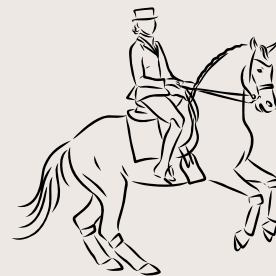

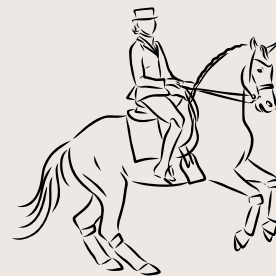

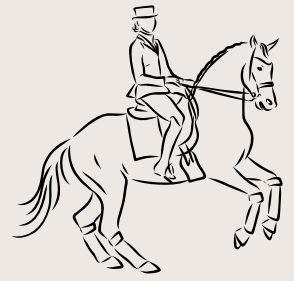

Welcome to the St Peter's Equestrian Local Dressage Competition, brought to you by St Peter's School Cambridge.

Please read the general conditions before you enter. It is the rider's, or person responsible's, obligation to read and understand the conditions for this event as published in this schedule. All enquiries are to be sent to the Event Secretary, Leanne Smith.

Important Information

1. ESNZ Horse Registration and Rider Membership for Graded Classes: Entries will not be accepted without ESNZ rider and horse registration current to 24 hours past the event you are entering.
2. Annual Dressage Start: All graded classes can be entered using an annual dressage start or a discipline Flexi start.
3. ESNZ Registration for Non-Graded Classes: All Riders must be a Full/Introductory/Youth member or pay an ESNZ Casual Day membership fee. Horses may be registered or non-registered.

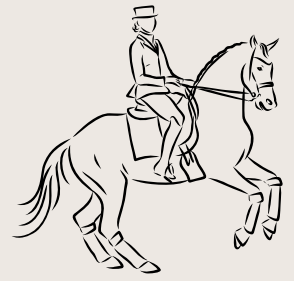
Rules of the Event

St Peter's School Cambridge will run under the current (2025) ESNZ GR's, VR's and ESNZ rules for Dressage.

1. Official start time: The official start time is 3.00pm before competition day. This is the start time for the period of jurisdiction for all Equestrian Sport New Zealand (ESNZ) General Regulations and ESNZ Dressage rules. Please note DNZ Articles 420-430, prohibited gear is not allowed from the time of arrival at the event.
2. Official finish time: The official finish time will be 60 minutes after the completion of the last class, or 60 minutes after the completion, of all presentations for the event, whichever is later.
3. Protests and Complaints: Must be lodged within the official finish time in writing including a fee of \$50.
4. Tests: All tests from DNZ Test Book version 2023 or ESNZ Dressage Website.

Entry Conditions

1. Entries close at 11.59pm on Monday 14th September.
2. Entry will not be accepted until payment is made. Combinations will only be entered into the competition draw once full payment of entry and other fees has been received.
3. Enter online at www.evoevents.co.nz.
4. Late entries will be accepted for a \$25 late fee. For changes, please contact the Event Secretary.
5. No class changes or scratchings will be accepted via Facebook or text.
6. Direct credit payments must be made by close of entry for entry to be accepted.

8. Draw will be available at www.evoevents.co.nz
9. Adults may ride ponies but must enter the horse class at the level they wish to compete.

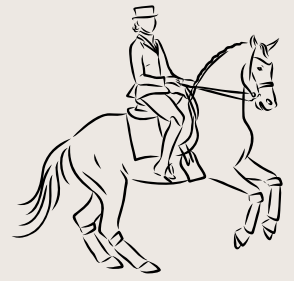


Sponsors and Volunteers

We ask that all competitors spend some time to thank our sponsors and volunteers that support Dressage in NZ, either in writing (Sponsor contact details will be listed in the event programme) or in person during the show. Event Conditions

1. **Amendments:** The organisers reserve the right to refuse entries, cancel the event, alter the programme/schedule and/or prize money within the ESNZ and DNZ rules.
2. **Prizes:** Prizes can be collected at the conclusion of each class.
3. **Scratchings:** Must be notified by email to the Event Secretary with the scratching form.
4. **Riders with more than 2 horses:** The organisers will make every effort to ensure that riders have at least 60 minutes between rides. However, if this is not possible owing to the scheduling of classes, maximum time possible between rides will be allocated.
5. **Hats:** ESNZ approved riding helmets must be worn at all times when mounted.
6. **Media:** St Peter's School Cambridge, Dressage NZ and ESNZ reserve the right to use event photographs, for marketing, publicity, advertising, funding applications as they see fit. Competitors and/or participants will receive no remuneration for this.
7. **Stallions** must comply with ESNZ Article 133 and must be housed in the stable yards at all times.
8. **Liability:** a) Competitors and spectators attending this event do so at their own risk. b) St Peter's School Cambridge, ESNZ, or Dressage NZ nor any representative of these bodies, accepts any liability for any loss, damage, injury or illness to horse/pony/rider, spectators, land, vehicles or any personal property whether caused by their negligence or breach of contract in any way whatsoever. c) St Peter's School Cambridge, ESNZ, or Dressage NZ will not be liable for the security of goods/equipment or the loss of, damage to such, stored at the venue, during the event.
9. **Health and Safety:** a) Dressage NZ and St Peter's School Cambridge are committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy event for all participants, and to providing the information, training and supervision needed to achieve this. b) Competitors must comply with appropriate legislation and Health and Safety at Work Act 2015. c) Each competitor and/or exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazard created, accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves at the venue of the Event. d) All competitors and associated staff/visitors to the venue must abide by the ESNZ/Dressage NZ Rules, the St Peter's Equestrian and St Peter's School Cambridge Health & Safety Policies. e) Copies of the event Health & Safety policy can be found at the event office. f) Any incident or near miss must be reported to event office and an incident form completed. g) Any hazards identified must be reported to event office. h) Competitors will be responsible for their safety at all times and must observe safe practices and following event rules and officials' instructions at all times, ensuring that others are not put at risk by their actions.



Event Conditions cont.

10. ESNZ Concussion Policy:

- a) This event will be run under the ESNZ Concussion Policy Guidelines.
- b) Dressage NZ policy requires all riders to report to Medical Officer or Steward following a fall.
- c) Medical clearance must be obtained before remounting or competing.

11. ESNZ Drug & Alcohol Policy: ESNZ reserve the right to drug or alcohol test any participant at the event under the ESNZ Drug & Alcohol Policy 2020. This link will access the policy and frequently asked question.

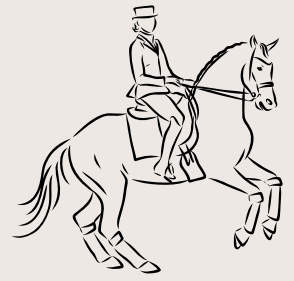
Prize Money: Each graded class will be allocated prize money as per the event schedule. This is generously sponsored by Property Brookers Cambridge.

Competition Arena Use and Warm Up Areas

1. All competition arenas are closed at all times outside of competition hours.
2. During the competition, please do not have any horses being led or grazed around the arenas.
3. Please do not enter the warm up on foot.
4. Young children are to be supervised at all times. Do not allow children to play in the arenas at any time.
5. The areas between the warm up arena and the competition arena is a quiet place for riders to move from one arena to another. Please be mindful of the judges needing to concentrate, and keep noise to a minimum.
6. Warm up areas are open from 3pm to 5pm on Saturday, these areas are the the right hand side of the treatlite top arena and the full bottom sand arena. Pelase be mindful and share arena use..

Horse Identification, Venue, Yarding, Accommodation and Conditions

1. Approved Dressage NZ Horse/Pony identification numbers must be worn at all times when competing.
2. When not competing, it is compulsory that horses/ponies are identified with ID tags that include person responsible name and phone number.
3. All yards are to be left properly mucked out. If not a fee of \$50 will be charged.
4. Please keep wash down bays clean at all times.
5. Moving horses to unallocated yards or stables is prohibited without permission of the Event Secretary.
6. Please use bins provided for horse waste, not rubbish.
7. No smoking and vaping on the school grounds.
8. Damage to St Peter's Equestrian Centre facilities is to be reported to the event office.
9. Yards mut be booked and paid for at time of entries. Limited numbers are available.

St Peter's Equestrian Code of Conduct

The Code of Conduct is for all competitors and their supporters, family, grooms, owners etc.

1. To ensure at all times the safety of your horse.
2. To ensure your horse is fed and watered and covered in an appropriate manner for the duration of the event.
3. Anyone seen abusing their horse will be asked to leave the ground. St Peter's Equestrian officials will use the notification of the official warning system enforced by Equestrian Sport NZ.

Code of Conduct for all Competitors

1. To at all times show respect and be courteous to all organisers and to other competitors and spectators.
2. We are a public group insofar that public can and do attend our competitions. You are expected to not bring the St Peter's School and Equestrian Centre into disrepute, by outwards display of verbal outcries/abuse, disrespect to competitors, judges, officials or spectators.
3. The use of social media is an area where we expect the same rules apply as above. Please see ESNZ Guidelines for more information on social media use.

Riders have a responsibility to horses and humans to act in accordance with the above guidelines. The six main notifications which can denote an official warning are:

Abuse of Horse or Safety to Others, Incorrect Behaviour, Abuse/Disregard of Officials, Dangerous Riding, Noncompliance of Rules - All ESNZ and DNZ rules apply at all times.

Withdrawals and Refunds

Please use the official withdrawal form attached to the schedule and send to Leanne Smith.

Conditions of Withdrawal before close of entries:

- Competitors that withdraw prior to close of entries are still liable for withdrawal online entry fees, all other fees will be refunded.

Conditions of Withdrawal after close of entries:

- Yarding fees will be 100% refunded in all cases, online EvoEvents fee will not be refunded.
- Competitors unable to provide a vet or doctors certificate will receive no ground fee or entry fee refund.
- If a doctor or vet certificate is provided, ground fee and entry fees will be refunded less 20% per horse. If doctors certificate provided fees for all horses for that rider will be refunded. If vet certificate provided, only the horse to which the certificate applies will receive a refund.
- Special applications for refunds can be presented to the OC for consideration.



St Peter's Dressage Official Withdrawal Form

Please use this form when applying for refund of entries. No refunds will be considered unless this form is sent in.

To be eligible for a full refund (excluding online entry fee), notification of withdrawal must be received before close of entries.

Any withdrawals after this time must be accompanied by a Vet, Doctor or Farrier certificate, or at the organiser's discretion. All late scratching will be refunded due less 20% (excluding online entry fee).

Any refund requests must be send to the Event Secretary (leannes@stpeters.school.nz).

Please note that all funds need to be approved by the organisers first, so the refund will not be immediate.
