Important Information

- ESNZ Registration for Graded Classes:** Entries will not be accepted without a full ESNZ rider and horse registrations current to the 3rd of Sept 5th Oct & 9th Nov respectively. All classes may be entered using a flexi start. Horses and Ponies must be registered, have an Annual Dressage Start or use flexi starts.
- ESNZ Registration for Non-Graded Classes:** All Riders must be a Full or Introductory ESNZ member current to the 3rd of Sept 5th Oct & 9th Nov respectively or pay a Casual membership of \$16.30 per day. Horses and Ponies may be unregistered or not registered for dressage in the last 12 months.
- Grading Points:** No ESNZ grading points will be awarded for Non-Graded classes or to unregistered horses.
- Rules:** This competition will be run under all current ESNZ rules for dressage.
- Dressage Tests:** All tests are from the **DNZ** Test book version 2023 or FEI Website.
- Volunteers:** In order for our competitions to run smoothly, we need your help! All riders are required to assist us for one hour over the duration of the day, please put your name down on the spreadsheet via the link attached. bit.ly/cdgvolunteer Times can be adjusted when the draw comes out.

Event Conditions

- Amendments:** The organising committee reserves the right to refuse entries, cancel the event, alter the programme/schedule and/or prize money within the ESNZ and DNZ Rules.
- Riders with more than 2 horses:** The OC will make every effort to ensure that riders have at least 60 minutes between rides. However, if this is not possible owing to the scheduling of classes, the maximum time possible between rides will be allocated.
- A maximum** of three tests per day if one horse/pony. If there is more than one horse/pony, a maximum of two tests per day per horse/pony. Maximum of 3 horses per rider.
- All riders must have either an annual ESNZ Introductory membership (New - Replaces Community Membership) or ESNZ Children's Membership (New) or Full ESNZ Membership or pay a casual member fee of \$16.30 per day – paid via Evo Events when you enter. - Hats:** Yellow Tag ESNZ approved riding hats must be always worn when mounted.

6. **Non-Competing Horses:** All horses and ponies on the grounds must be entered at the event unless the organising committee gives permission otherwise. This does not include arena time unless requested, approved and time allocated.
7. **Bullying:** ESNZ prohibits all forms of harassment, bullying and discrimination based on personal characteristics listed in the dictionary – whether this is face to face, indirectly or via communication technologies such as mobile phones and computers
8. **No entry** will be accepted without payment. It is your responsibility to contact us if you are unable to pay via Poli. You will not be reminded if your entry remains paid. This will be strictly adhered to and your account will be debited with non-refundable fees
9. **Liability:**
 - a. Competitors and spectators attending this event do so at their own risk.
 - b. Dunstan Horsefeeds National Equestrian Centre, ESNZ, Dressage NZ or Dressage Canterbury nor any representative of these bodies, accepts any liability for any loss, damage, injury or illness to horse/pony/rider, spectators, land, vehicles, or any personal property whether caused by their negligence or breach of contract in any way whatsoever.
 - c. Dunstan Horsefeeds National Equestrian Centre, ESNZ, Dressage NZ or Dressage Canterbury shall not be liable for the safety of any goods/equipment or the loss of, or damage to such, brought in/stored at the venue, during the event.
10. **Health & Safety:**
 - a) ESNZ, Dressage NZ and Dressage Canterbury is committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy event for all participants, and to providing the information, training and supervision needed to achieve this.
 - b) Competitor or Exhibitor must comply with the appropriate Legislation and Health & Safety at Work Act 2015.
 - c) Each Competitor and/or exhibitor must always supervise and control their animals and shall be liable for any hazard created, accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves at the venue of the Event.
 - d) All competitors and associated staff/visitors to the venue must abide by the ESNZ, Dressage NZ Rules, Dressage Canterbury and the venue's Health & Safety Policy's
 - e) Copies of the event Health & Safety policy can be found at the event office.
 - f) Any incident or near miss must be reported to event office and an incident form completed.
 - g) Any hazards identified must be reported to event office.
 - h) Competitors will be always responsible for their safety and must observe safe practices and always following event rules and officials' instructions, ensuring that others are not put a risk by their actions.
11. **ESNZ Concussion Policy:**
 - a) This event will be run under the ESNZ Concussion Policy Guidelines.
 - b) Dressage NZ policy requires all riders to report to Medical Officer or Steward following a fall.
 - c) Medical clearance must be obtained before remounting or competing.

Entry Conditions

1. Please enter via www.evoevents.co.nz and payment is to be made via Poli upon entering competition. Should Poli not be an option for your bank please email Ken at canterburyentries@gmail.com & paying into Dressage Canterbury Account 02 0820 0359529 00. Please advise the name of the rider in the reference section. If payment is not received within 3 working days of entry the entry will be returned as not valid.
2. **Test of Choice (TOC) classes** – please nominate your test of choice in the “General Special Requests” on Evo Events.
3. Plaiting and riding jackets are optional for non-graded classes.
4. Dressage Canterbury must pay a bond of \$500 to use the grounds and this is only returned if the yards/stables grounds and facilities are left clean and tidy, please put all manure in muck heaps by the stables.

5. Dogs must be always kept in the truck/car park area and must be on a lead. Dogs are not allowed in the warmup, competition areas or buildings. The owner of the dog will be responsible for the cost of any damage/harm caused by the dog at the competition, and the associated rider will face elimination due to any disregard of these rules.
6. Any person with a dog causing disruption or concern may be asked to leave the grounds at the discretion of the OC.
7. When not competing, it is compulsory that horses / ponies are identified with ID tags that include, person responsible name and mobile phone contact number.
8. Payment of prize money will be paid by direct credit, and riders must ensure their correct bank account details are loaded into Evoevents. Prize money is only paid on scores of 57% and above and at a ratio 1:2.
9. Champion & Reserve Champion series ribbons will be awarded across all graded and non-graded sections, with Champion Rugs to be awarded to the graded section winners. To qualify you must attend a minimum of 2 series days. In the event of a tie, the combination with the highest average percentage score will be deemed the winner, calculated to three decimal points.
10. Points For our annual awards as follows, a maximum of two scores per combination per day to count with the top 10 results over the season counting.

Percentage Points

>72%:	10 pts
70-71.99%:	7 pts
67-69.99%:	5 pts
64 – 66.99%:	3 pts
60 – 63.99%:	2 pts
57 – 59.99%:	1 pt

11. To scratch prior to competition day please contact Ken Wilson canterburyentries@gmail.com or txt/ phone Ken 021339843 on the day of the competition. Refund of entries will only be paid out on the receipt of a vet/medical certificate and withdrawal form, less the administration and online entry fee. Refund applications must be made within 7 days of the competition. If you scratch before you have paid, you are still liable to pay the admin and online entry fees.
12. If for any reason, we reach capacity we may need to close prior to the advertised closing date. Should this be necessary we will offer a waitlist class which will be available until the week of the competition.
13. **Important note.** We are offering the WDC tests as practice opportunities on the first two days. These tests are judges under ESNZ rules and using the FEI guidelines applicable to the WDC regarding saddlery, whips, spurs, gloves, and test execution with the reminder that all trot is to be ridden sitting unless specified in the test for specific movements.
