Riders

All riders must be a financial member of ESNZ (www.nzequestrian.org.nz) or pay a \$16.30 casual day fee which we collect on your behalf and pay in its entirety to ESNZ as at 9pm **Thursday** before start of competition – if you have any problems please contact us.

Horses

Equines do not need to be registered for Express Eventing.

Designation of discipline:

Run under the ESNZ Eventing Express/Introductory Events – Guidelines January 2023 and the current ESNZ Eventing Rules.

Prizes:

Ribbons 1st – 6th in each class per day.

Sash for overall Topscore Champion & Reserve in each age group presented on the final day.

How the day works:

You will ride your dressage test, a short break and then show jump (on the polofield) and then a short break before cross country – all on one day.

Limited to the first 140 combinations.

General Rules & Conditions – Please read carefully

1. **ESNZ & EVENT RULES:** The event is run under ESNZ Eventing – Express/Introductory Events – Guidelines – effective January 2023. The OC reserves the right to restrict entries, if necessary, alter classes and awards as required – article 611 – Reservation of Right. The Organisers & WECT disclaim any & all liability in the event of accident to rider, horse, spectator, or property. WECT reserves the right to refuse any entry.
2. **ENTRIES:** combinations may only enter 1 height/class.
3. **QUALIFICATIONS:** There are no MER's required or restriction on classes entered. But please be honest and enter the height you would usually jump.
4. **CALLING:** Dressage tests may be called.
5. **WHIPS:** Whips may be carried in dressage.
6. **SPLIT CLASSES:** If entries allow, the classes may be split.
7. **DRAW:** the draw will be emailed via EE.
8. **PRIZEGIVING:** overall rosettes up to 6th place in each class can be collected once the class is finished and 30-minutes has elapsed since the results were posted.
9. **VET AND FARRIER:** There will be no vet or farrier on site during the event. Waikato Equine Veterinary Centre are on call – 07 827 5570.
10. **YARDS:** Day & overnight yards must be booked online at time of entry. Yards are compulsory and must be used at all times there is no tying to truck or floats at any time, they will be allocated to you (day yard – \$12.00 per horse per day, overnight yard \$12.00 per horse). Please ensure you leave your yard tidy, any damage will be charged out, yards with manure in will be charged out at \$20.00 per yard. ID tags must be worn at all times whilst in yards.
11. **OVERNIGHT:** If you'd like to stay overnight on Saturday night, please select an overnight yard when entering. Please note, there will be toilets in the carpark and we have showers on site. Yards only to be used (no paddocks available).
12. **REFUNDS/SCRATCHINGS:** As per Article 646 of the Eventing Rules – Withdrawals and Substitutions. No refund on Admin, EE or Late Fees.
13. **DOGS:** MUST be on a lead at ALL times and REMAIN in the carpark. Failure to comply may result in elimination from the event.
14. **LUNGING:** No lunging on the competition side of the boat ramp road.
15. **COMPETING HORSES:** Competing horses ONLY are allowed at the event – which includes the yards, carpark & surrounding areas. Any non-competing horses brought to site will result in the owner's elimination. This includes minis.
16. **MEDICAL:** If any rider is injured or has a fall as at start of competition (official start time 7.30am) they MUST be checked out by our medic before they can continue.
17. **STALLIONS** – Riders to advise organisers of stallion's entry, requirements & must comply with the ESNZ article 133 of the General Regulations.
18. **HORSE SHARING** - Horse/Pony only to be ridden by 1 rider per day. There is no sharing of ponies/horses allowed.
19. **PHOTOS** – please note that our official photographer and WECT staff take photos for Facebook and advertising purposes. These may be used by WECT without further reference to competitors unless you specially request not to be included in photos of this type.
20. **NO OTHER RIDERS** – Under no circumstances are any riders or spectators, other than the competing riders allowed to sit and/or ride any horse/pony competing.
21. **HORSE IDENTIFICATION** – All horses/ponies are required to have identification on at all times.
22. **BACK NUMBERS** – All riders are required to wear a back number at all times while riding. The number will be pre-printed and must be collected from the office before the horse/pony is mounted and worn at all times. You must bring your own back number holder.

Series rules:

- 4-day accumulating series.
- Points will be awarded to the top 10 combinations in each class as follows
 - 1st = 20
 - 2nd = 18
 - 3rd = 16
 -etc
- Sash for overall topscore champion in each age group as follows:
 - 12 years and under
 - 13 years – 17 years
 - 18 years – 30 years
 - 31 years – 49 years
 - 50 years and above
- Age as at the date of the first series – i.e. 25 May.
- If you change age during the series, your points will stay in the age group you started in.
- You need to be present to receive your sash on the final day.
- Tiebreak – in the case of two combinations finishing on the same score on the final day, the lowest average score across all events entered will be used.
- There will also be a WECT Member topscore for the highest placed WECT financial member and reserve.
