Official Start Time

The official event start time is 12pm Friday 24th October 2025. This is the start time for the period of jurisdiction for all FEI Rules for Dressage Veterinary & General Regulations, Equestrian Sport New Zealand (ESNZ) General Regulations, Veterinary Regulations and ESNZ Dressage rules. All horses and ponies on the grounds after the official start time of the event must be entered at the event or have express permission from the Organizing Committee to be on site and will be subject to ground levy and yards fees.

A reminder FEI/Dressage NZ rules do not allow the use of prohibited gear from time of arrival on the grounds.

Whips / Boots: Whips & Boots are permitted in the ten-minute arena. Whips must be dropped and boots removed prior to leaving the ten-minute arena.

Gear Inspection: Stewards will undertake a gear inspection for every combination as they leave the main arena. This also includes a "blood check".

Please assemble outside the arena at the direction of the stewards:

If you and your horse have not trotted up before – it is not as easy as it looks - some practice is strongly advised.

Riders should wear smart practical dress and shoes/boots suitable for running.

Horses must have ID numbers on both sides of their bridles at the horse inspection.

Riders 25yrs and under must wear safety helmets at the trot up. It is further recommended all riders wear safety helmets.

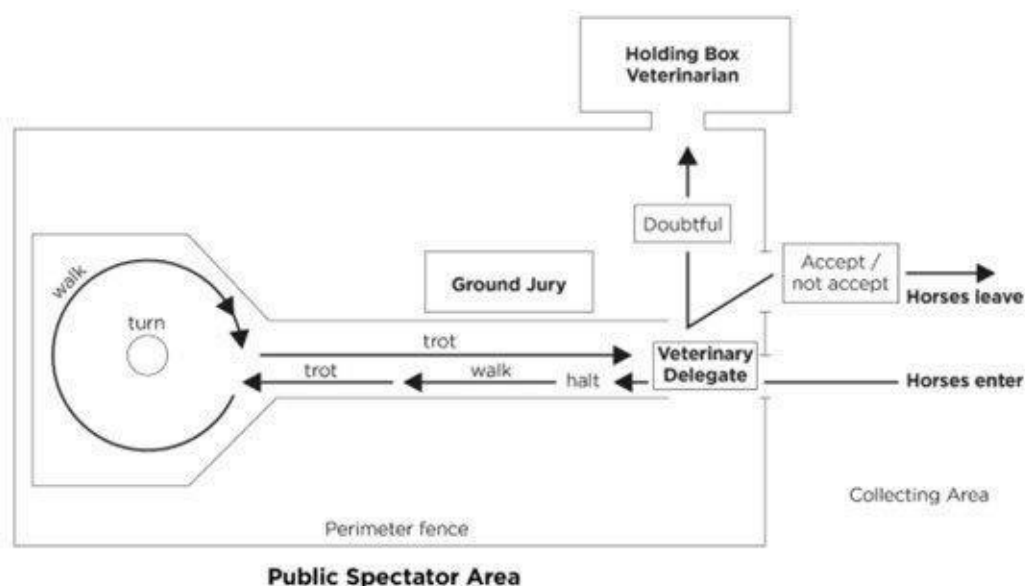


Figure 1: Illustration of the Horse Inspection procedure

All competitors must wear correct riding attire. Refer to Rule 456 - riders must be correctly attired as for the dressage test. For mounted prize giving, dress & saddlery must be the same as (permitted) for the competition, however white or black boots or bandages are allowed.

Riders must be on time, and present in an orderly and professional manner. Any rider late for prize giving may be forfeit any rosettes/prizes

JUDGES REVIEW: 4.30 - 5.45 pm. MARQUEE

All Competitors are welcome at all sessions of the rider review at 4.30 - 5.45 pm, but attendance at their own Test Review level is compulsory. Riders will be required to sign in
