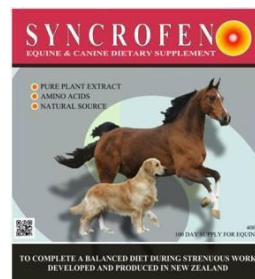

Responsibility: It is the rider's or person's responsibility to read and understand the conditions for this event as published in this schedule.

Important Information

1. **ESNZ Registration for Graded Classes:** Entries will not be accepted with registration as follows to the 27th of October 2025
 - **Preliminary:** Riders must have an ESNZ Introductory, Child or Full Competitive membership.
 - **Novice and Above:** Riders must have an ESNZ Child or Full Competitive membership.
 - **Horse and Ponies:** Must have ESNZ Horse/pony registration. May compete on an Annual Dressage Start (purchased on Horse Reg) or use Flexi Start at \$5 per Test (payable with entries).
2. **ESNZ Registration for Non-Graded Classes:** All Riders must be a Full or Introductory ESNZ member current to the 27th of October 2025 or pay a Casual membership fee of \$16.30 per event. Horses and Ponies may be registered or non-registered.
4. **Bronze:** Riders in Preliminary Bronze level and Novice Bronze, please refer to Annex 8, page 96 in the DNZ rule book.
5. **Non-Graded:** Are to allow anyone to compete on any horse to 'Give Dressage a Go', regardless of any previous history of either the horse or rider. This may include an experienced rider on a young horse that may or may not be ESNZ registered or hold no Dressage discipline starts.
6. **Introductory Classes:** For non-registered horses/ponies or horses that hold no dressage discipline starts. These classes are designed to be an introduction to dressage for all ages. If sufficient entries, horses and ponies will be judged separately.
7. **Rules:** Dressage Marlborough Premier League competitions will be run under the current ESNZ GRs, VRs & ESNZ Rules for Dressage.
8. **Official start time:** The official event start time is 12.00 pm Saturday, 25th October 2025. This is the start time for the period of jurisdiction for all Equestrian Sport New Zealand (ESNZ) General Regulations and ESNZ Dressage rules. Please note that Dressage NZ Articles 420-430 prohibit the use of gear from the time of arrival at the event.
9. **Official finish time:** The official finish time will be 60 minutes after the completion of the last class or 60 minutes after the completion of all presentations for the event, whichever is later.
10. **Protests & Complaints:** Protests and complaints may be considered by the Ground Jury at an event in accordance with Art 137 of the ESNZ General Regulations. As a guideline only, protests must be lodged within 60 minutes of the completion of the competition to which the protest relates, and a complaint within 60 minutes of the completion of the event. The Ground Jury is the sole judge of time in both cases. For complete rules and official documentation required, please refer to <https://www.nzequestrian.org.nz/esnz/rules-regulations/>
11. **Qualifiers:** Premier League Shows are qualifiers for Horse of the Year and Bates National Dressage Championships.
12. **Dressage NZ Leagues/Series:** Horses/Ponies must have an annual start for Dressage to gain points in any Super 5 League, Zilco Musical Freestyle Series, Prestige Futures Prize, AMS Pony, Young Rider and U25 Performance League, or Top 10 Leagues. Riders must register online at Evo Events before 1st December 2025 for inclusion in any Top 10 League, Prestige Dressage Futures Prize, AMS Pony, Young Rider and U25 Performance League.
13. **Tests:** All tests from the DNZ Test book version 2023 or the FEI Website, <https://inside.fei.org/fei/yourrole/organisers/dressage/tests>
14. **Super 5 Tests:** Must be ridden from memory; no caller is permitted.
15. **FEI Tests:** Must be ridden from memory; no caller is permitted.
16. **Grading Points:** No ESNZ grading points will be awarded for non-graded classes or to unregistered horses. Horses must gain over 57% to be eligible for ESNZ grading points.

Event Conditions

1. **Amendments:** The organising committee reserves the right to refuse entries, cancel the event, alter the programme/schedule and/or prize money within the ESNZ and DNZ Rules.
2. **Presentation of Special Awards Prizes and Prize Money:** See DNZ Rule article 456.
 - a. All riders must attend advertised presentations. The organising committee reserves the right to withhold prize monies should a placegetter not attend an advertised prize giving.
 - b. The organising committee reserves the right to substitute prize money with goods of equal value.
 - c. Prize money will be paid by electronic transfer within 2 weeks of the completion of the event.
 - d. Prize Givings: Unmounted - Champions & Reserves. Unmounted - Super 5 League and Zilco Musical Freestyles.
 - e. Prize money will only be paid out on scores of 57% and above in levels 1-5 and more than 55% in Levels 6-9.
 - f. If 6 or less riders in a class, prize money will be paid out as a 1:3 whilst adhering to article Art 481 of Dressage NZ Rules
 - g. Sunday Prizegiving: The Winery Riders function will take place on Sunday afternoon; this is a must for all riders to attend to thank the sponsors. Food and beverages will be available, and presentations of Sunday's classes and the Area Teams competition will take place. Approximately 5pm. Please check the programme for details.
 - h. Monday Prizegiving: Will take place after all classes have finished and arenas have been packed away.
3. **Draw:** If required, a revised draw and/or start times for the following day's competition will be available on Evo Events It is the rider's responsibility to check any new times posted.
4. All outstanding amounts from any previous Dressage NZ Event must be paid before entries will be confirmed.
5. **Scratchings** Must be notified to the Event Secretary, night before show (before 9pm) via Evo Events
6. **Equal Placings:** In the case of equality in any qualifying class, the higher collective marks will determine the higher placing. If the competitors are still equal, then the higher co-efficient marks will determine the placings. If there is still an equality of points, the competitors are given the same placing.
7. **Riders with more than 2 horses:** Entries are limited to 4 horses, with a maximum of 6 tests per day per rider. The OC will make every effort to ensure that riders have at least 60 minutes between rides. However, if this is not possible owing to the scheduling of classes, maximum time possible between rides will be allocated.
8. **Hats:** ESNZ approved tagged riding helmets must be worn at all times when mounted.
9. **Non-Competing Horses:** All horses and ponies on the grounds after the official start time must be entered at the event unless the organising committee grants permission otherwise.
10. **Media:** Dressage Marlborough, Dressage NZ and ESNZ reserve the right to use event photographs, for marketing, publicity, advertising, funding applications as they see fit. Competitors and/or participants will receive no remuneration for this. All images remain the property of Dressage Marlborough.
11. **Musical Freestyles:** USB sticks must be handed into the office at least 2 hours prior to class starting, this will enable testing of music to be done.
12. **Stallions** must comply with ESNZ Article 133 and must be housed in a stable at all times.
13. **Liability:**
 - a) Competitors and spectators attending this event do so at their own risk.
 - b) Dressage Marlborough, ESNZ, Dressage NZ or Marlborough Equestrian Park any representative of these bodies, accepts any liability for any loss, damage, injury or illness to horse/pony/rider, spectators, land, vehicles or any personal property whether caused by their negligence or breach of contract in any way whatsoever.
 - c) Marlborough Equestrian Park, Dressage NZ or Dressage Marlborough will not be liable for the security of goods/equipment or the loss of, damage to such, stored at the venue, during the event.
14. **Health & Safety:**
 - a) Dressage NZ and Dressage Marlborough are committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy event for all participants, and to providing the information, training and supervision needed to achieve this.

- b) Competitors must comply with appropriate Legislation and Health & Safety at Work Act 2015.
- c) Each Competitor and/or exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazard created, accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves at the venue of the Event.
- d) All competitors and associated staff/visitors to the venue must abide by the ESNZ/Dressage NZ Rules, the Dressage Marlborough and Marlborough Equestrian Park Health & Safety Policy's
- e) Copies of the event Health & Safety policy can be found at the event office.
- f) Any incident or near miss must be reported to event office and an incident form completed.
- g) Any hazards identified must be reported to event office.
- h) Competitors will be responsible for their safety at all times and must observe safe practices and following event rules and officials' instructions at all times, ensuring that others are not put a risk by their actions.

15. ESNZ Concussion Policy:

- a) This event will be run under the ESNZ Concussion Policy Guidelines.
- b) Dressage NZ policy requires all riders to report to Medical Officer or Steward following a fall.
- c) Medical clearance must be obtained before remounting or competing or leaving the grounds.

16. ESNZ Drug & Alcohol Policy

ESNZ reserve the right to drug or alcohol test any participant at the event under the ESNZ Drug & Alcohol Policy 2020. This link will access the policy and frequently asked question.

- 1. Entries Close Thursday 9th October 2025.
- 2. The entry will not be accepted until payment is made. Combinations will only be entered in the competition draw once full payment of entry and other fees has been received.
- 3. Enter online at www.evoevents.co.nz . Emailed or phone entries will not be accepted.
- 4. Late Entries & Changes - please contact Event Secretary Sharon Inwood marlboroughdressage@xtra.co.nz.
- 5. No class changes or scratchings will be accepted via Facebook or text and must be done online at Evo Events.
- 6. A late penalty fee of \$20.00 per class will apply and proof of payment before entry accepted.
- 7. Direct credit must be made by close of the entry deadline for entry to be accepted. Please calculate correctly.
- 8. Preference is POLi payment or direct deposit via internet banking to Dressage Marlborough bank account.

Withdrawals and Refunds

Applications for refund must be submitted on Dressage Marlborough withdrawal/refund form with accompanying documentations vet/doctor/farrier certificate. Final date for refund applications – Friday 1st November 2025.

Conditions of withdrawal from the event before close of entries.

- Competitors that withdraw prior to close of entries are still liable for nonrefundable fees.
- All other fees paid will be refunded.

Conditions of withdrawal from the event after close of entries.

- Stabling and camping fees will be 100% refunded in all cases.
- Online entry fee and late entry fees will not be refunded.
- Competitors unable to provide a vet or doctors certificate will receive no ground fee or entry fees refund.
- If a doctor or vet certificate is provided ground fee and entry fees will be refunded less 20% per horse.
- If vet certificate provided, only the horse to which the certificate applies will receive a refund.
- If doctors certificate provided fees for all horses for that rider will be refunded.
- Special applications for refunds can be presented to the OC for consideration.

Championship Eligibility Points Levels Preliminary – Grand Prix

1. Combinations are eligible for one level of Championship only.
2. Championship points are allocated 20 for 1st, to 1 for 20th.
3. Champions and Reserves: The horse with the highest aggregate allocated points from specified classes will be the Championship winner. In the event of a tie, the combination with the highest place in the final qualifier is the winner. If there is still a tie, the combination with the highest aggregate collective marks in the final qualifier will be the winner. If there is a further tie, the combination with the highest average % in two qualifiers will be the winner.
4. All classes for eligible for championships points are *



Awards

Age Group Championship Eligibility

1. Combinations are eligible for one level of Championship only.
2. **Champion Junior Rider:** For riders on a horse from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach 12 until they reach the age of 16. Riders who turn 16 on or after 1st August may continue competing as a Junior until the 31st of July in the following calendar year.. Includes non graded.
3. **Gayendo Trophy Young Rider:** For Riders on a Horse or Pony from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 16 years until they reach the age of 21. Riders who turn 21 on or after 1st August may compete as a Young Rider until the 31st of July in the following calendar year. Awarded to the highest percentage in Super 5 class.
4. **Champion Pony Rider 12 years and Under:** For riders on a Pony until they reach the age of 13 years. Riders who turn 13 on or after 1 August may compete until 31 July in the following calendar year, plea Includes non-graded.
5. Champion sashes only will be awarded.
6. **Masters Championship:** Open to riders on horse or pony. Riders must be aged 50 years or over as of 1st August 2025

Special Awards

1. **Faircloth Memorial Trophy** for the most points gained by a Marlborough Rider: For horse and rider combination gaining the most points at any level.
2. **Schindler Area Teams Trophy**: Please state your area team at marlboroughdressage@xtra.co.nz, please nominate rider and horse, and which team they are in. Eligible classes are Sunday AM classes and 1 class for levels 6 and above. Maximum of 4 riders in a team. Includes non graded. Team members must be from same area. Combinations can be in only 1 team and each team member must be a different rider.
3. **Champion overall pony**: Vause Trophy to be awarded to the champion overall pony with most points.
4. **Taiko Trophy**: Overall points from Bronze Classes – Adult only.
5. **Innishmore Fionne Trophy**. Champion Young dressage horse. The highest placed young horse is C classes. 4yo Level 1, 5yo Level 2, and 6yo Level 3.
6. **Bitteschon Trophy** for the highest % Musical Freestyle overall grades.
7. **TL MacLean South Island Points Prize Accumulator**. Points are allocated as follows: 7, 5, 3 and 1 for first to fourth placing. Only the two best placings per day are taken when riding more than two tests and points are only counted if the score is above 55% placing.

Competition Arena Use & Familiarization

1. All Competition Arenas are closed at all times except as stated below.
2. These times may be amended please check times in rider notes provided with the draw.
3. Arena familiarization is not intended to be used as a full schooling session.
4. Riders need to be considerate of other riders wishing to familiarize their horses.
5. Lunging is not permitted on the all-weather arenas; lunging area is the east section of MEP.
6. Horses may be hand walked or ridden at walking pace around the exterior of the competition arena unless advised otherwise by the Technical Delegate. Any person leading a horse in an arena familiarization, must be wearing a correctly fitting yellow tagged helmet. All horses being lead must be wearing a bridle with permitted bit, and with two bridle numbers or back number if non graded. A Newmarket lead may replace the reins for this purpose.
7. Familiarization Times: To be advised.

Horse Identification, Venue, Yarding, Accommodation Conditions

1. Approved DNZ Horse/Pony identification numbers must be worn at all times on both sides of the horse or pony when competing unless back numbers are provided by the OC for non-registered horses and ponies.
2. When not competing, it is compulsory that horses/ponies are identified with ID tags that include the person responsible's name and mobile phone number.
3. All yards and stables are to be left properly mucked out. If not a fee of \$50 will be charged.
4. Temporary yarding must comply with ESNZ rules.
5. Stallions must comply with ESNZ Article 133 and must be housed in a stable at all times.
6. Please keep wash down bays clean at all times.
7. Moving horses to unallocated yards or stables is prohibited without the permission of the Stable Manager.
8. Please keep the MEP gate shut at all times.
9. No smoking at Marlborough Equestrian Park.
10. Damage to Marlborough Equestrian Park facilities to be reported to the Marlborough Dressage Event Office.

Dogs

1. Dogs must be always kept in the truck park.
2. No dogs are allowed in any stable or yarding areas, warm-up, competition areas, or buildings.
3. Dogs must be always on a lead at all times.
4. The owner of the dog will be responsible for the cost of any damage/harm caused by the dog at the competition.

Camping & Power Sites

1. Parking and camping areas may be defined. Some areas will be restricted to on-site camping/parking only.
2. Day competitors must park in designated day parking areas.
3. Trucks and Campervans requesting power must have a valid electrical certificate and under no circumstances will allow other vehicles to connect to their vehicles.

Vehicles & Access

1. The speed limit for all vehicles 15 kph.
2. Joy riding on any part of the grounds at any time will not be tolerated.
3. Bicycle helmets must be worn in accordance with NZ road rules.

Professional Services

1. Equine Therapists and Treatment
 - a. Any equine therapists or practitioners who are not veterinarian and intend to provide therapeutic treatment to equines in any capacity at this event in a private or commercial basis must notify the Organising Committee of any treatment prior to the event.
 - b. All practitioners must also comply with the Conditions applicable to this event set out in the Schedule of classes.
 - c. Riders who own their equipment (eg Equissage, Cyclossage or similar) are only permitted to treat their own horses with these systems at the event.
 - d. Any practitioner receiving financial or other gain from providing therapies at the event will be required to pay a trade exhibitor fee at the discretion of the Organising Committee.
2. Other Professionals including freelance grooms
 - a. Any other professional intending on providing services at this event must obtain prior agreement from the Organising Committee – this excludes professionals, Dressage Coaches assisting in the warmup of competitors, and grooms that are in part-time or full-time employment of a competitor.
