Gear Check: Team managers are responsible for rider's gear checks.
Volunteers on the day: Each team will be required to supply a helper along with a plate for the Judges.

Un-mounted prize giving for Stringer Trophy once results are tallied and all rings and arenas are packed away – all teams to help with this please.

Dressage starts at 8.30am

All team members enter the Dressage arena's on the same bell.

Dressage Test - J8 NZPCA Junior Riding Test 2018

Arena 1 – Class 1	21 years & under - 75cm:	(TAM 2 then Take-your-own-line - Class 5)
Arena 2 – Class 2	16 years & under - 65cm:	(TAM 2 then Take-your-own-line - Class 6)
Arena 3 – Class 3	14 years & under - 65cm:	(TAM 2 then Take-your-own-line - Class 7)
Arena 4 – Class 4	12 years & under - 45cm:	(TAM 2 then Take-your-own-line - Class 8)

Stringer Trophy Show Jumping Round

Based on TAM 2 – will consist of one round where the winner will be the competitor that receives the fastest time with the least number of penalties.

Take-your-own-line – Showjumping Round – results do not form part of Stringer Trophy
RPC ribbons to be given out at the conclusion of the class.

Take-Your-Own-Line Competition Rules:

1. In this competition the obstacles may be jumped only once in the order chosen by the competitor. Any competitor who does not jump all the obstacles is eliminated. Combination obstacles are not allowed.
2. Competitors may cross the starting line or finishing line in either direction. The lines must be provided with four flags: a red and a white flag at each end of these lines. Obstacles may be jumped in either direction, unless otherwise directed on the course plan.
3. If the rider has not completed the course 120 seconds after the round has started, they will be eliminated.
4. All disobediences are penalised by the time lost by the competitor. Third disobedience is elimination. **Faults are under Table C** and are penalised in seconds which are added to the time taken by the competitor to complete the round.
5. **Time of the round** is calculated by adding the clock time and any time corrections for interrupted time (+ 6sec if time stopped for jump being rebuilt).
6. **The total score** (in seconds) is obtained by taking the time of the round and adding 4 seconds for each obstacle knocked down.
7. **Lowest score wins.** In the event of equality for first place, the competitors will be placed equal first - No jump off



General Stringer Trophy Rules:

- Riders ride at their own risk, Rangiora Pony Club accepts no responsibility for any injury, loss or damage, to any person, animal or property.
- The five rally rule applies to all combinations. Dispensations are at the discretion of the organising committee.
- Combinations that have competed in the last Springston Trophy are not eligible to compete at Stringer Trophy.
- Branches may supply/borrow riders to or from another branch to make up a team.
- Age is at the date of competition.
- Riders may ride up but cannot ride down/juniors limited to one height up (juniors cannot ride at 75cm).
- NZPCA approved helmets must be worn in all phases (yellow tagged)
- Gear checks are the responsibility of the team manager. Spot checks will be done during the day. Pony Club Uniform is to be worn for all phases.
- Dressage tests can be called under combined training ESNZ rules
- Under ESNZ Combined training spurs are allowed but no whips.
- Protests to be submitted with \$50.00 in writing within 30 minutes of the incident.
- Riders to provide their own back numbers
- 3 best scores to count, if only 3 in a team all scores count
- Rangiora Pony Club reserves the right to combine, delete and/or alter any classes.
