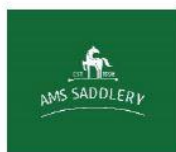

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SHOW CONDITIONS

Are you new to ESNZ Show Jumping or Show Hunter this season?

Show Jumping Canterbury (SJC) warmly welcomes you.

If this is your first season or you would like some extra help, please enter class 75 (no charge) and we will get our wonderful new mentor, Amy Williams for Show Jumping or a lovely Show Hunter expert, to get in touch with you prior to the show to answer any questions you might have.

They will also be at our shows to help point you in the right direction and make sure your day is as stress free as possible.

- Run under ESNZ rules and Show Jumping New Zealand Rules, for Series conditions Refer to Annex 11 (SJ Rule Book).
- All entries must be made on the official online entry program of Evo Events.
- It is the rider and entrants' responsibility to ensure all rider memberships and equine registrations with ESNZ are current and must do so before the show begins.
- Prizes & Conditions for all South Island Series will be on the South Island Show Jumping Facebook Page.
- Competitors and spectators attending this competition do so at their own risk. Show Jumping Canterbury and the organisers disclaim all liability in the event of accident/injury/damage to riders, horses, spectators, or property.
- All injuries and accidents anywhere on the grounds must be reported to the office.
- Dress code: Formal required in R1 & R2, Minimum in R3&R4 as per ESNZ Jumping Rules. SHH and SHP should always be in formal wear.
- The Committee reserves the right to alter, amend or delete any class.
- Please refer to the "Registration guide" on the ESNZ website for more information
- Hacks / Ponies may start in only ONE Championship class or Mini Prix or Grand Prix.
- DOGS ON LEASHES AT ALL TIMES
- The Show Jumping Canterbury Committee reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry
- Coffee cart & food will be available on the grounds.
- By entering or attending you accept that you may appear within differing media streams that SJ Canterbury approves in attendance to cover the event. Your behaviour at the event and within the competition arena is at your discretion and is your responsibility. Please note that there might be live streaming at the event therefore the camera is on throughout the day
- It is the rider's responsibility to clean up all hay and manure from their yards/covered yards/stables as well as from around their float/truck, which is to be placed in designated areas NOT around trees. Any holes dug by horses MUST also be filled in.
- No electric fencing or taping is allowed, and please do not tie or fence your equines up to graze unattended.
- Riders must wear tagged helmets and must always be done up whether competing or training at any time on the grounds. Article 151 will be enforced. As per ESNZ Rules
- Concussions: Any rider that falls or has a knock to the head, must be checked by the attending medical officer before remounting. Any rider deemed to be concussed will not be allowed to ride for the rest of the show or for at least 21 days post show. The ESNZ fall protocols must be followed.
- Official Photographers assigned to the event by SJ Canterbury organising committee are the only media to be sold or advertised.
- BACK NUMBERS are intended on being used at this show.
- All equines while not being ridden, MUST have their name, name of person responsible and their telephone number clearly visible on their head collar and/or rug Article 200 7.1 as per ESNZ Rules.

HELPERS JOB INFORMATION – all Canterbury Area Riders

• **JOB SELECTION: All Canterbury Area Riders MUST select a job when entering online.**

- **JOBS REQUIRED ARE 1 JOB PER RIDER AGED 18 OR OVER**, for those under 18 riders, 1 job per family is suffice.
- Once your job is confirmed, it is then up to the rider to find a replacement if they scratch after entry closing date.
- If a job is not selected your entries will be DECLINED. There will be a sign in and out procedure for all jobs. \$150.00 will be added to your entries for those who do not complete their job in full as an administrative replacement cost.
- Gate Keepers Helpers Job – Please NOTE that this involves strict control of who enters the ring and now includes using the radio to communicate with the judges regarding every competitor. Therefore, we respectfully request that only adults take on this job



McMillian Masters SJ Series – Rug plus McMillan Equine Feeds to the value of \$700 to winner

- Run over the three Canterbury Shows
- Open to riders 40 years and over. Age as at 1 August 2025
- Riders to nominate the horse they want points on prior to the show commencing (can be a different horse each show)
- 3 best SJ results at any level count at each show (maximum of 9 results count)
- Points only awarded for clear rounds even if you placed with faults.
- Points awarded as follows:

1 st	10
2 nd	9
3 rd	8
4 th	7
5 th down to 20 th	5

Show Hunter classes run under ESNZ Show Hunter Rules 2025 & SHNZ Equitation Series Conditions 2025

- Show Hunter classes run under ESNZ Show Hunter Rules 2024 & SHNZ Equitation Series Conditions 2024
 - All horses/ponies may start in any class under the Casual Start system with the exception of ESNZ Series Classes where horses/ponies must hold an annual jumping start registration
 - Ponies will not be restricted to their respective categories, but they MUST compete in the correct height category for HOYQ and ESNZ Series
 - Prize Money and HOYQ points will be awarded to place getters being awarded 66% or greater in the Open Classes.
 - The following Canterbury Series will be run over the three Canterbury Shows – Labour Weekend, Xmas Cracker and Canterbury Champs.
- Horse Rising Star Series** – Sponsored by EPIC Recruitment Ltd
- Rising Star Horses/Ponies are defined as Horses/Ponies that have not qualified for HoY in the previous 4 seasons. A list of horses/ponies

qualified for HOY will be posted with schedule.

- Three classes qualify per show – under saddle and two jumping classes
- A substitute rider may ride in the under saddle class if you have more than one horse in the series

▪ **There will be a points prize for the horse with the most points from the two Ashburton shows and the three Canterbury shows in the Open Masters 90cm classes. Sponsored by McMillans and called the McMillans Masters Show Hunter Combined Series. Winner to receive 5 x McMillan feed vouchers.**

CLASS CHANGES AND SCRATCHING CONDITIONS

- Scratchings prior to close of entries or when riders have been issued with an ESNZ Blue Card – Full Refund, excluding admin fee
- Scratchings after close of entries will receive 80% refund of class fees with proof of inability to compete – excluding admin fee, ground and yarding as appropriate
- Scratchings without the above or if you are a late entry do not receive refunds of any kind • All proof of inability to compete (vet or doctors certificate) are to be received by the event secretary in writing within 48 hours of the show
- Changing class 80% refund of original class and normal entry fee on new class
- Changes to classes must be made 30 minutes before the start of the class, except for the first class of the day which needs to be in by 5pm the day before
- Late entries must start first in all draw order competitions.
- **Class changes are only able to be done via the following options;**
 1. **Complete and sign a form in the office**
 2. **Complete online on Evo Events (we encourage you to use this)**

PLEASE DO NOT email, text or message any class changes. These WILL NOT be actioned!

- Late entries: Plus 50%. This includes all late payments. 50% of unpaid entries as at closing date will be added to your entry

STABLING

- Stabling will be allocated on a first entered and paid first served basis, apart from NEC leases and owners which take priority. Lessees and owners MUST enter by closing date to get use of their yards!
- Please indicate in the stabling notes any requests which will be duly considered but not guaranteed
- Stallion boxes are for STALLIONS ONLY
- Yard allocations will be done once entries close.
- **If a stable/covered yard is not sufficiently cleaned out, you will not be able to use one at our next show and you will receive a \$25 fine.**

SHOW FEE INFORMATION

Please ensure that you add all your extra day/nights in for camping and for yarding and these will be checked by committee before and after the show for those staying.

- All entry fees and prize money are inclusive of GST.

PLEASE MAKE FULL PAYMENT VIA POLIPAY WHEN ENTERING ON EVO EVENTS*

- *If your bank does not support PoliPay please make payment to our bank account immediately 03 0674 0092896 000 with your name as reference. Your entry will still come through to the event secretary without PoliPay

If payment is not made at the time of entry, your yard requests and job choices are NOT allocated until payment is made.

- Once you hit submit on Evo Events, you are required to pay all fees and entries as selected. Please only do this once as your entry will still come through.
- Payment must be received in Show Jumping Canterbury's account by closing date to avoid late fees.
- Any Customer owing fees as of Wednesday 21 October 2025 will be removed from the program and will not be able to enter the ring. Reinstatement will be only via the Secretary and strictly enforced.
- Please ensure your correct bank account name and number for direct credit of prize money and refunds are loaded into Evo Events.
- The Administration fee is non-refundable.
- Prize money will be paid out as per the schedule and then on a ratio of 1:7.
- For SJ Series Classes this show will pay prize money to 6th place regardless of the number of penalties in the first round
- Any Customer owing fees 5 days prior to the show will be removed from the program and will not be able to enter the ring. Reinstatement will be only via the Secretary and strictly enforced.
- **Any balances owing at the completion of the show must be paid within 5 days of the show. If any balances are outstanding this will be added to your account and will need to be paid before entering our next show.**
- Covid or natural disaster clause: If a show is cancelled due to either Covid 19 or any natural disaster or similar SJ Canterbury reserve the right to withhold 10% of all entry fees received to cover costs already incurred for the show.

Horses are restricted to 1.10m and Under. Ponies are restricted to 1.00m and Under.

Horses/Ponies not eligible to start in Series Classes.

JUMPING RULE UPDATE – USE OF WHIP IN COMPETITION AND PRACTICE ARENAS

Horse welfare remains at the heart of jumping, and we must all do our best to protect our social license to operate (SLO).

There is an important change to the Jumping Rules effective 1 August 2025, which affects all riders.

Art. 243 Abuse of Horses Effective 1 August the rule is:

2.2(iii) The whip should never be used more than three times in total, in the competition arena or in the practice arena.

What does this mean and what will happen if a rider uses the whip more than three times in the competition or practice arena?

In the competition arena:

Ponies 1 August – 31 December 2025

Elimination if rider uses whip more than 3 times. Rider may complete the course.

Ponies from 1 January 2026

Elimination if whip used more than 3 times. Rider must leave the arena immediately.

Horses from 1 August 2025

Elimination if whip used more than 3 times. Rider must leave the arena immediately.

In the practice arena:

Ponies and Horses from 1 August 2025

If the whip is used more than 3 times, the rider will be issued with a verbal caution.
