On Evevents please nominate a height for circuit points as you will be unable to do so on the day.

PLEASE NOTE: Hack 60cm & 70cm and Pony 50cm & 60cm classes are training only and no circuit points will be gained in these classes.

Please also nominate for Masters' Cup (30yrs and over) on entry form.

The rider must be in the possession of an annual or life measurement issued by the RAS showing the pony measures 148cm or under. Once a pony reaches 8 years of age no further annual certificates are required but must still be carried as proof.

MAXIMUM OF 4 CLASSES PER COMBINATION OVER 2 HEIGHTS ONLY.

Refunds: 75% of entry will be refunded when request is made in writing within seven days of the event and accompanied by either a vet or doctors' certificate. No refunds to be given on the day.

Dunstan Show Jumping Circuit Rules 2025/2026

The Show Jumping Mini Circuit will be hosted by Amberley Pony Club, Kaikoura Pony Club & Waiau Pony Club

1. Classes as per schedule
2. Heights will be
 - Ponies; 30cm (no points), 50cm (no points), 60cm (no points) 70cm, 80cm, 90cm & 1.0m.
 - Hacks: 50cm (no points) 60cm (no points), 70cm (no points) 80cm, 90cm, 1.0m & 1.10m
3. If the combination has been placed overall 1st to 10th in the previous season, then they must compete at that height or higher.
4. On the first day of the circuit riders can nominate a height, they can then downgrade at second circuit day, but they must remain at that height or higher for the remainder of the circuit.
5. At the end of five wins, the rider has the option of staying at the original height and not accumulating points or advancing to the next height and continuing for another five wins with points. Then after ten wins they may choose to advance to the next height and continue with points or remain at second height collecting points and take minus 20 points at last circuit day. If the combination is riding at the maximum height the combination continues to get the points even after 5 wins at the maximum height.
6. If there is only one rider in a class the handicap system will take place, whereby the rider's score and time will be compared with the class one height lower to ascertain their placing for points allocation.
7. Each circuit day entered you must state a nominated height.
8. You can ride below or above your nominated height, but no points will be awarded.
9. A rider/mount combination can only ride at 2 heights throughout the day.
10. There is to be ONE horse/pony to ONE rider for every circuit day and height class.
11. There must be a draw for each class.
12. If there is a rider changing class, they must present gate keeper with class change slip (available at secretary's tent)
13. Points to be awarded as follows.
 - 1st = 10 points, 2nd = 8 points, 3rd = 7 points, 4th = 6 points, 5th = 5points, 6th =4 points.
14. In event of a tie, both combinations will score full points.
15. Masters Cup is for riders 30 years and over.

16. You may be asked for a height certificate, RAS/ESNZ card may be asked for any pony at prize giving for each class. If no height certificate is produced, no points, placing or prize money will be awarded.
17. The secretary on the day is to get the collated jump sheets to point secretary, immediately after the event.
18. In the event of a tie for first place for overall placings on the final circuit day - clear rounds in TAM5 class for all circuits (including Jump off) to be counted. Combination with most clear rounds wins.
19. In event of further tie, the rider with most wins in TAM5 class over the whole circuit will be the winner.
20. A ground jury is to consist of branch representatives as nominated at the meeting to decide the outcome of any queries or protests and any letters of complaint to be sent to the secretary of that jumping day and then for the nominated committee to discuss.
21. The horse / pony welfare is paramount and if any concerns are raised you may be asked by the organising committee to withdraw from any further classes.
22. All clubs to pay a small amount of prize money.
23. Rules must be displayed on each circuit day.
