yards & Stables ****NEW****

- Competitors can select their own yards and stables when doing entries. There is Yarding map document available on Evo events to have a look at.
- Selecting your own yards and stables is not guaranteed it is a request. The committee have the right to move you if it is needed.
- **-Stables are \$40 for the duration of the show.**
- **-Uncovered Yards are \$30 for the duration of the show.**
- Booking is essential.
- No temporary fence accommodation is permitted.
- Yard allocation will be emailed out prior to the show.
- Please leave your yards and boxes clean.
- A \$50 fine will be invoiced to anyone who leaves their stables/ yards dirty and if this is not paid it will affect you entering any future shows associated with the Wanganui A&P and will remain on your Evoevents account.
- We highly recommend taking a picture of your yards and stables when leaving the grounds.

Dogs

Dogs are welcome. **There will be a \$50 fine for any dog caught on the premises that is not on a lead and under control or near the racecourse running rails in the morning while racehorses are working.**

“new racecourse rule” there are to be no dogs in or around the racecourse stables and yards area. if any committee sees this rule being broken you will be asked to pack up and leave as if we do not follow racecourse rules we will lose the use of the grounds.

RAS

The RAS Equestrian Rulebook (www.ras.org.nz) sets out all conditions applying to showing classes offered. All entry fees to all show rings and show jumping classes include a \$1.25 RAS levy.

RAS Height Certificates/Novice Performance Cards must be carried at all times and presented on request. No card – no start. No exceptions. (excludes working hunter classes, recreational classes are optional)

Ras Resolution Process – This show supports the RAS In-Line resolution Process Policy. A Yellow or Red card will be issued for offences of abuse of animals or inappropriate behaviour as per the RAS Constitution and the RAS Rules & regulations /Bylaws including the Equestrian Rulebook. Full working of the in-line Resolution Policy is available to view on the RAS website – www.ras.org.nz

Clean Sport – Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the show under the RAS rules. A forbidden substance is any substance capable of affecting the speed, stamina, courage or conduct of a horse or pony by its action upon the central or peripheral nervous system or the cardiovascular, respiratory, digestive, muscoskeletal or urogenital systems.

Arrears -No person who is in arrears with regard to entry fees, subscriptions, or any other Show/Event charge is eligible to compete at any affiliated Show/Event. Proof of payment will be required before any restriction is lifted.

Summary of RAS Resolution Process – the full process can be found on the RAS website www.ras.org.nz. The principle behind the process is to deal with the matter as it comes to hand and in most cases, it should be dealt with directly by the show. If the matter is in regard to an RAS official, then it is to be forwarded on to the RAS CEO who will deal with it appropriately.

Rights of the committee – The committee reserves the right to refuse or cancel an entry without giving reason for doing so and reserves the right to make any alteration to the show timetable or withdraw any event as may be deemed desirable. If there are insufficient entries in a class at close of entries, classes maybe combined. **Any cancellations will be notified to the competitors Evo Events email address by Tuesday 9th December.**

Any unruly or dangerous animal or exhibit may be required to leave the showgrounds. Handlers must be capable of managing their exhibits.

Riders/ Handlers/ Horses/ Ponies- age is taken as on the 1st of August 2025. No Horse/ Pony 3 years and under can be ridden.

GR 8. FALL OF RIDER If a rider has a fall or suspected head injury, at any time at a RAS affiliated Show/Event in the: competition ring/arena, practice/warmup/collecting ring/arena; or elsewhere within the grounds of where the show/event is being convened, the rider must be removed from the activity and checked by the show/event's nominated First Aid service/personnel and be given the 'all-clear' before the rider is permitted to re-mount and continue riding at the show/event.

Stallions

All stallions and colts must wear a bit at all times. It is compulsory for all stallions and colts, except foals, to wear two (2) official 'S' identification badges, one attached to each side of their bridle, at all Shows/Events at all times. The rider/handler must also wear two RAS official (2) armbands (one on each arm) when in the ring. 'S' badges to be purchased from RAS Head Office or ESNZ; armbands from RAS Head Office.

Handlers and Riders of stallions/colts must wear an approved Hi Viz vest at Shows/Events when outside the showing ring.

Presentation area

This area has been decorated for the purposes of capturing sponsored presentations and anyone else who wishes to take advantage of it with taking pictures of your horses or ponies with ribbons, rugs or any other prizes. We will not have an assigned photographer in this area but you are welcome to take your own pictures or find a photographer on the grounds to use.

Health and Safety

We will take responsibility for Health and Safety procedures, however all people on this site need to be aware of their responsibilities and comply with the events Health and Safety policy. Competitors will be responsible for themselves at all times by observing safe practices/instructions relating to their competition.

By entering the Wanganui, A&P Show (The Event) all competitors are understood to have agreed with the following statements.

I declare that:

1. My accepted entry into the Event will not be transferred to another entrant.
2. In the event of any 'act of God' conditions causing a cancellation of the Event, I agree that my total entry fee is not transferable or refundable.
3. I am in an appropriate physical condition to participate in the Event, given the known parameters of the Event (such as the length, time, physical demands and environmental context).
4. I have taken medical advice on any pre-existing medical conditions, and confirm that it is medically safe for me to participate in the Event.

I fully realize the dangers of participating in the Event, and fully assume the risks associated with my participation and my wellbeing and safety during and after the Event. I understand and acknowledge that the Event organizers (including all officials and event volunteers) provide no warranties, regarding my wellbeing and safety.
6. I understand and agree that situations may arise during the Event, which may be beyond the immediate control of the Event organizers (including all officials and event volunteers).
7. I will participate in the Event, in a manner that does not endanger either me or others.
8. I agree that to the extent permissible by law, the Event organizers (including all officials and event volunteers), the sponsors and other parties associated with the Event, have no liability to me whatsoever for any direct or indirect loss, (including, but not limited to injury or death) sustained by me during or in any way related to my participation in the Event.
9. I authorize the use of my name, voice, picture and information on this entry form in any broadcast, telecast, promotion, advertising, and in any other way, without payment to me or any other form of compensation.
10. I agree to comply with the rules, and regulations pertaining to the Event.

11. I agree to follow all reasonable safety instructions provided to me by the Event organizers, (including all officials and event volunteers) before, during and after the Event.
12. I consent to receiving medical treatment in the event of illness or injuries suffered during or immediately after the Event.
